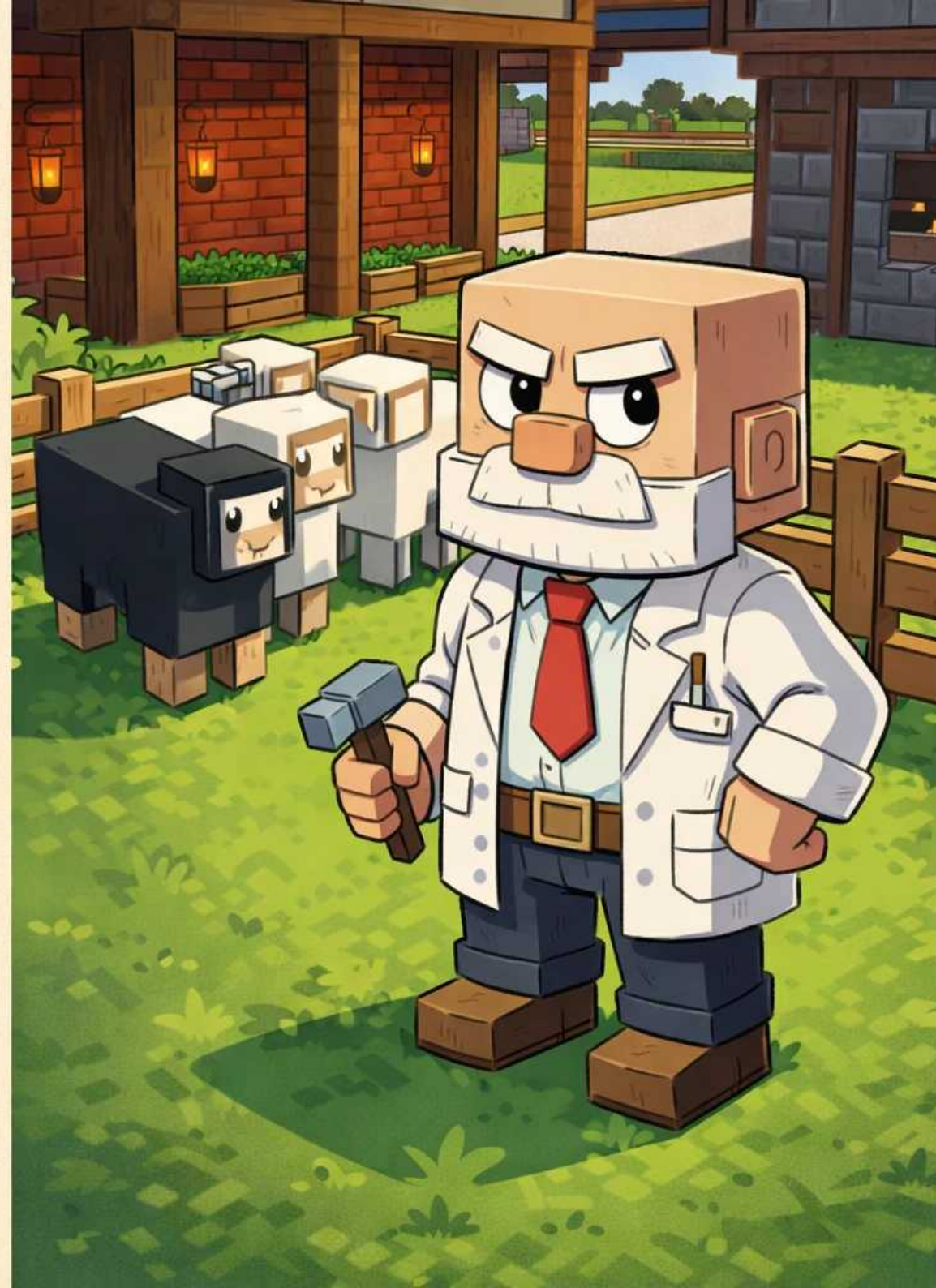


When Dr. Can Do arrived in the **village**, he had a **huge** idea. He could make every home better than before.
