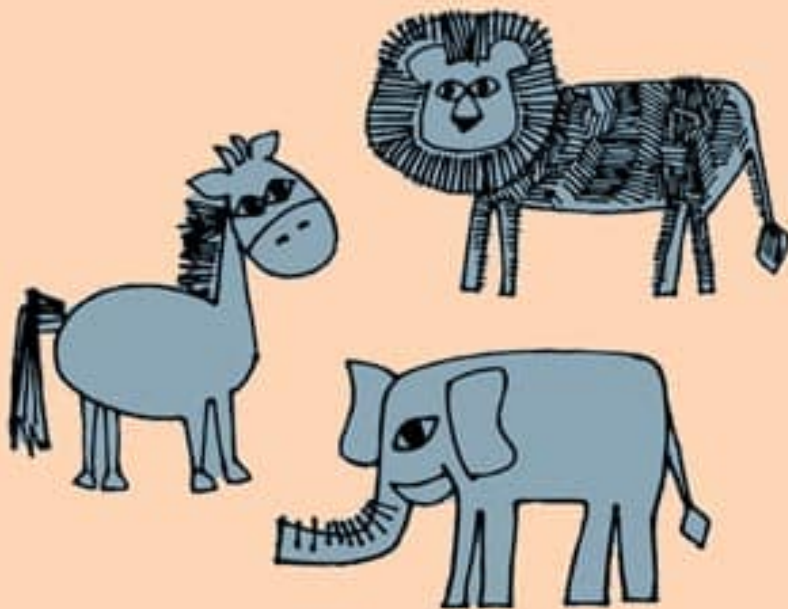

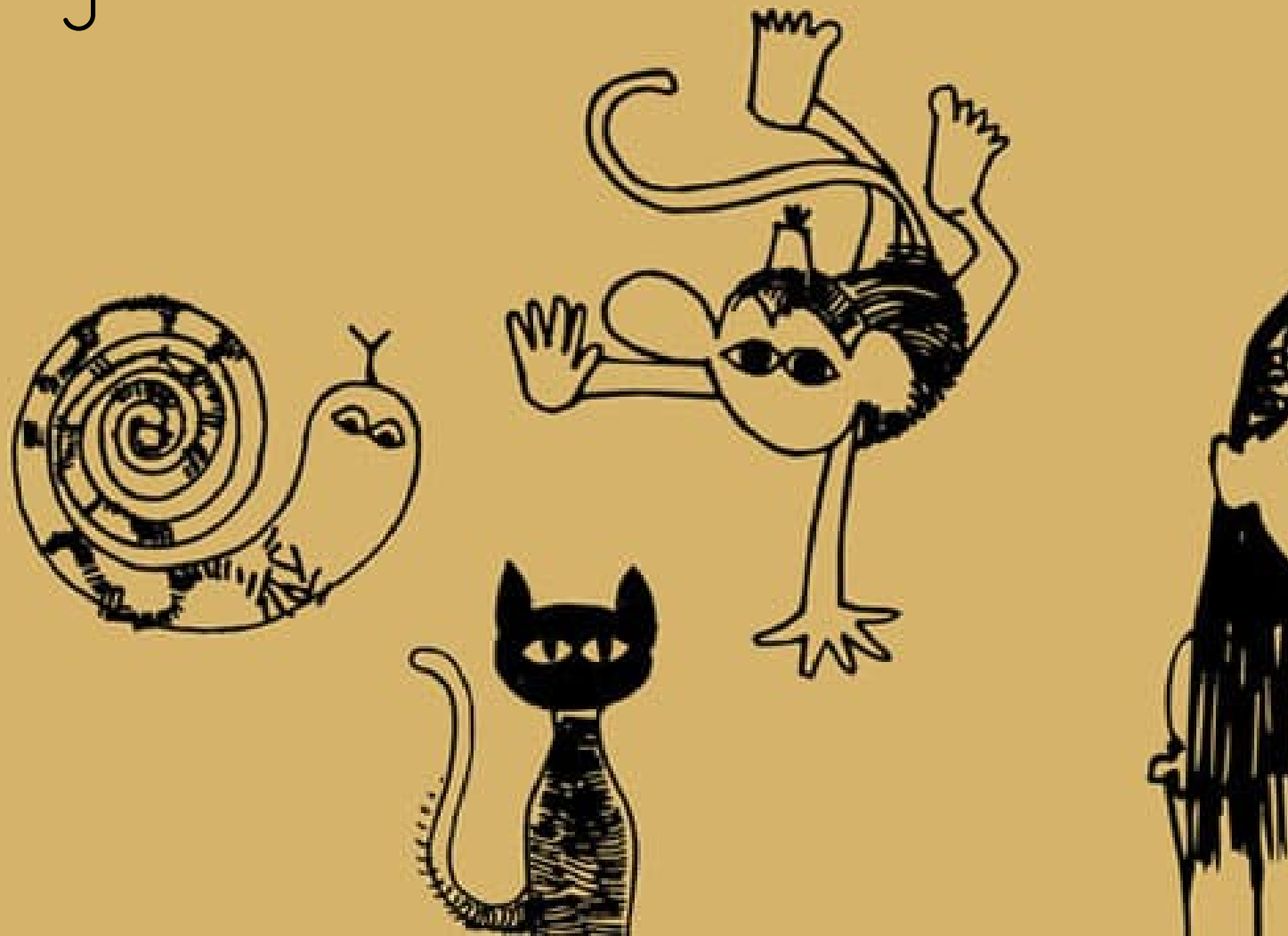
