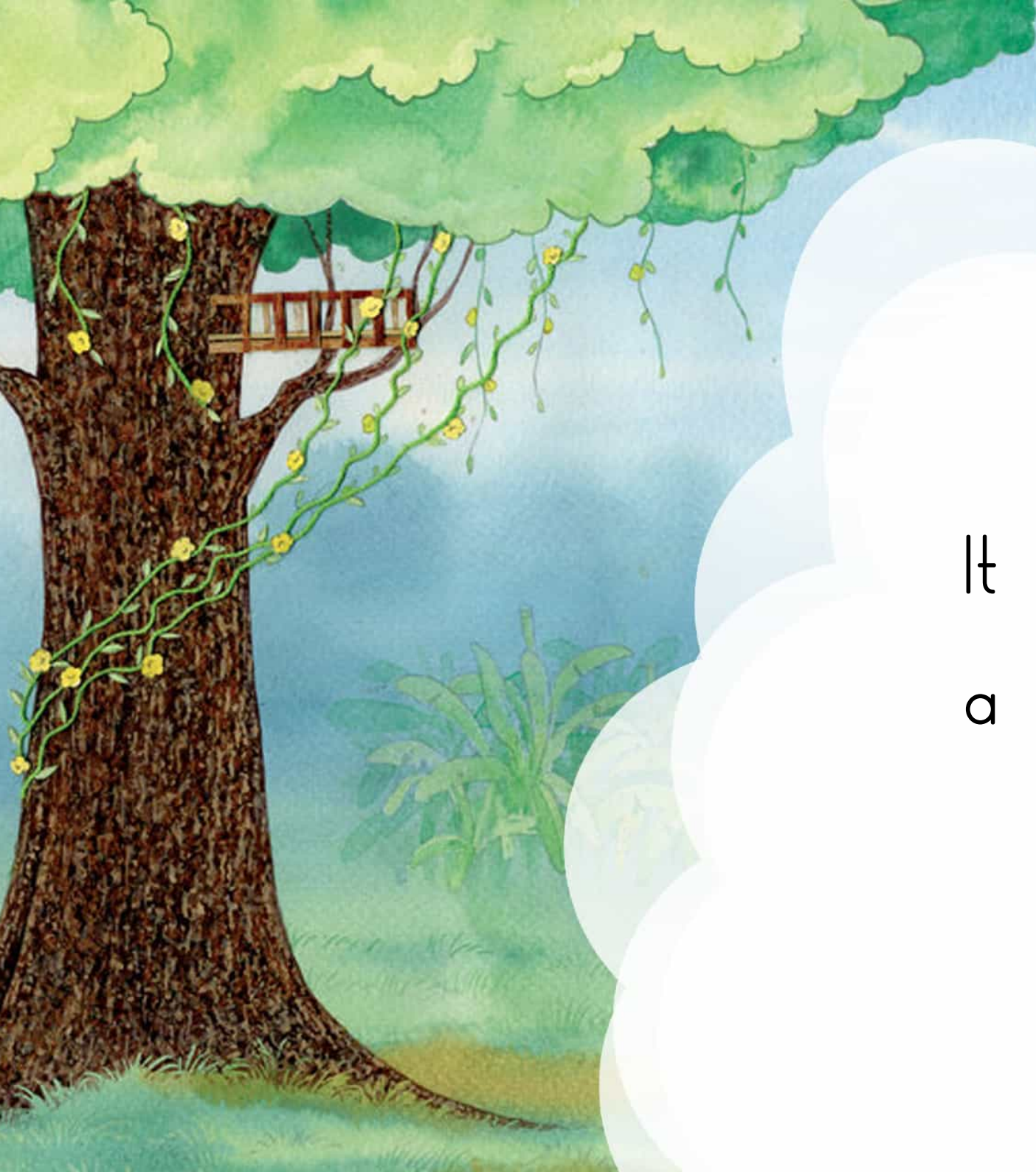


Banana Hunt
