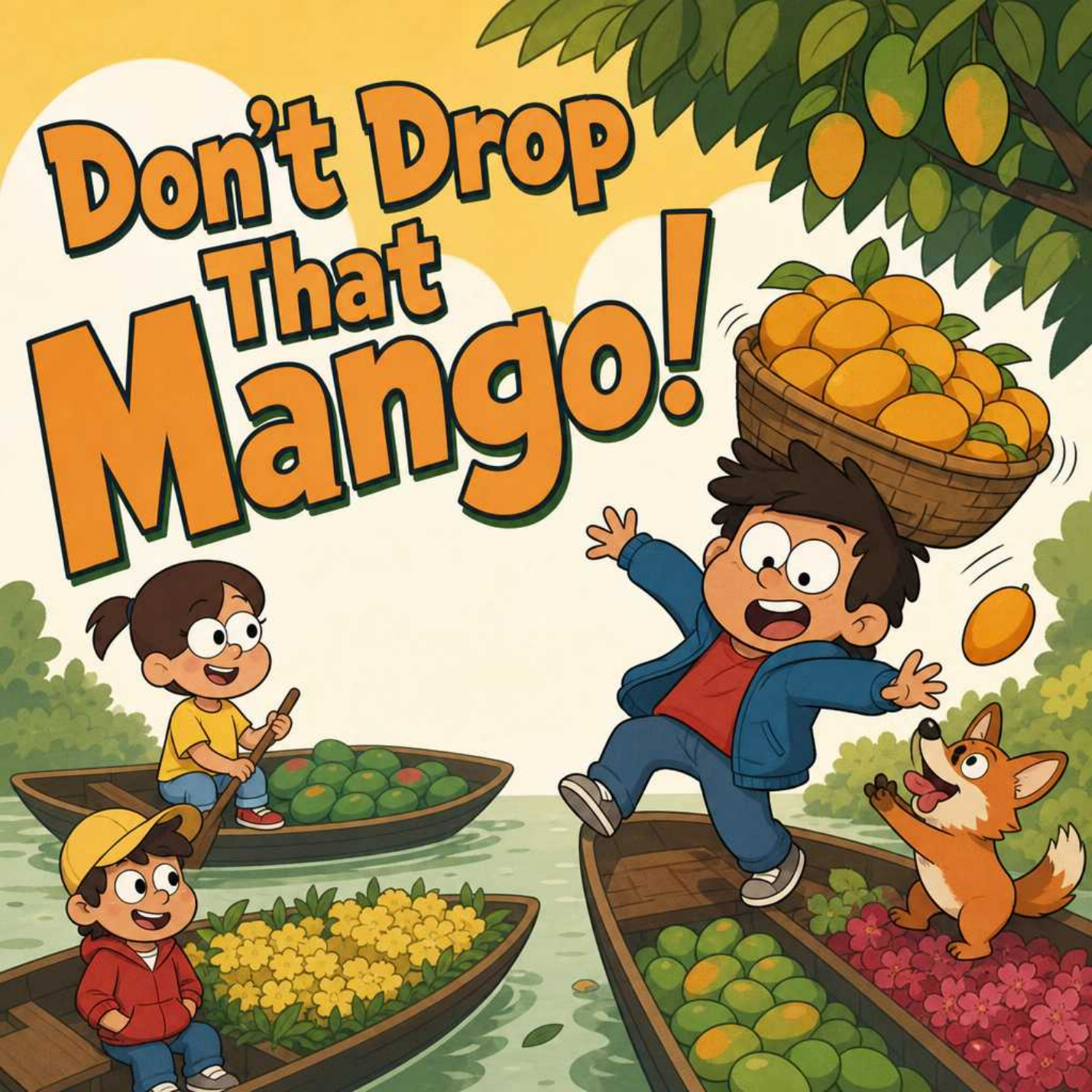


Don't Drop That Mango!

We have a lot of mango trees. We must work hard to pluck them all while they are ripe. We fill each **basket** and take them to **market** to earn our money.