Hair can have a tight

spring.



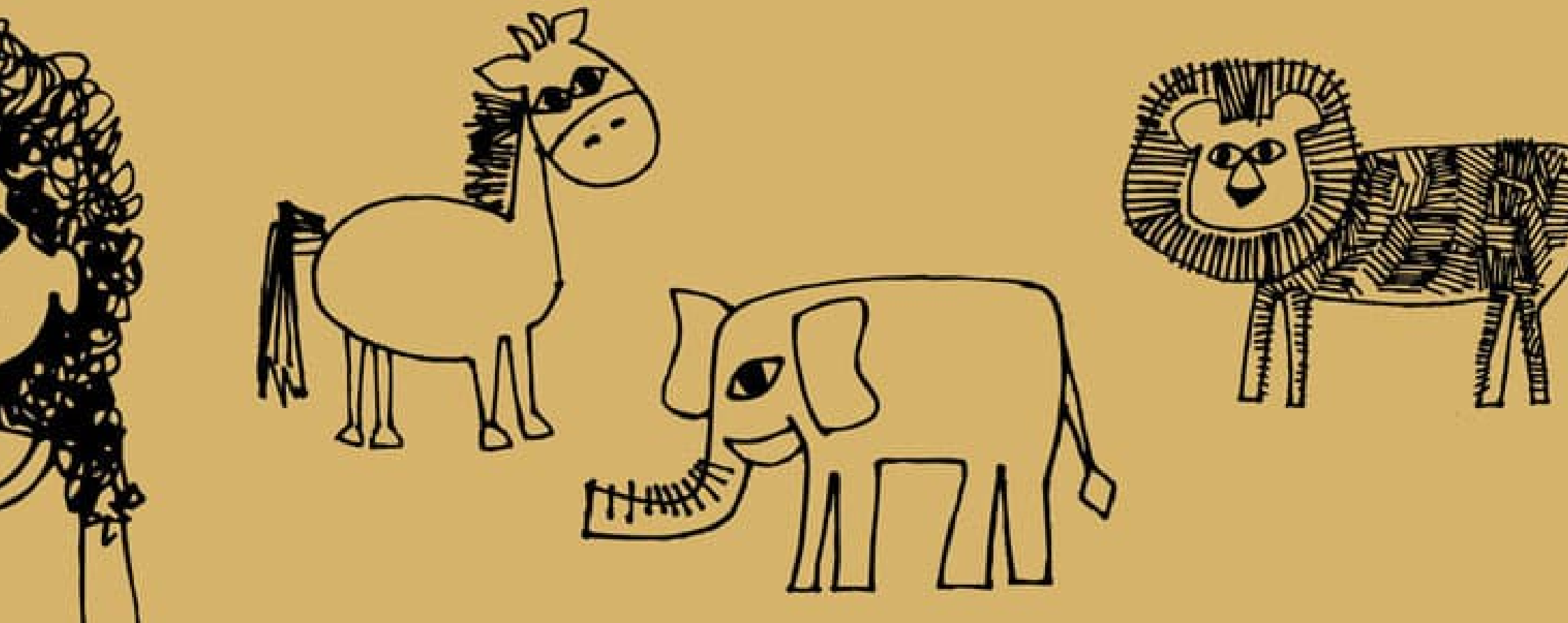


Some hair is
