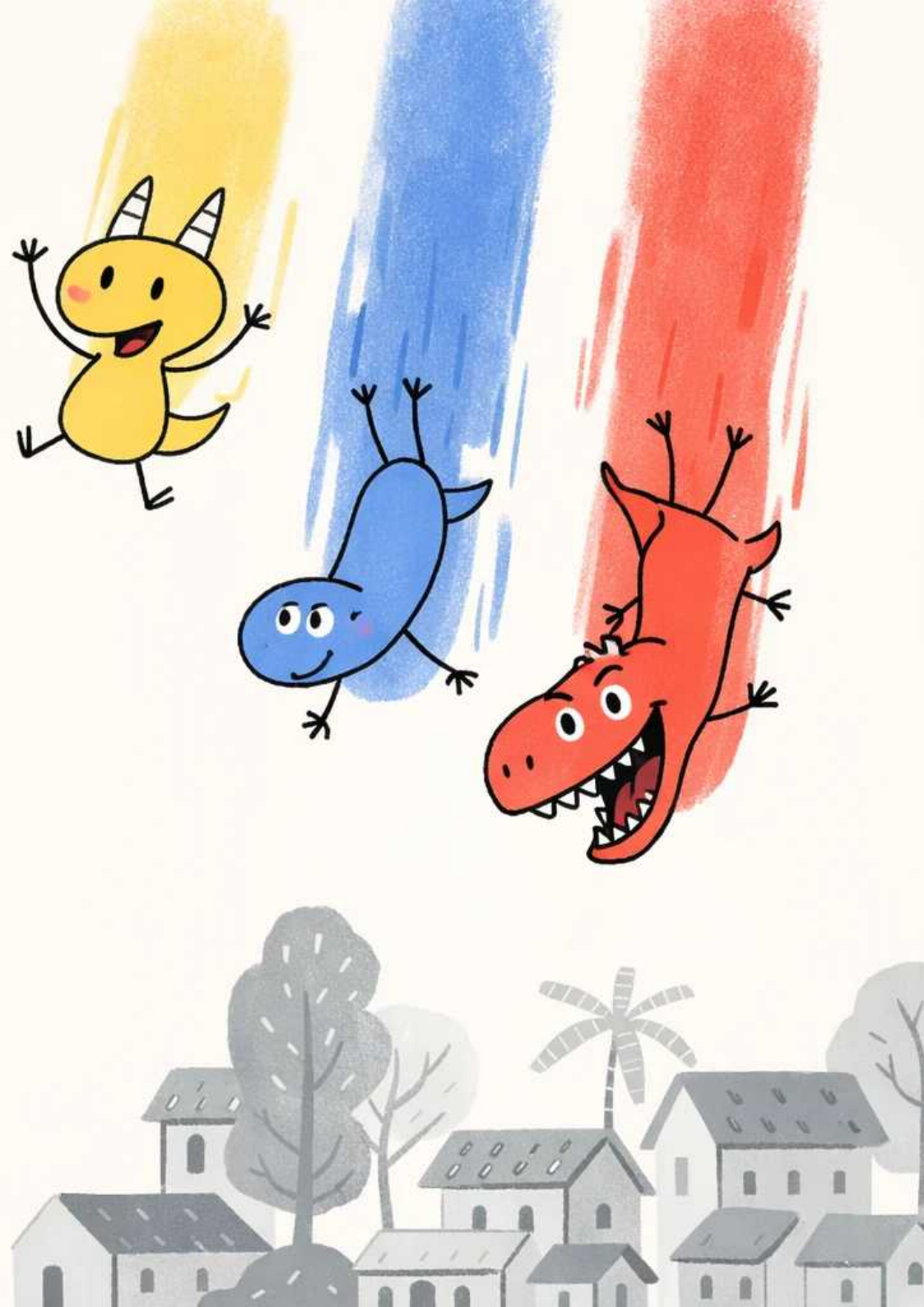
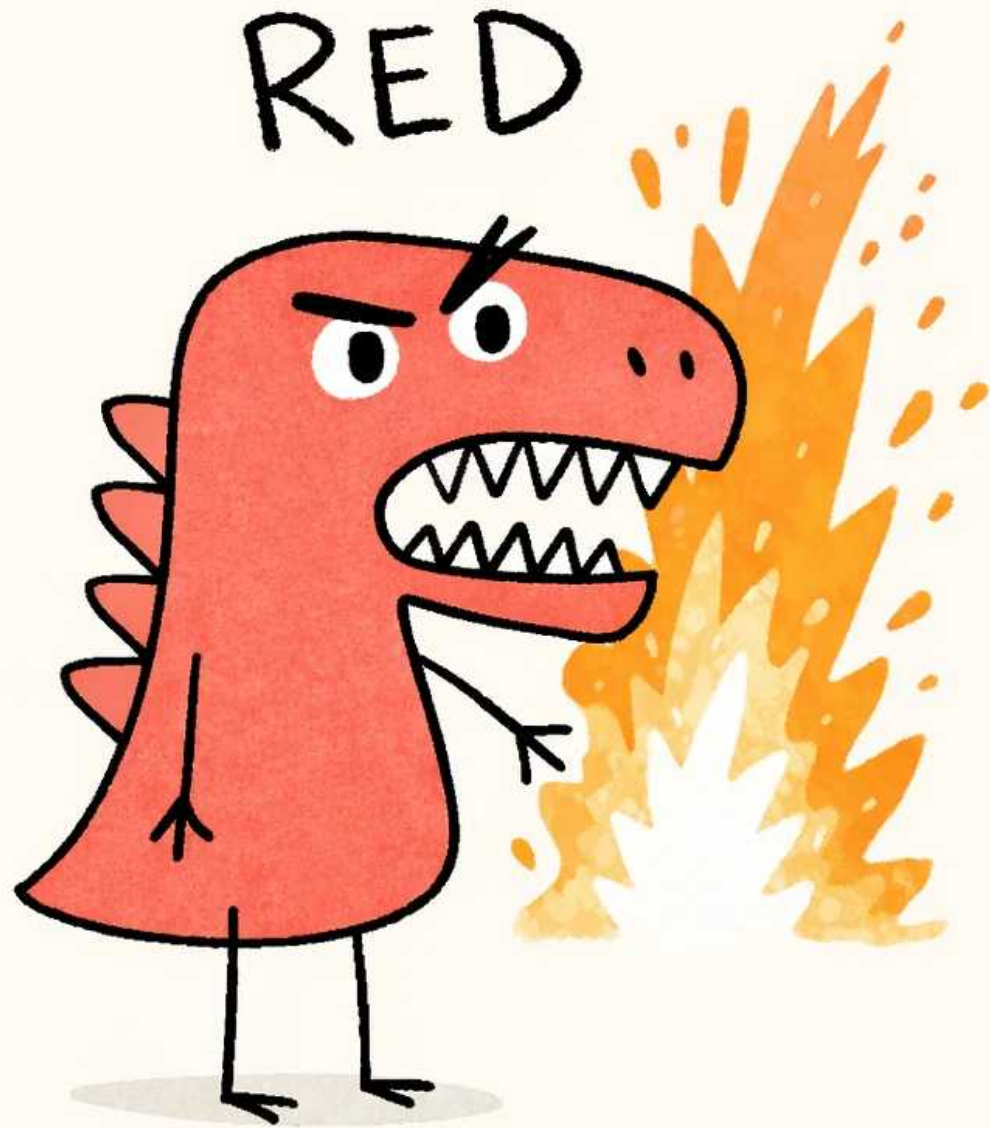


