

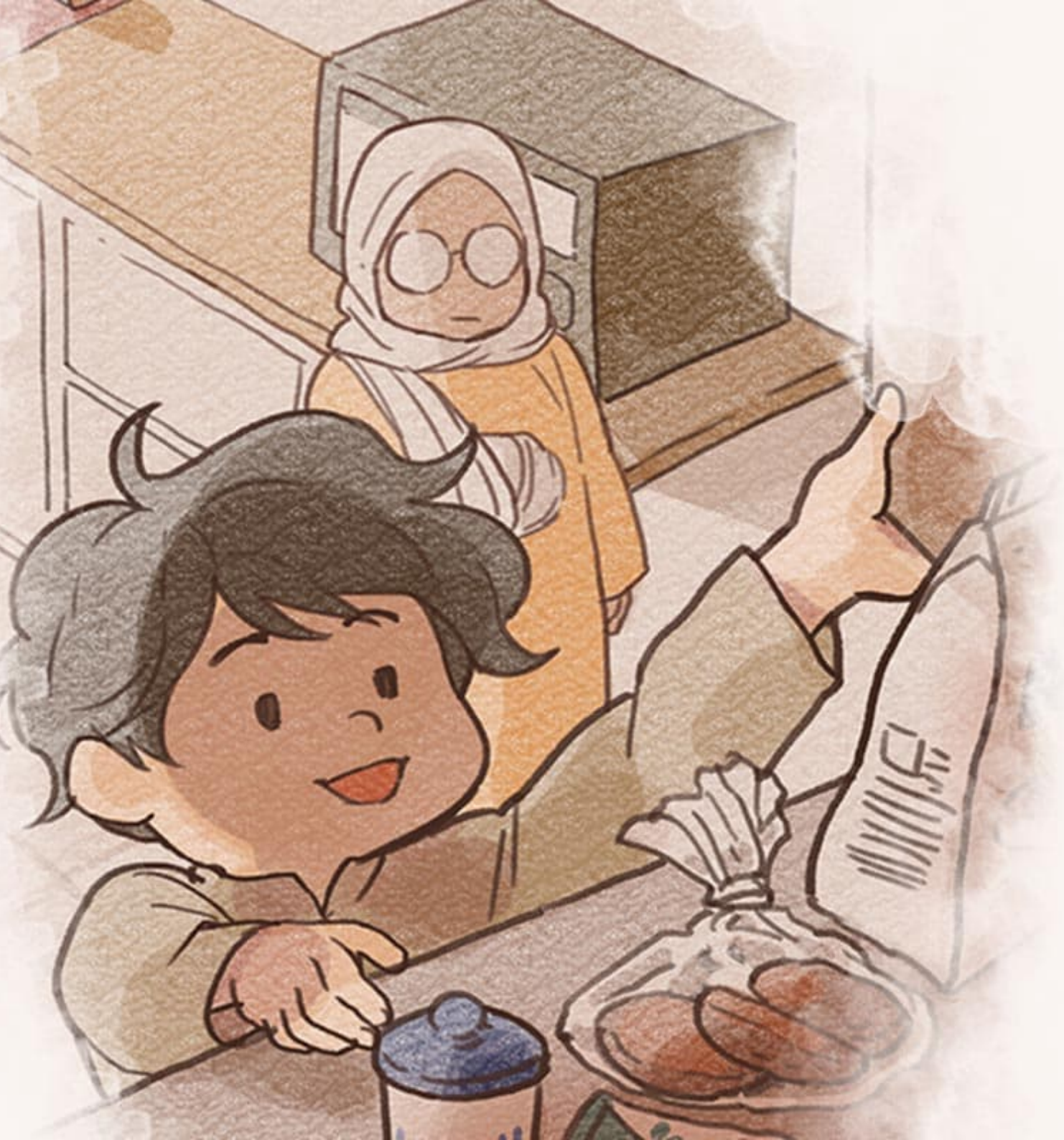

her hand.





