

Jim And His Big Brag

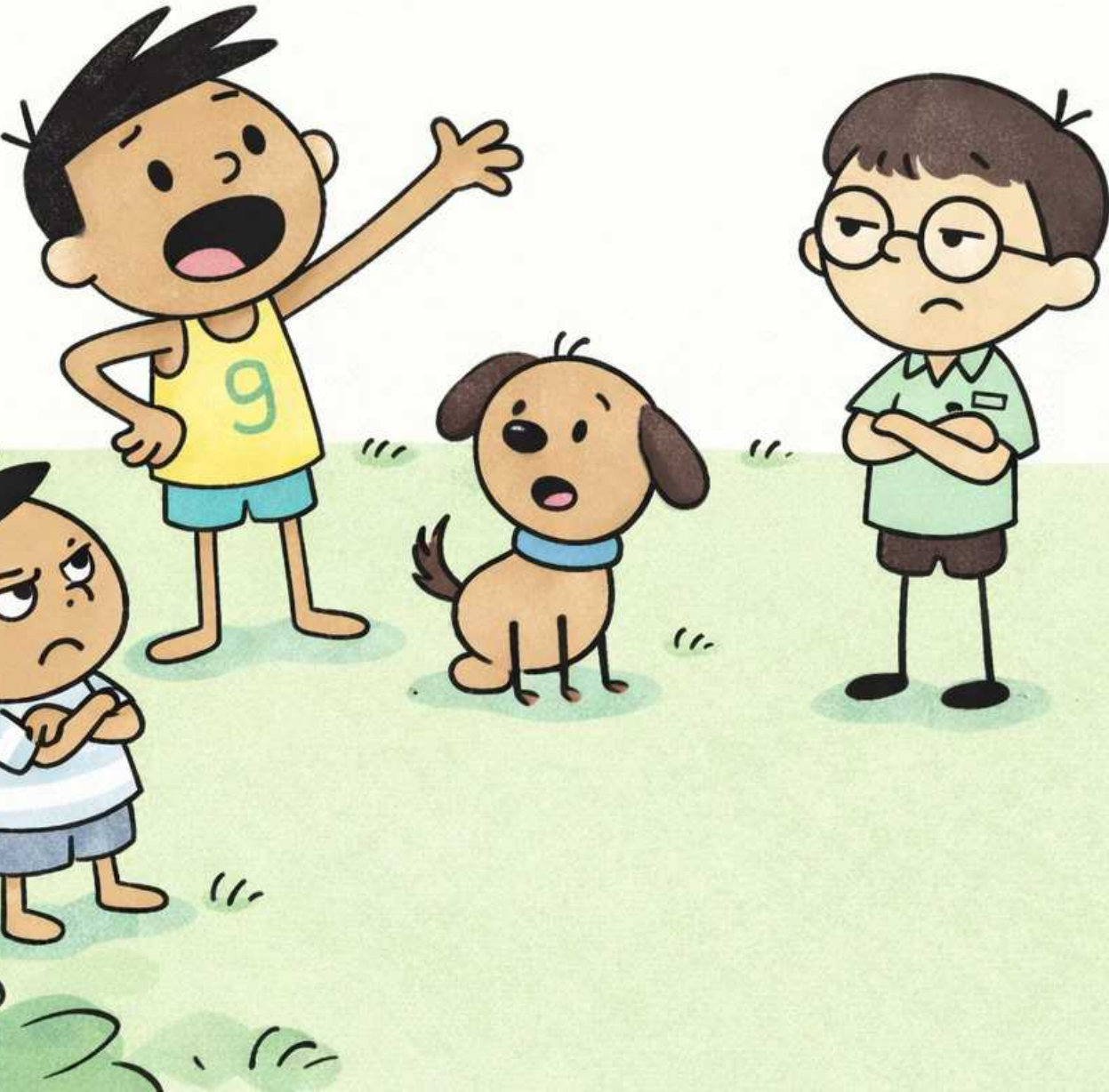




Jim and his

is a ship.

