

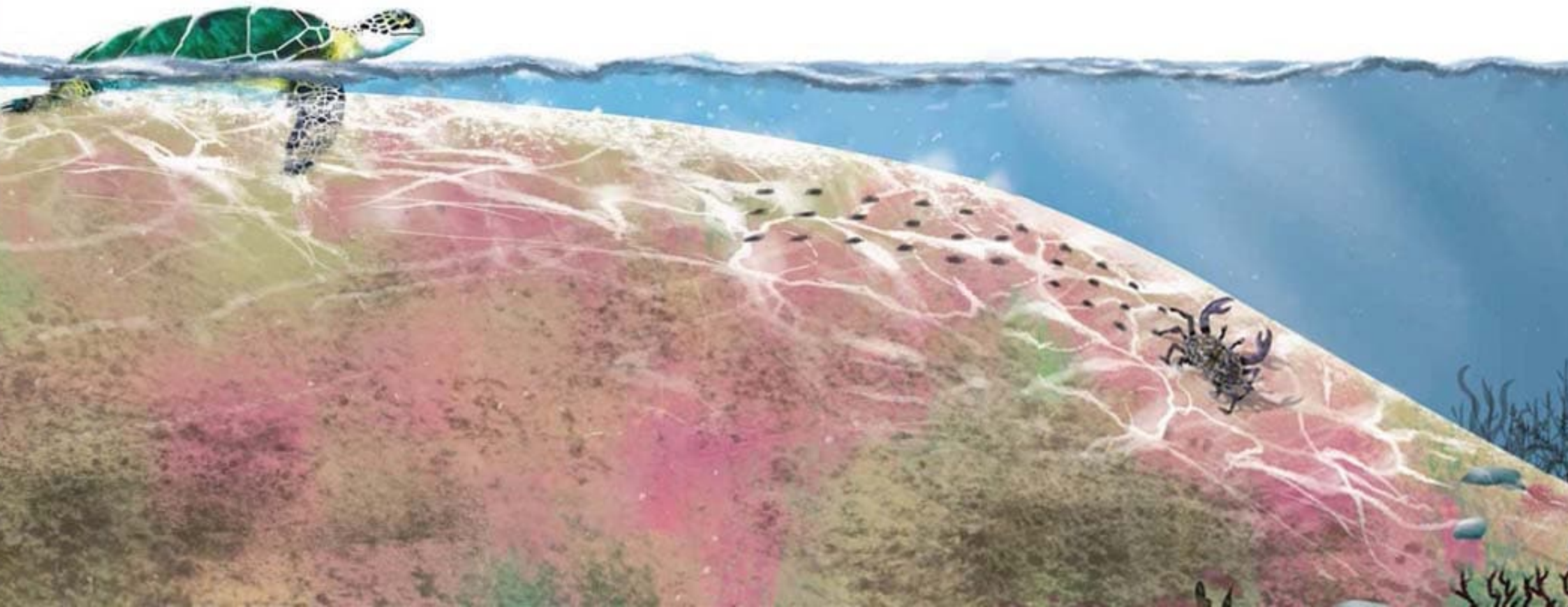


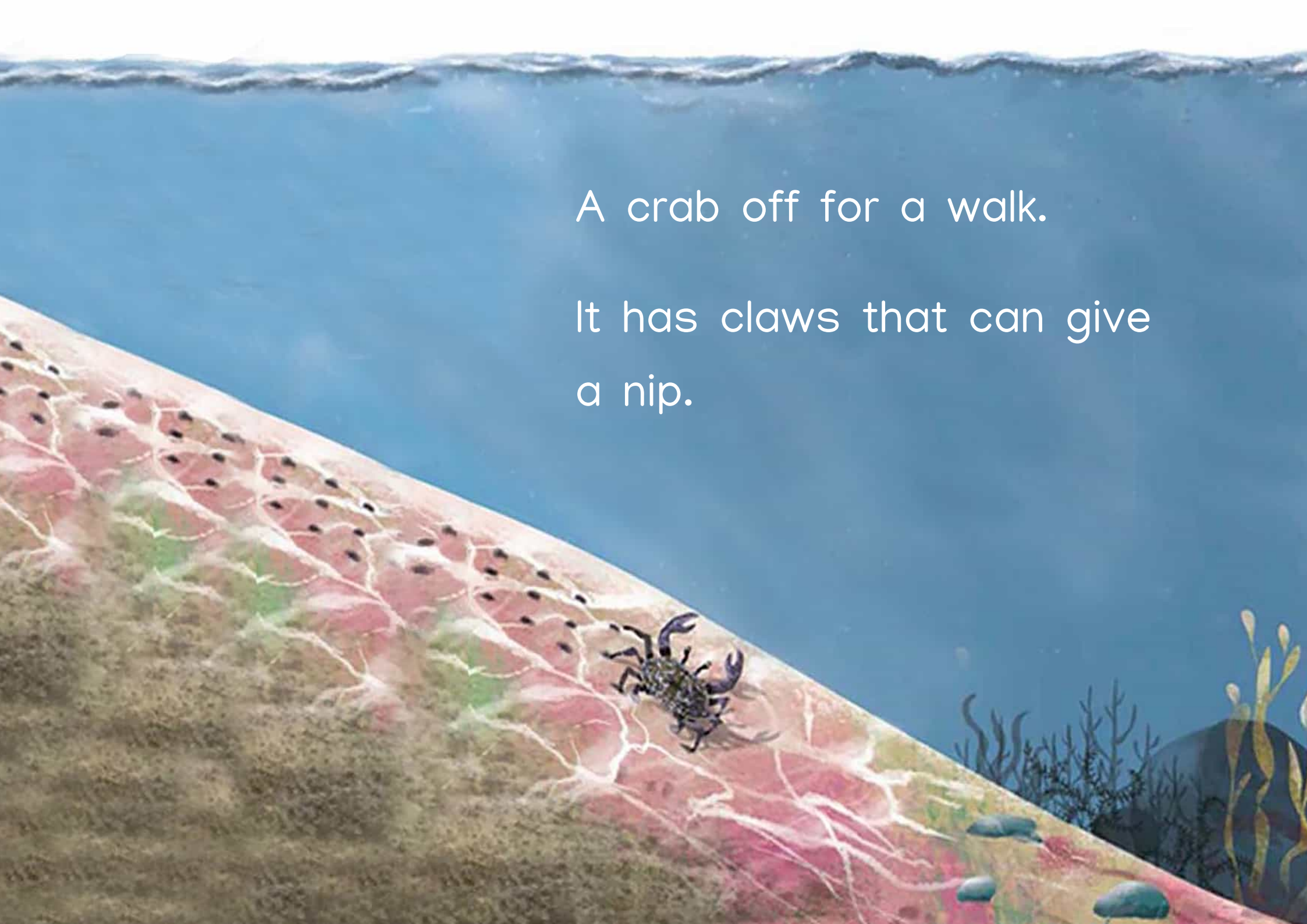
