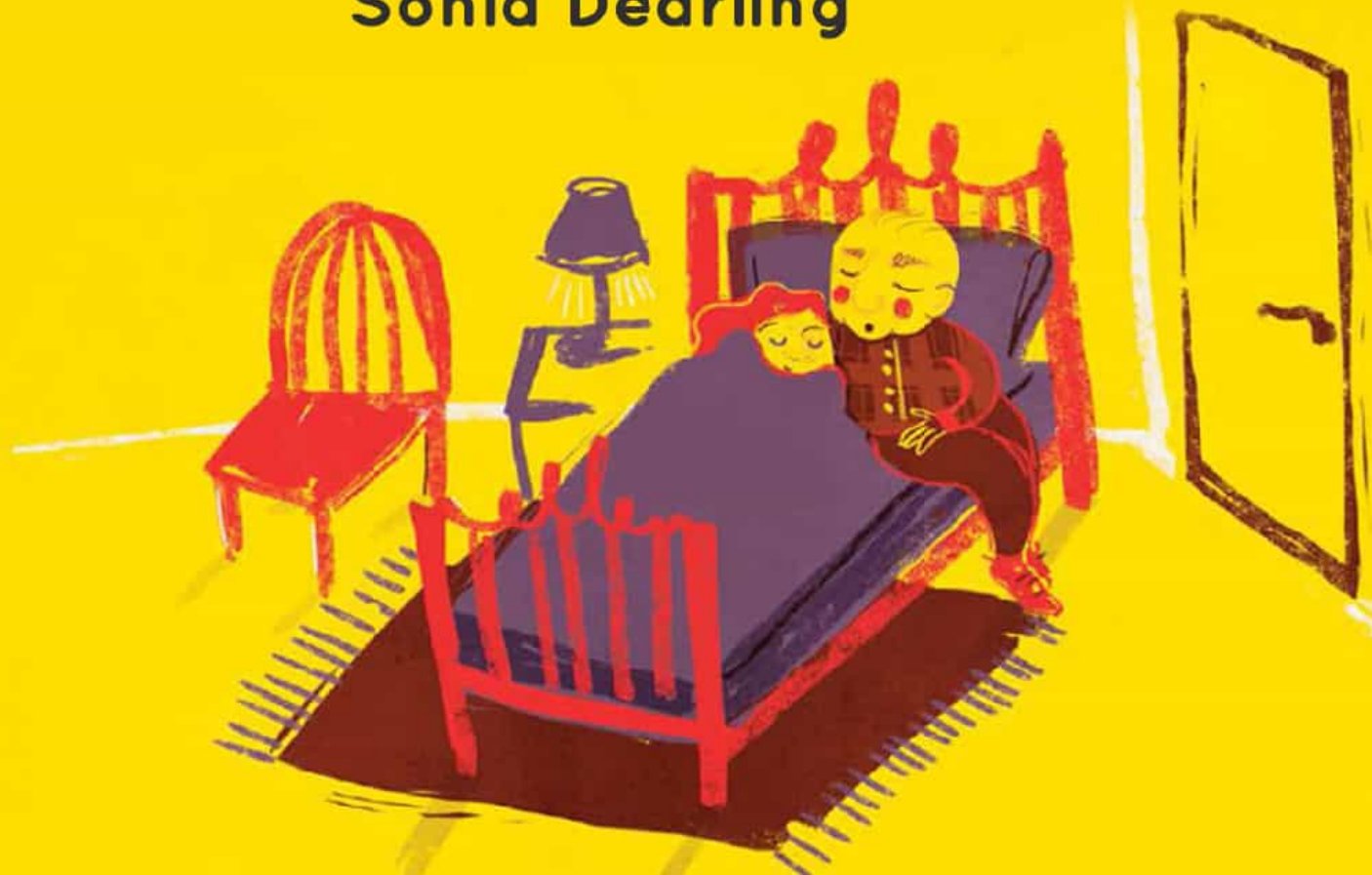


A Tall Tale

This is my Pa.

