

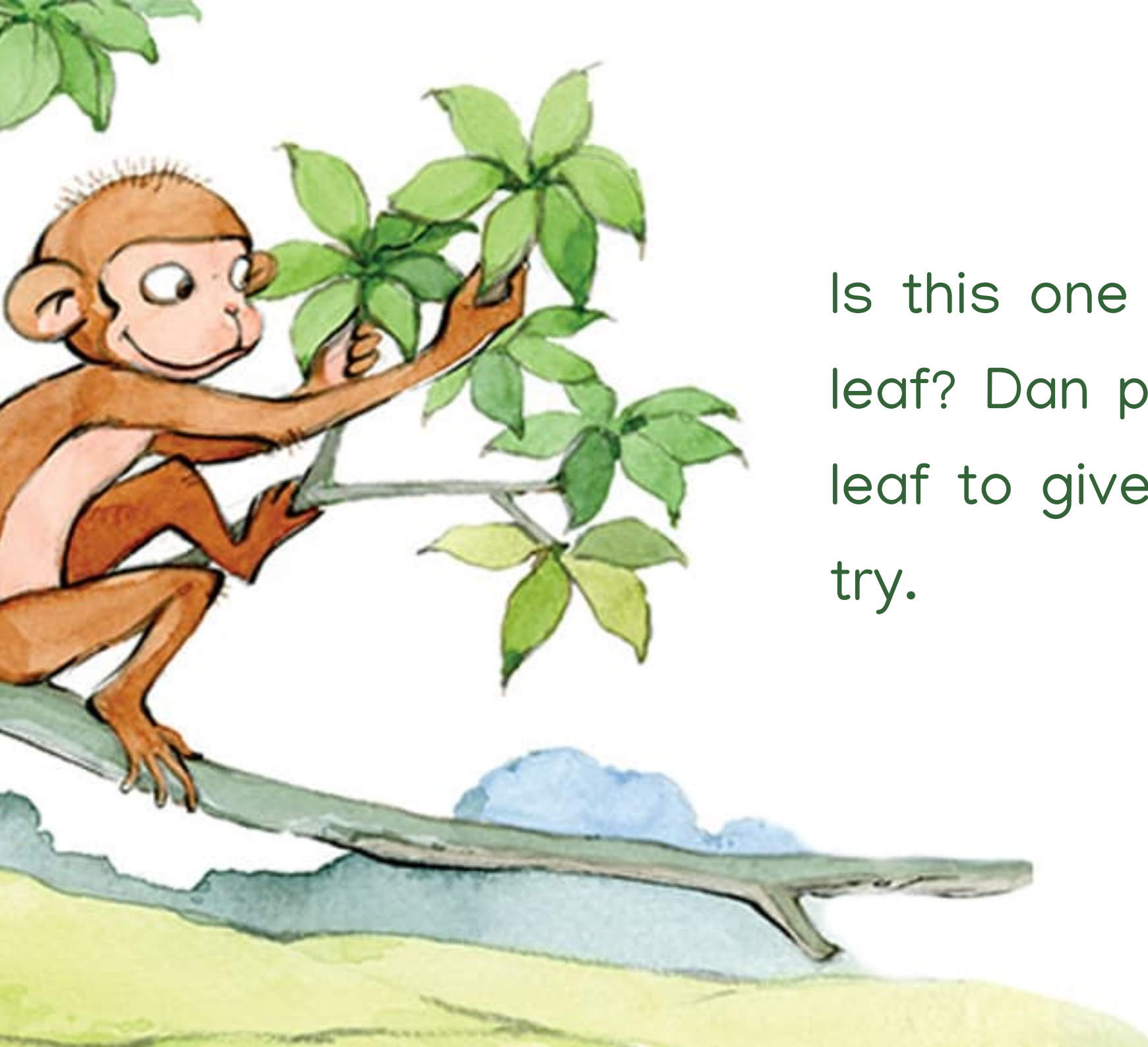

want a snack as well?