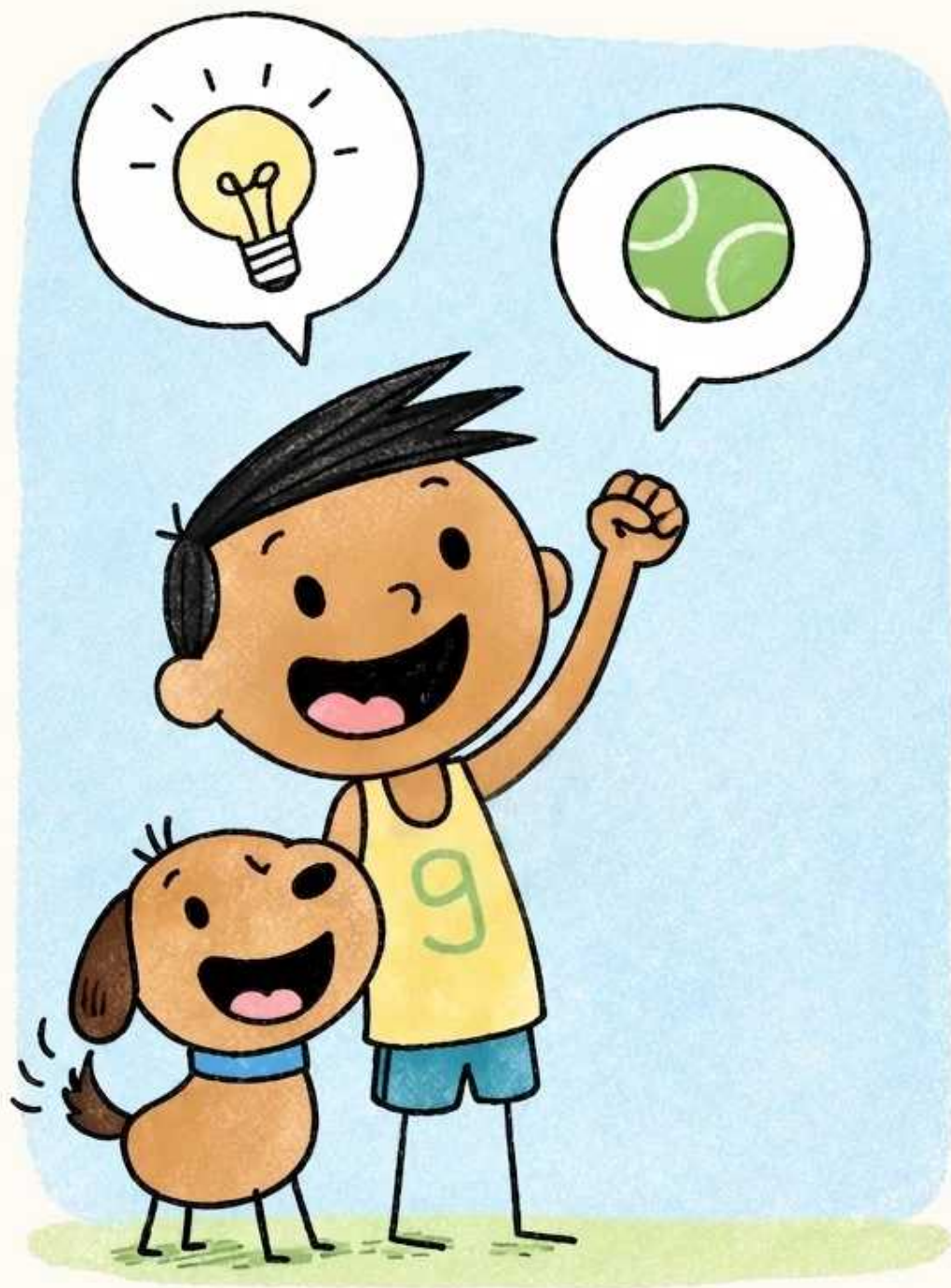




Jim says