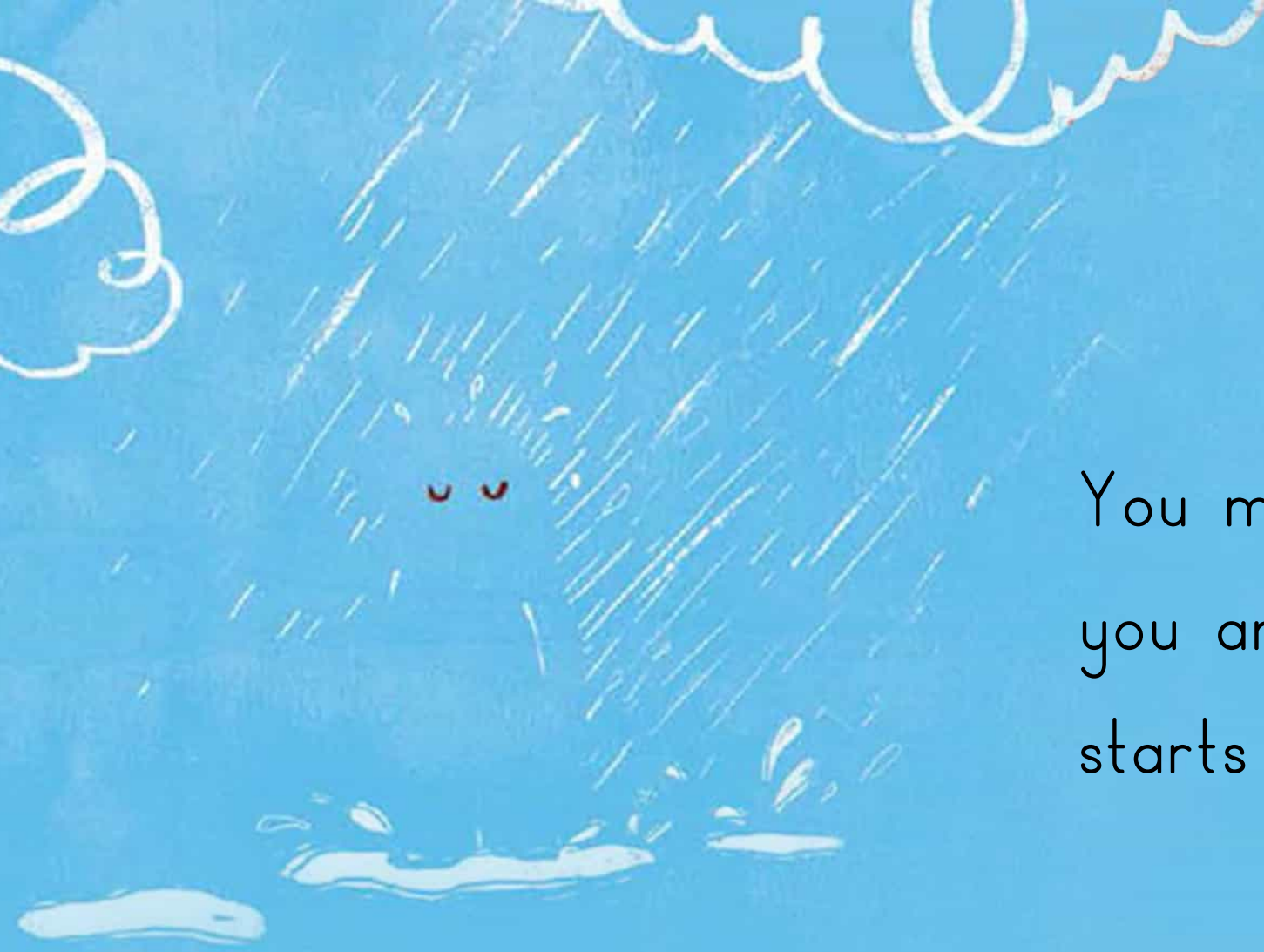
He likes to spoil me

The girl loves it!