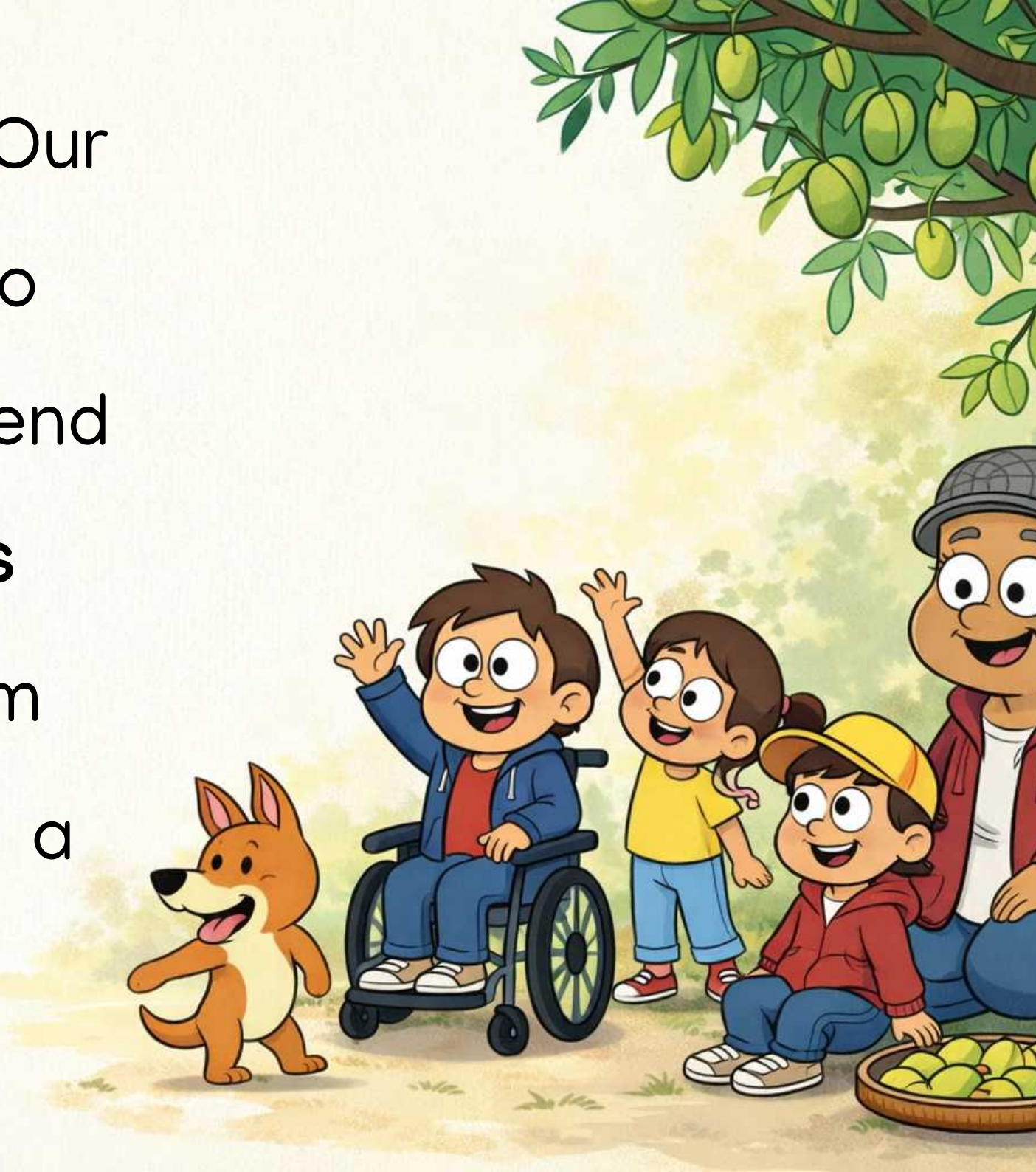
We climb the trees

safe.

