frog.

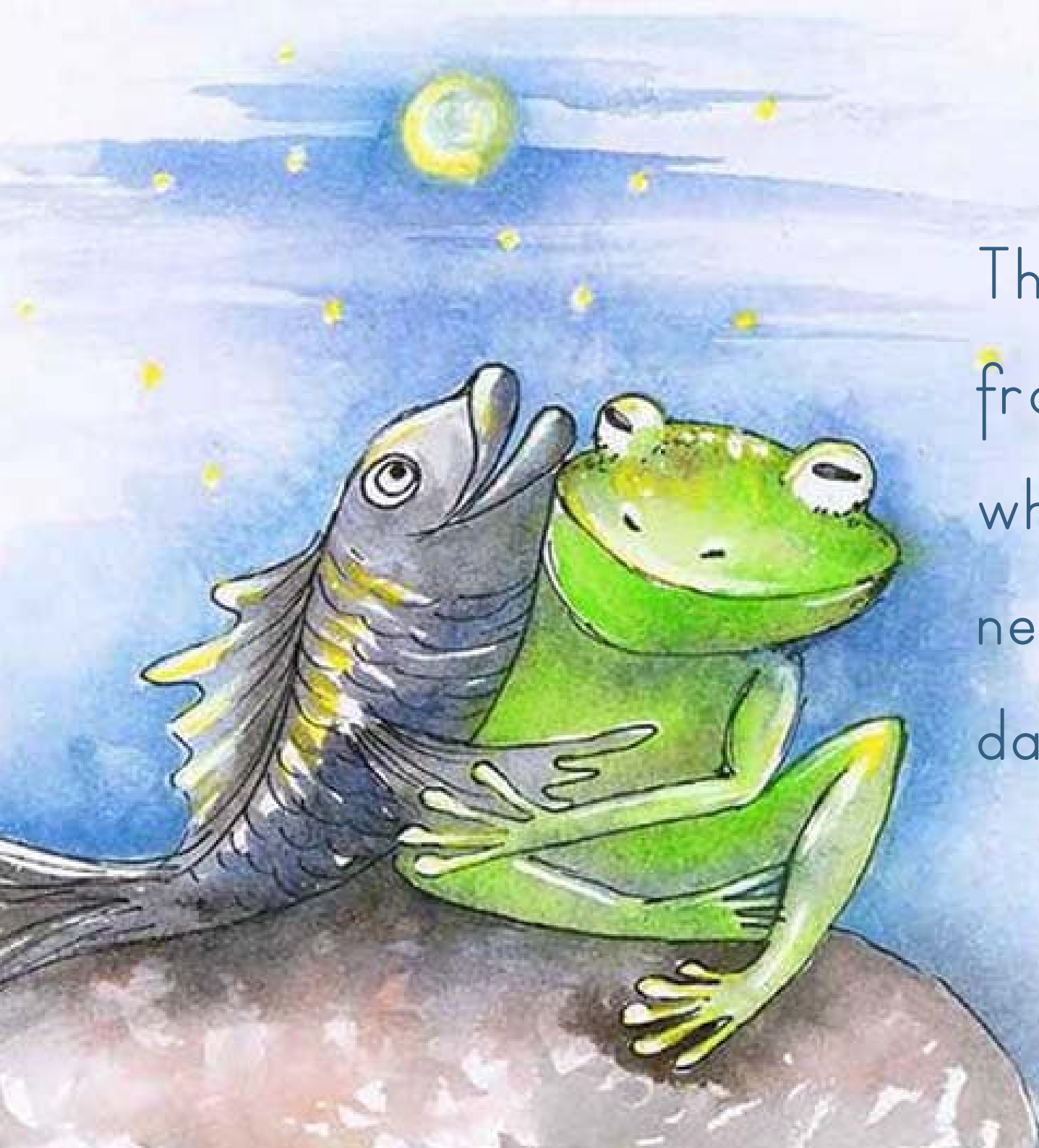


The frog does not

how to swim.

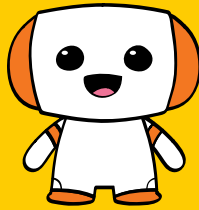




They have a great day. The frog can watch the fish and then move the same way.