DIVE!

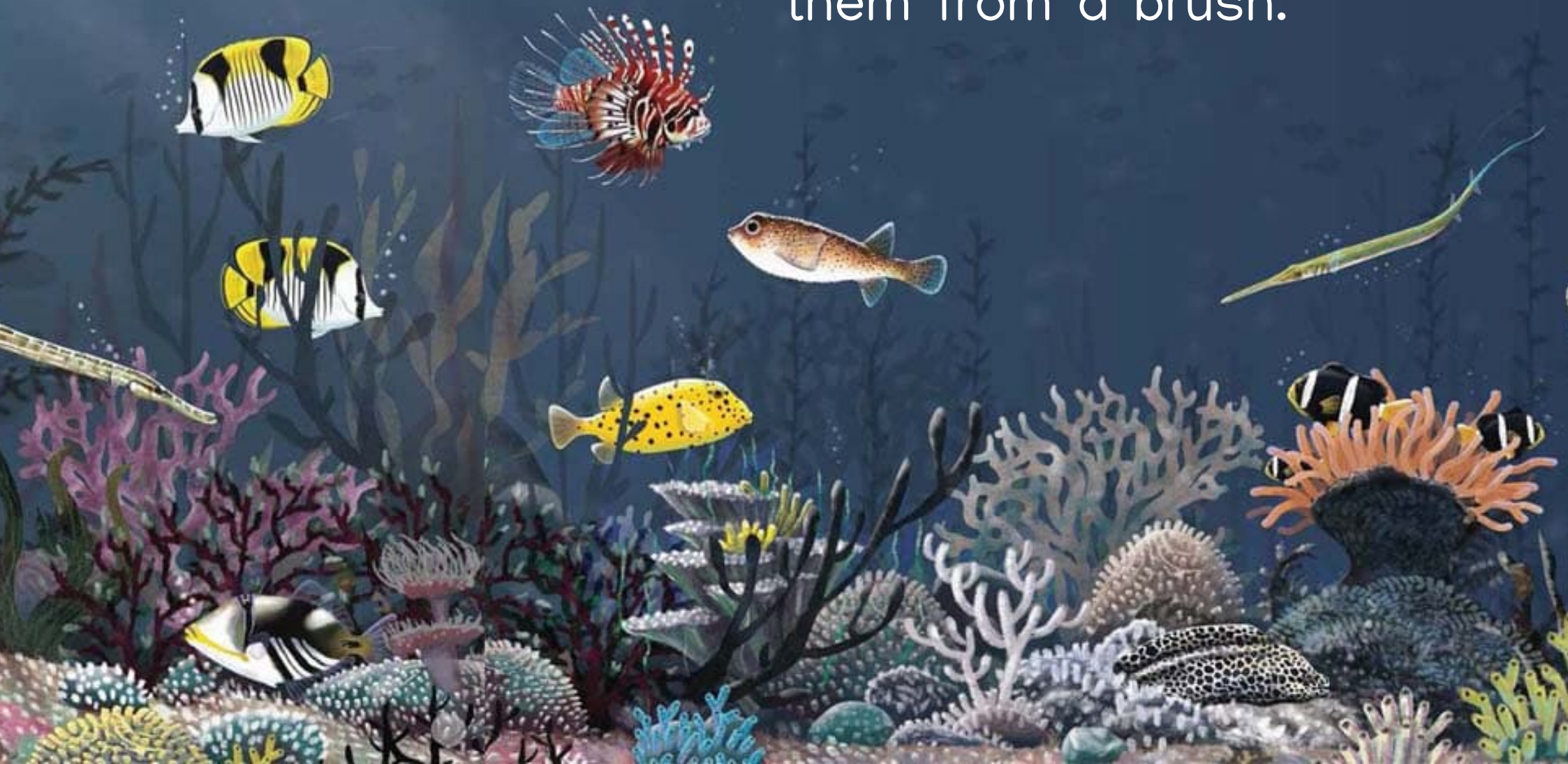
A crab off for a walk.