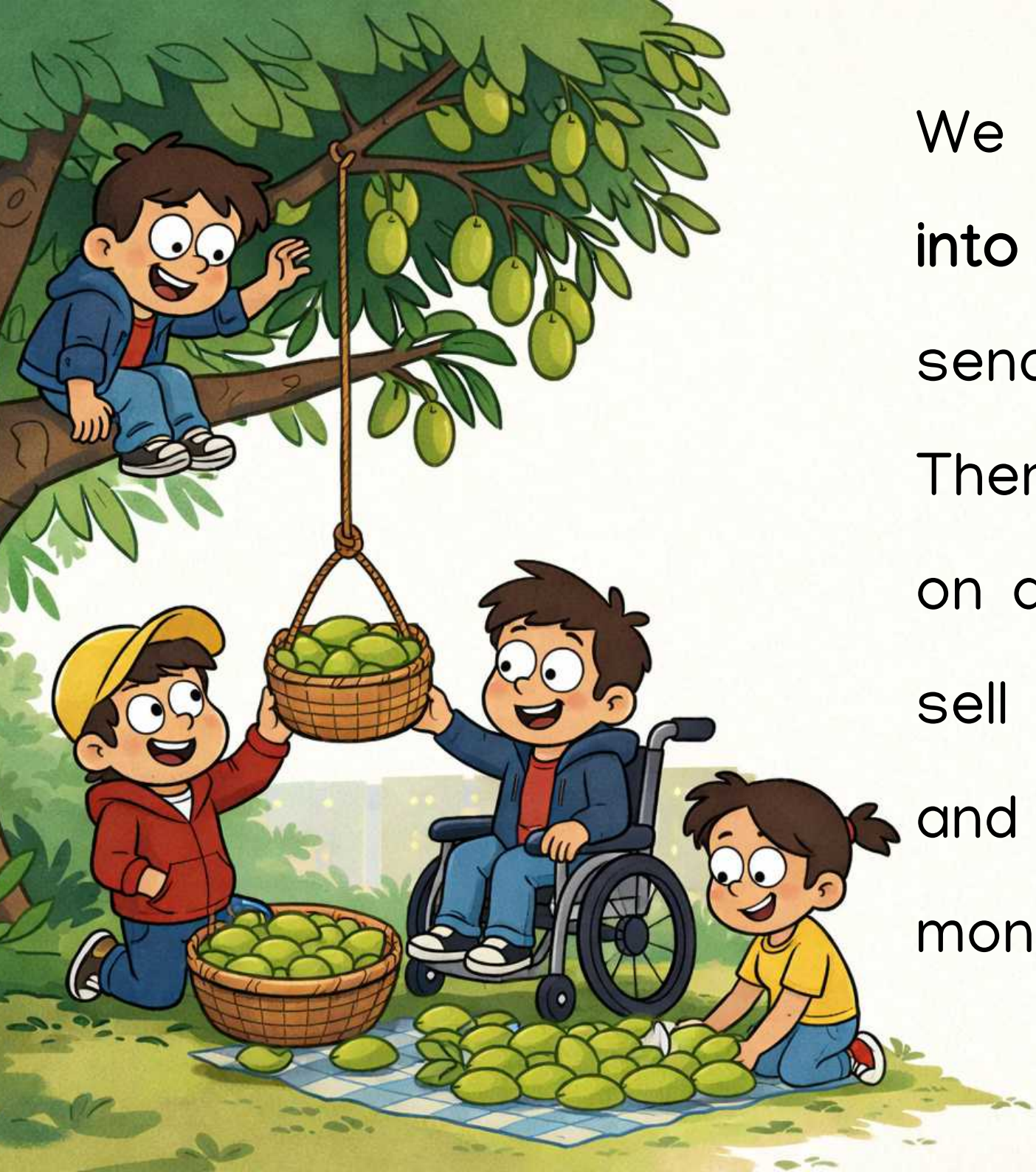




We have a

Back to work. Our friends come to help. We will send some mangoes home with them in a basket as a thank you.



