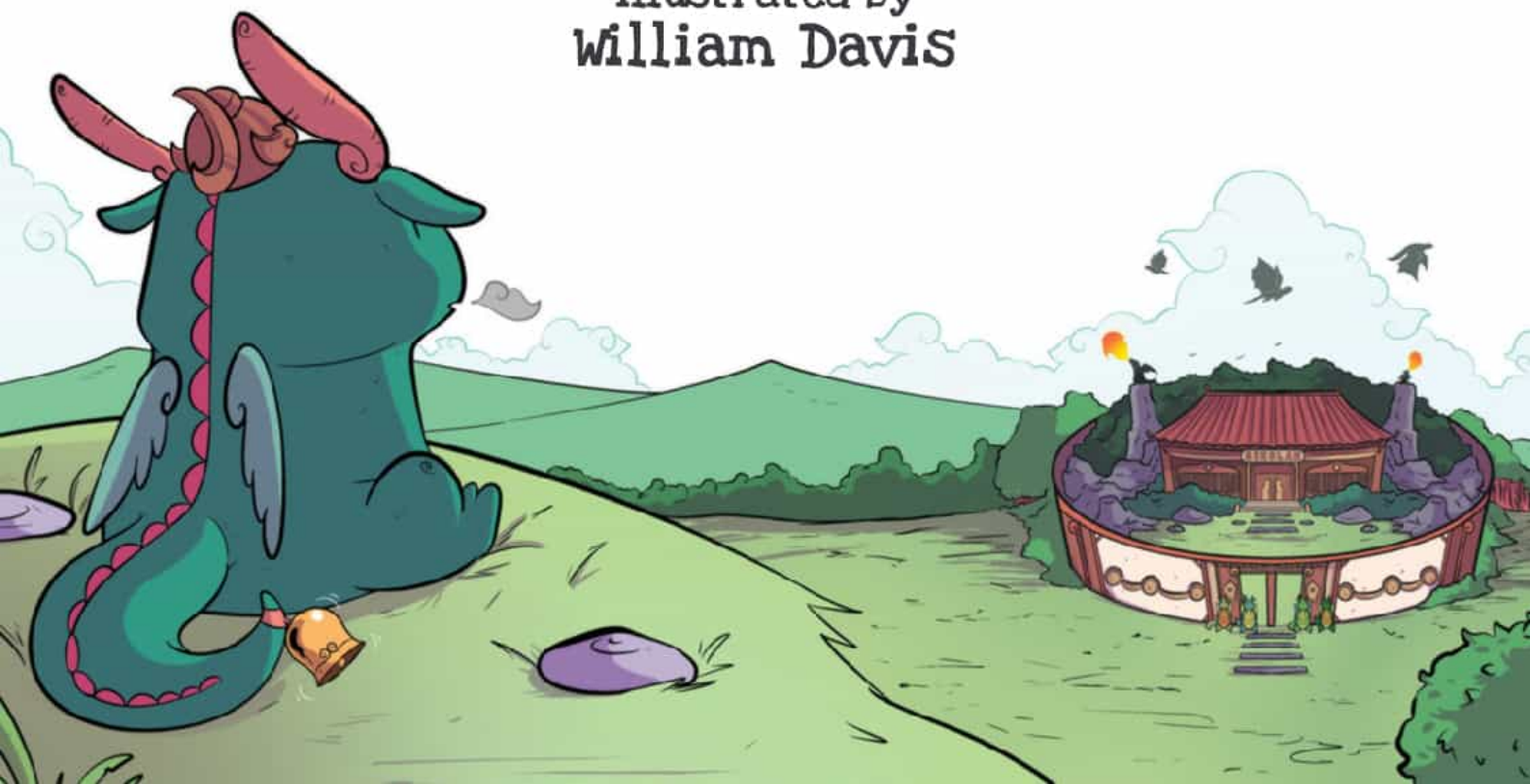


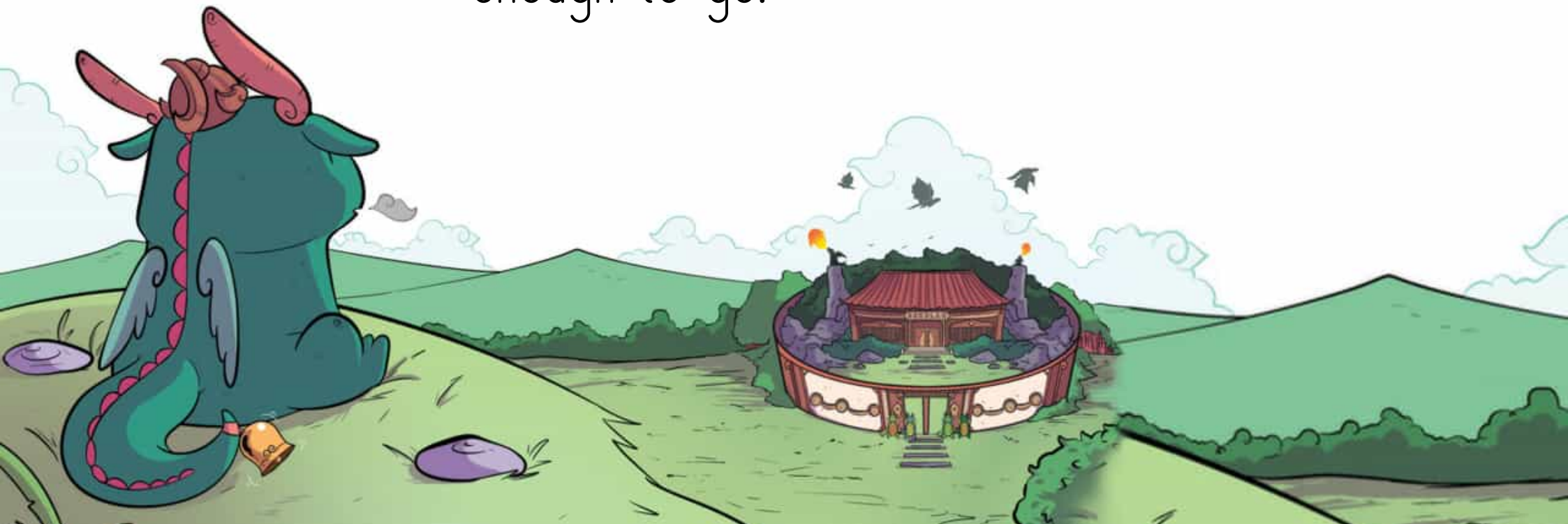
Dragon School

Dibs was sad.