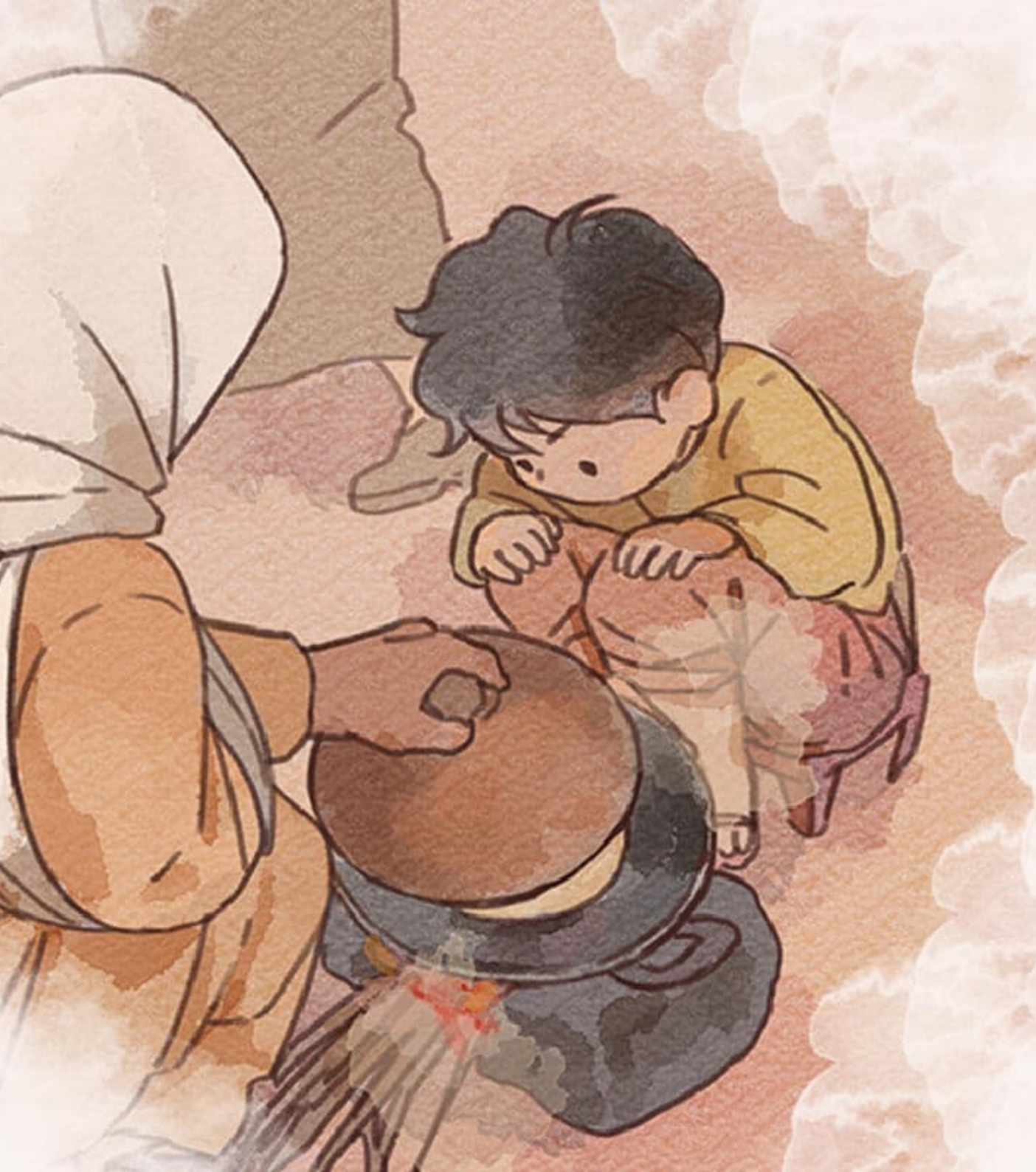