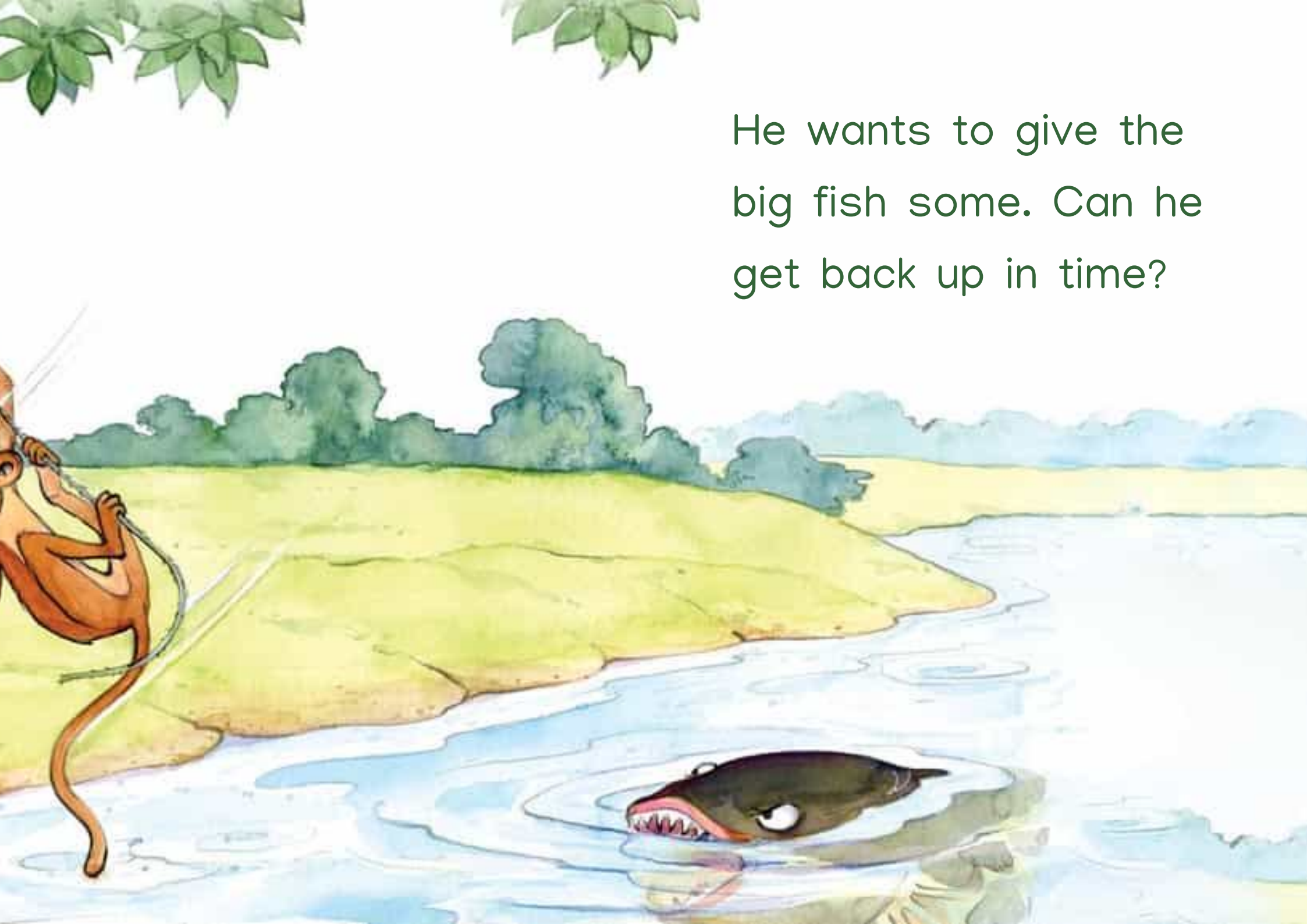


Dan's mum grabs

get up high.

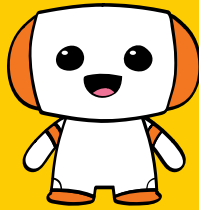
Swish!