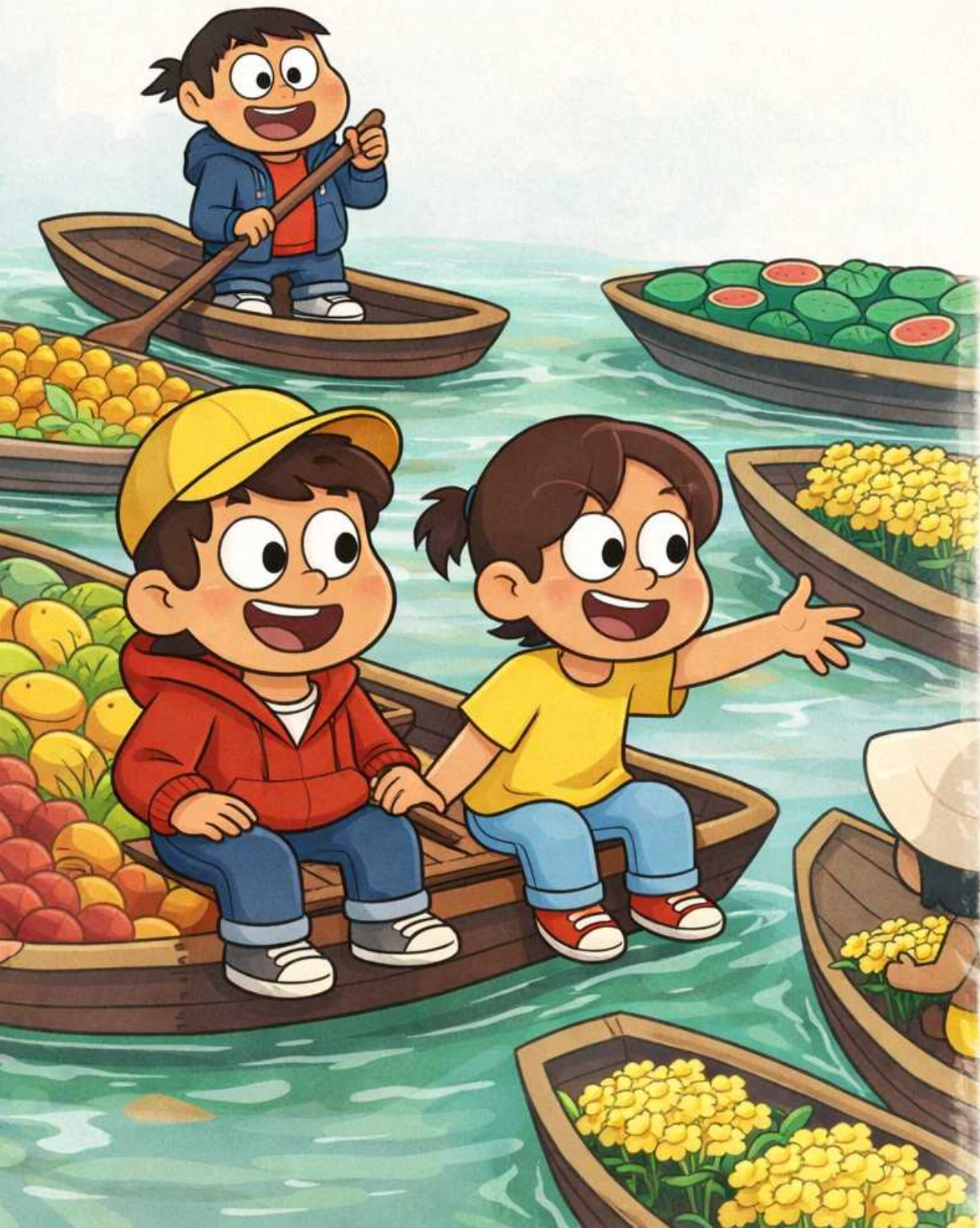


We load the mangoes
