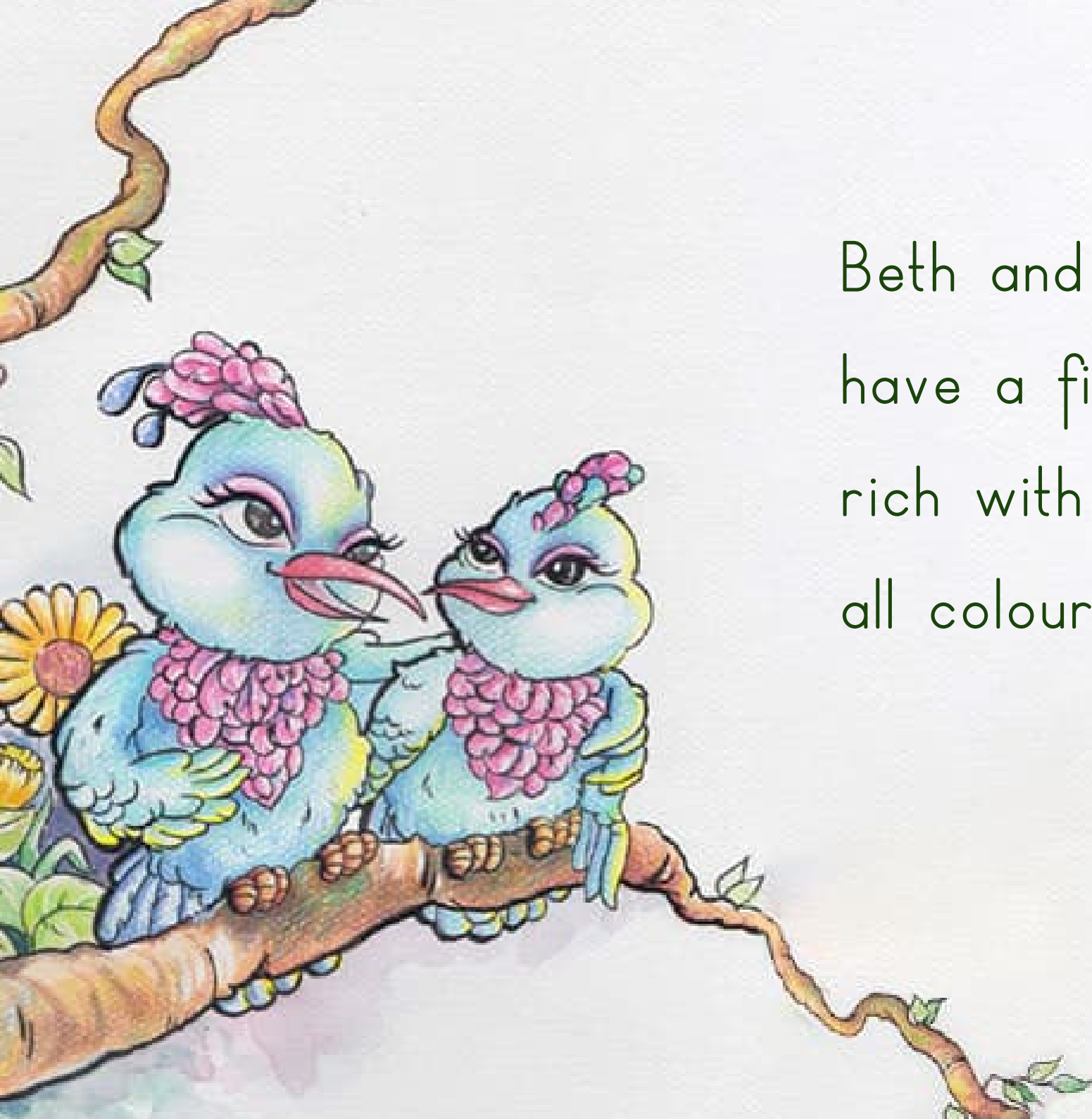


FLOWER HUNT