a nip.

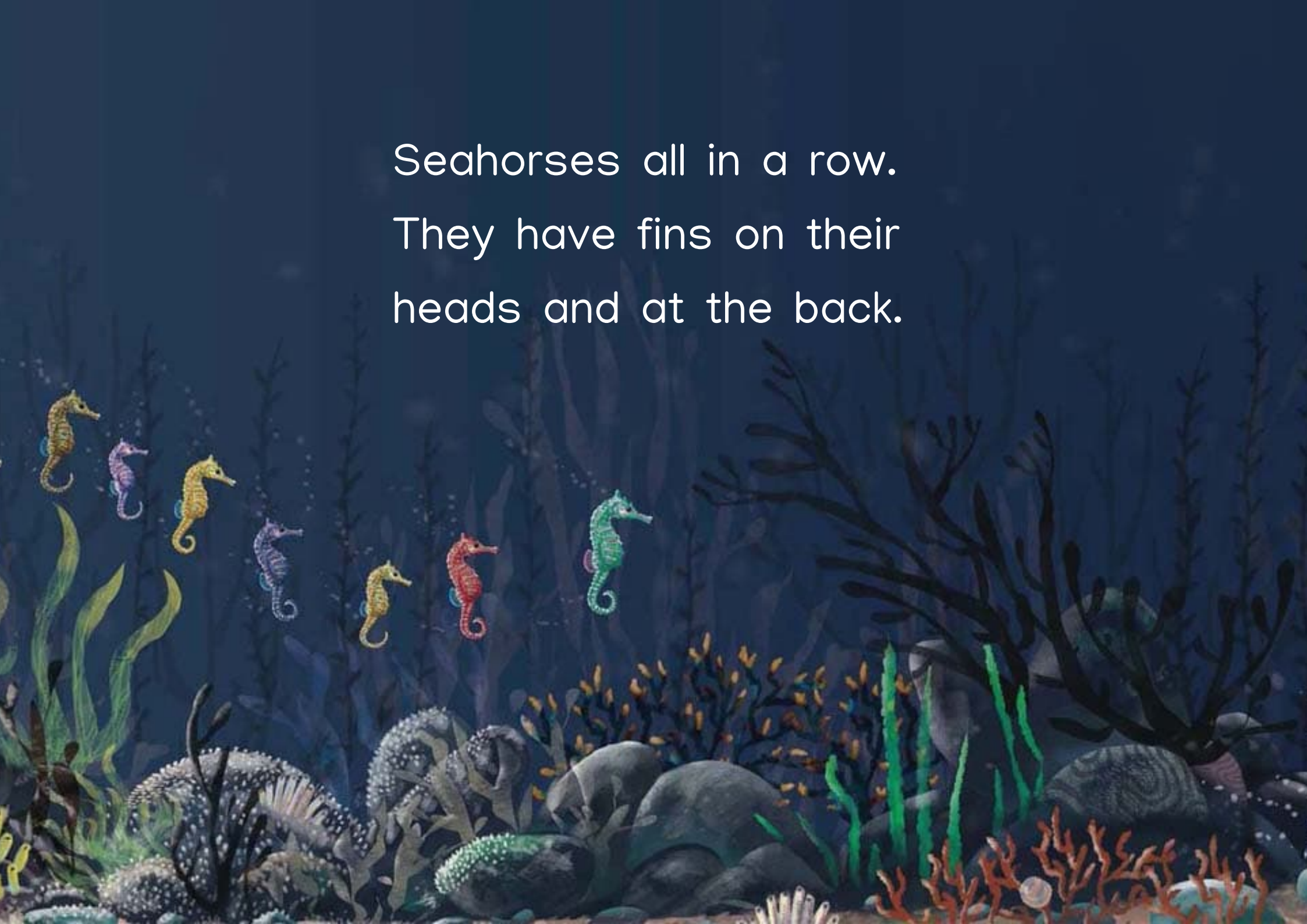
Fish come in all shapes

so that they can hide.



