like a zoo!

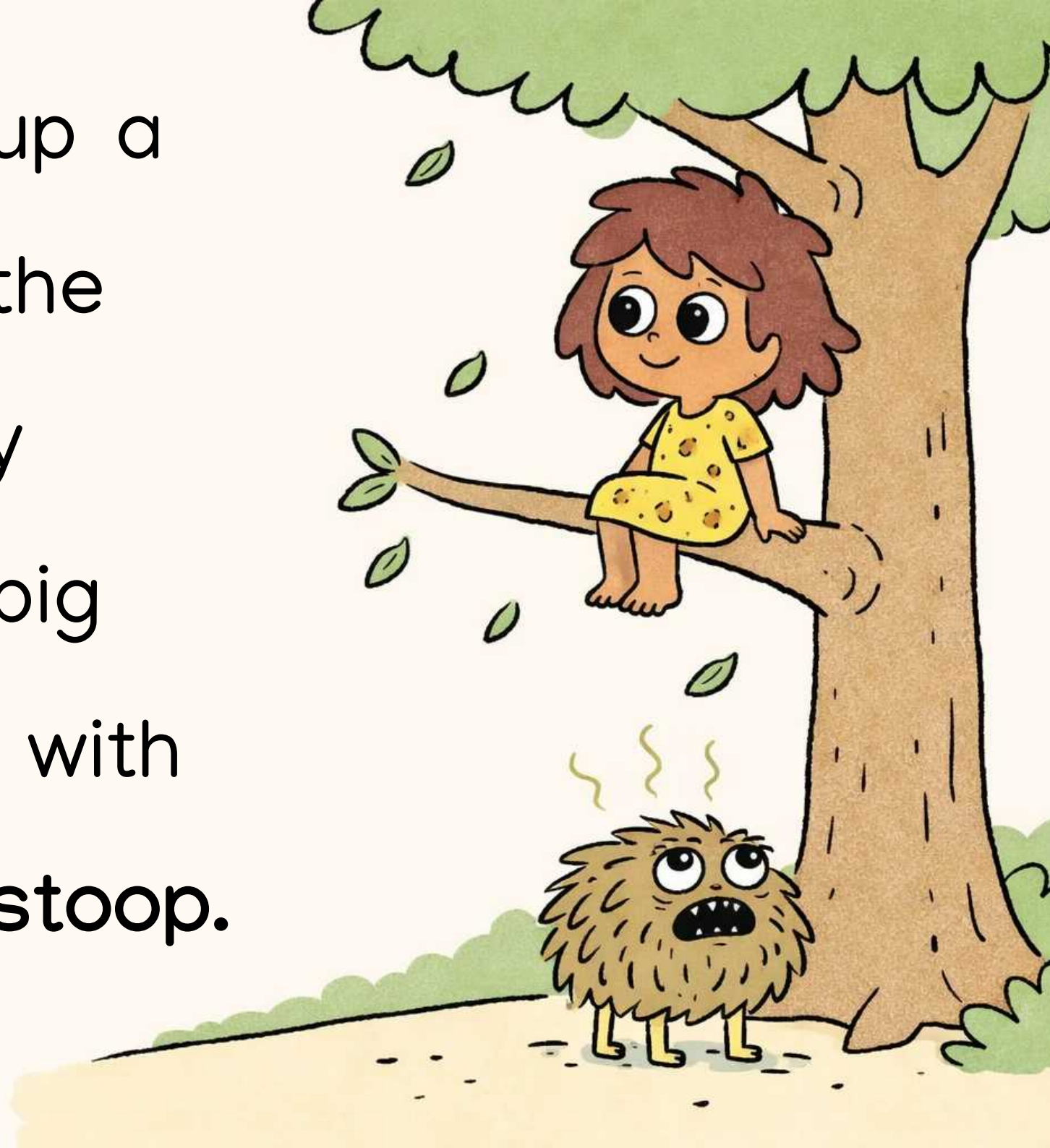
Pig scoots from