Don't Mix All Three!



Just three colours can make a whole lot more. They are called the **primary** colours. Red, blue, and yellow are **primary**.





Red is a dangerous, powerful colour. We call it a hot colour. Think of hot, red things like lava.

Yellow is a warm colour, too. It is more gentle. Think of warm things like the sun on a beautiful day.



BLUE



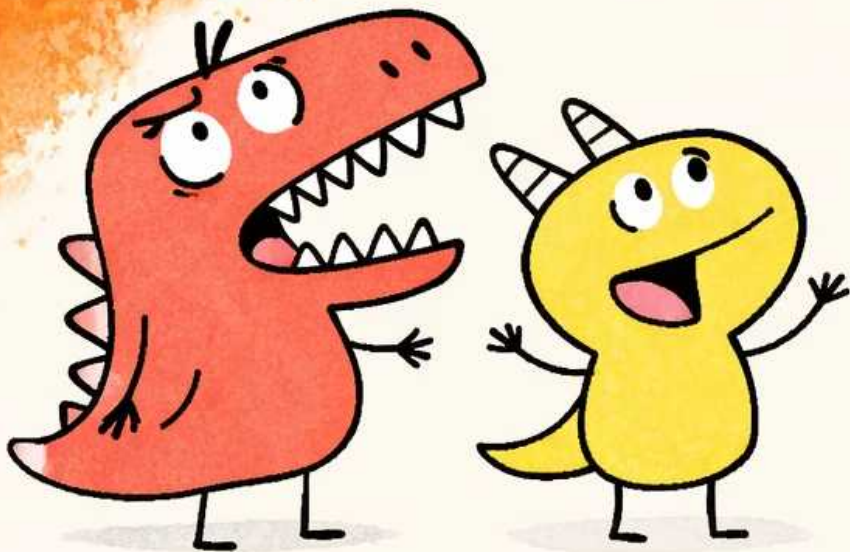
Blue is a cool colour. Think of swimming in a wonderful, clear blue lake.