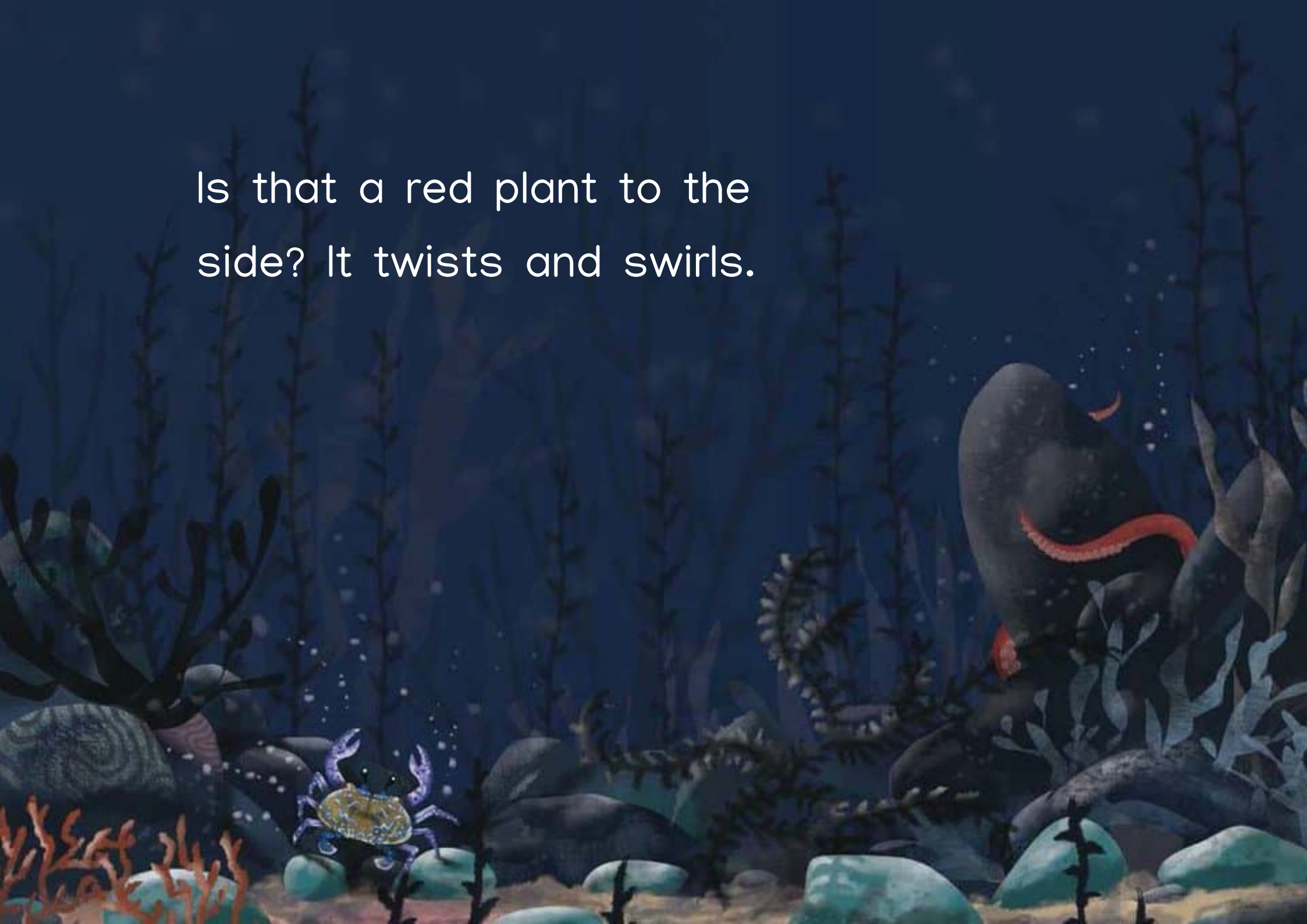
Fish can look like they

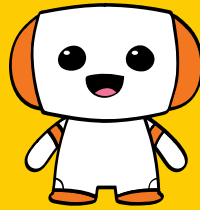
Dolphins!
