left the yard.



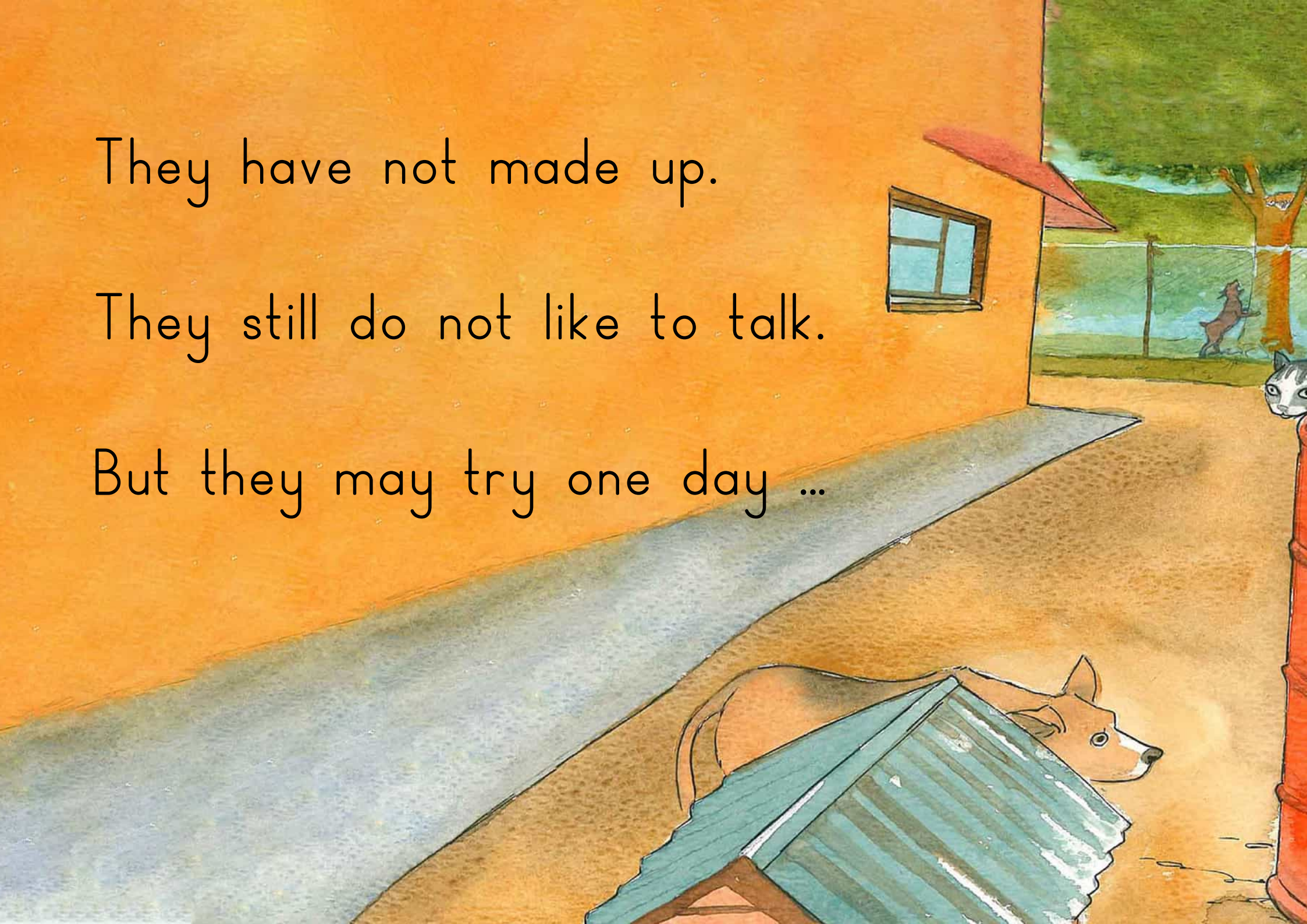
Cat had a rest.