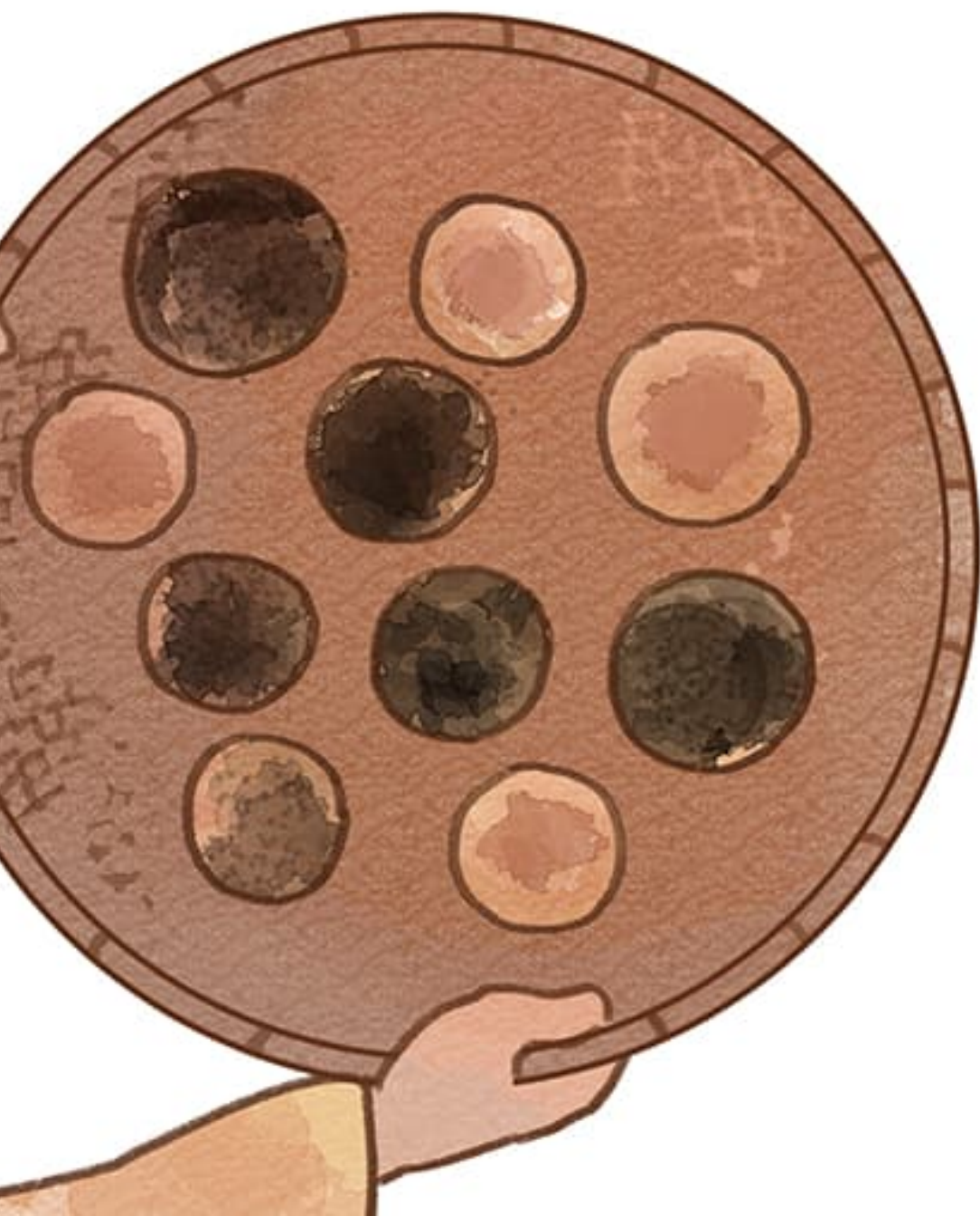