you get...

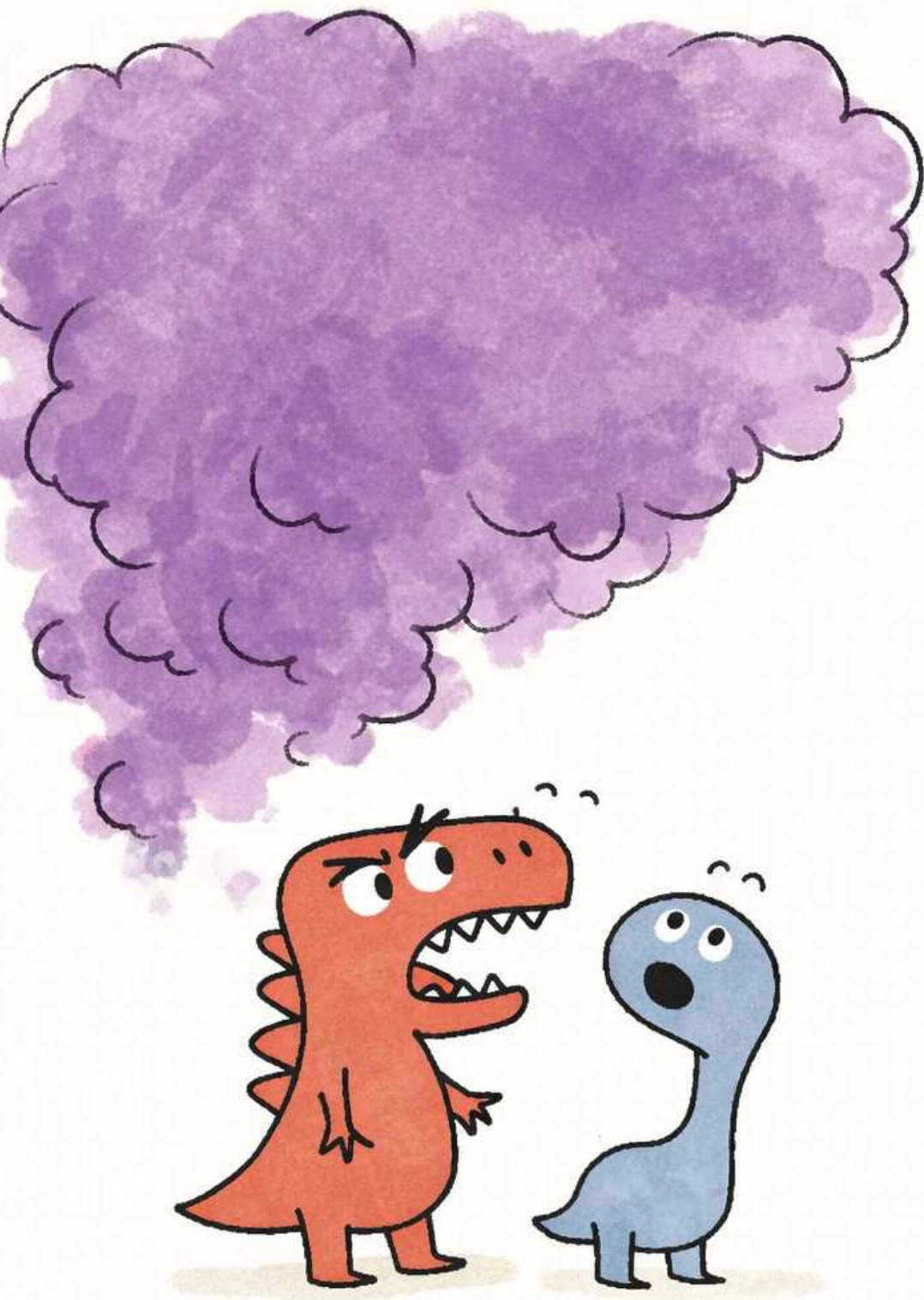


Orange! These

mix together.