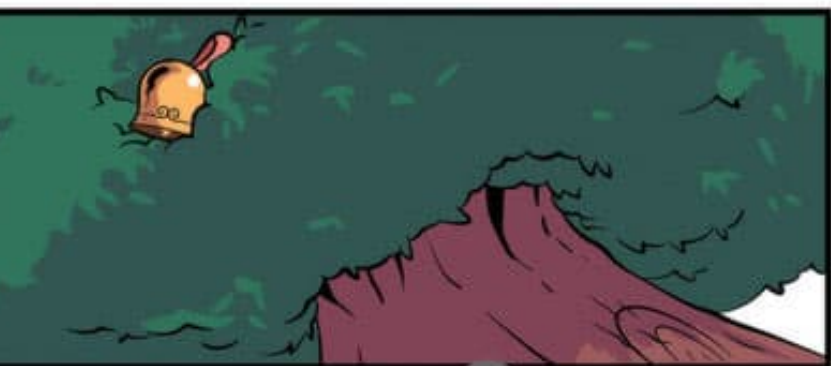


He told the teacher.

came back!





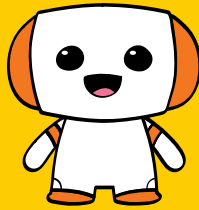
The bell got stuck in a tree.