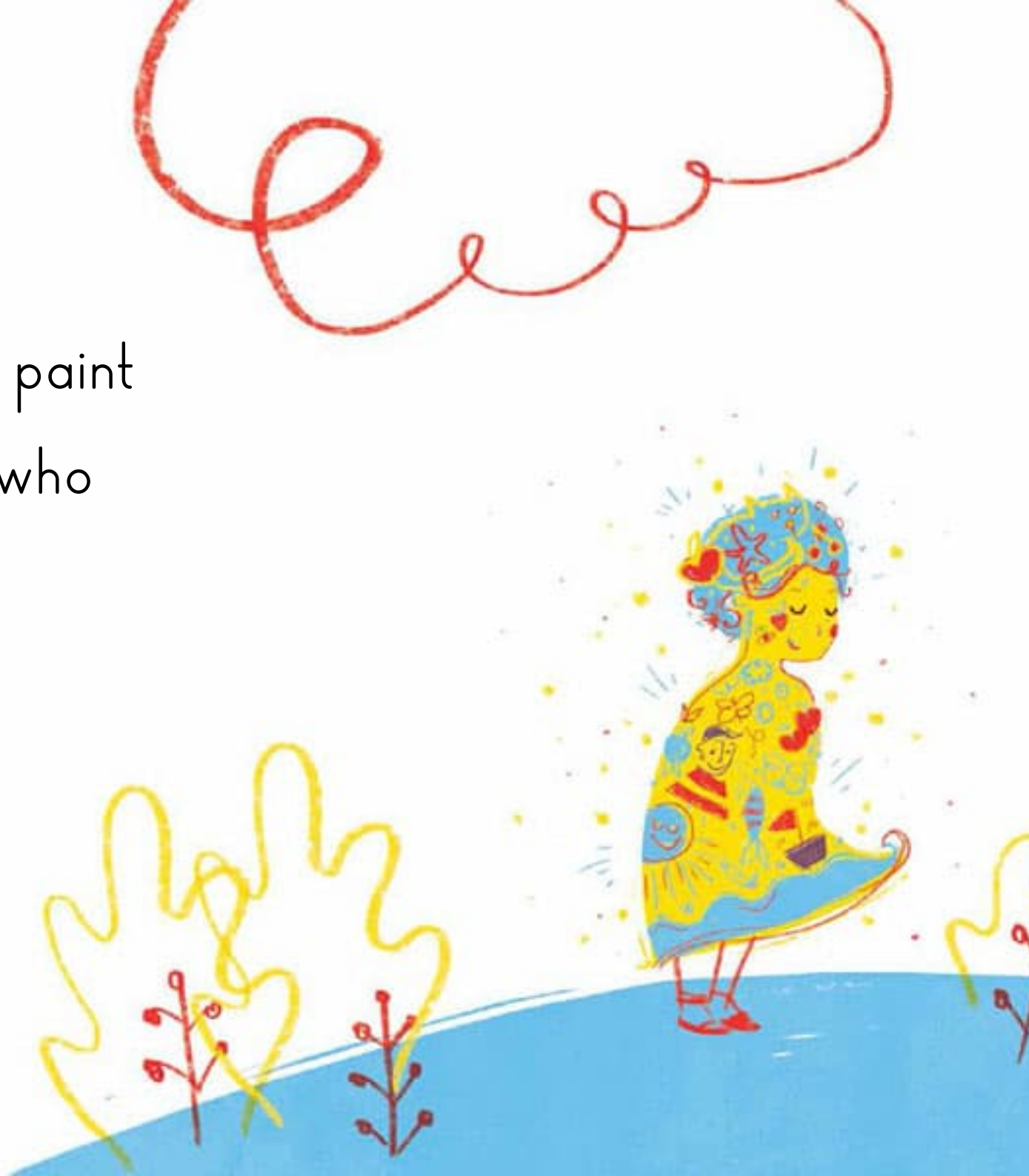
He gives her hair

He asks what I think.

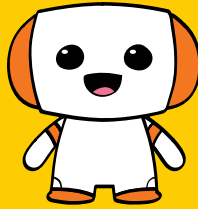


I say, I think it is a tall tale.