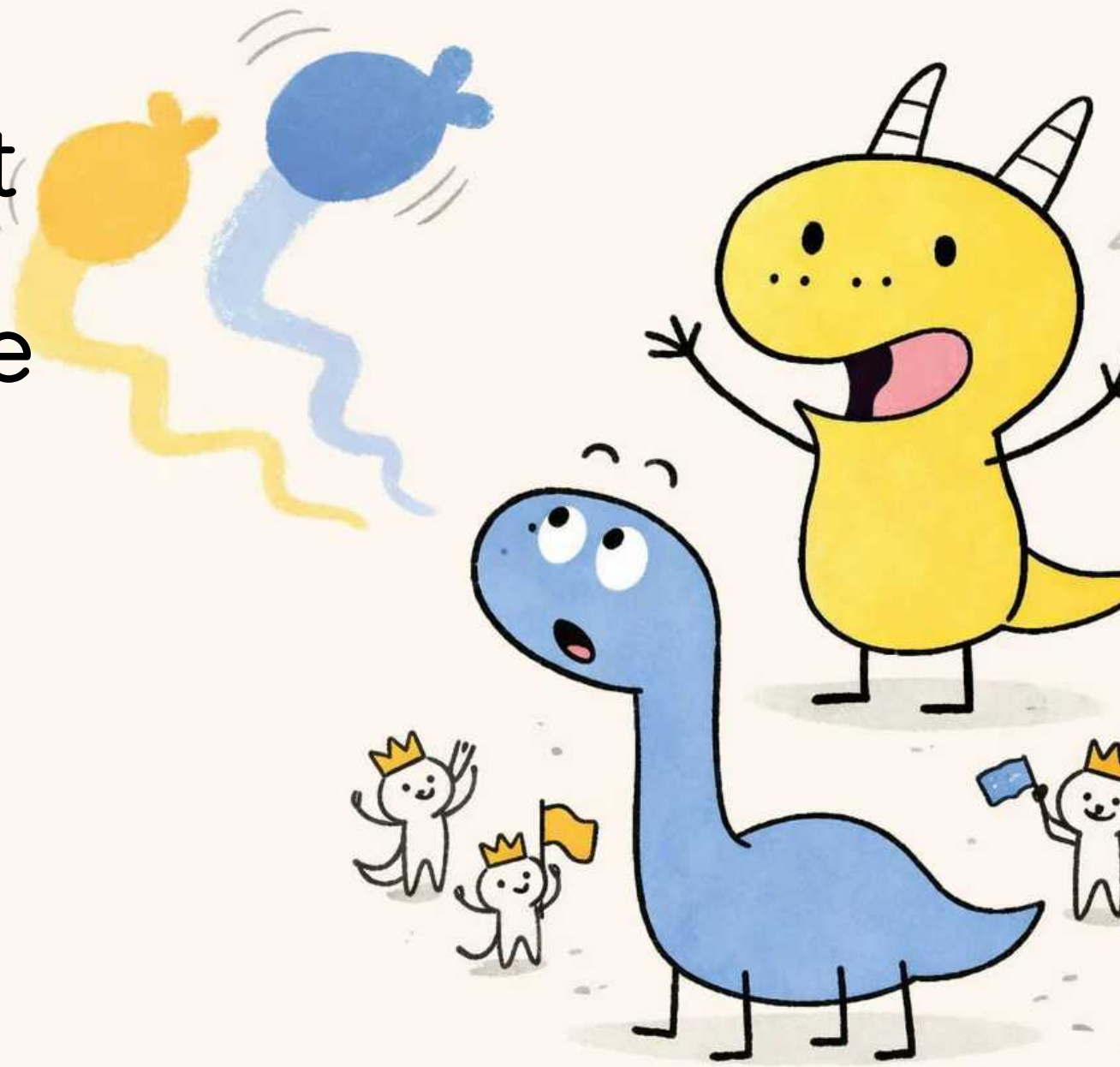
Let's mix

It's a wonderful shade of purple! When there is more red, it's a warm purple. When there is more blue, it's a cool purple.

Generally it's a cool colour.

But add a lot of yellow to warm it up.

And there you have it! Mix the primary pairs together, and you get secondary colours. So, what happens when you mix all three at once?

Don't Mix All Three!
