float on the breeze.





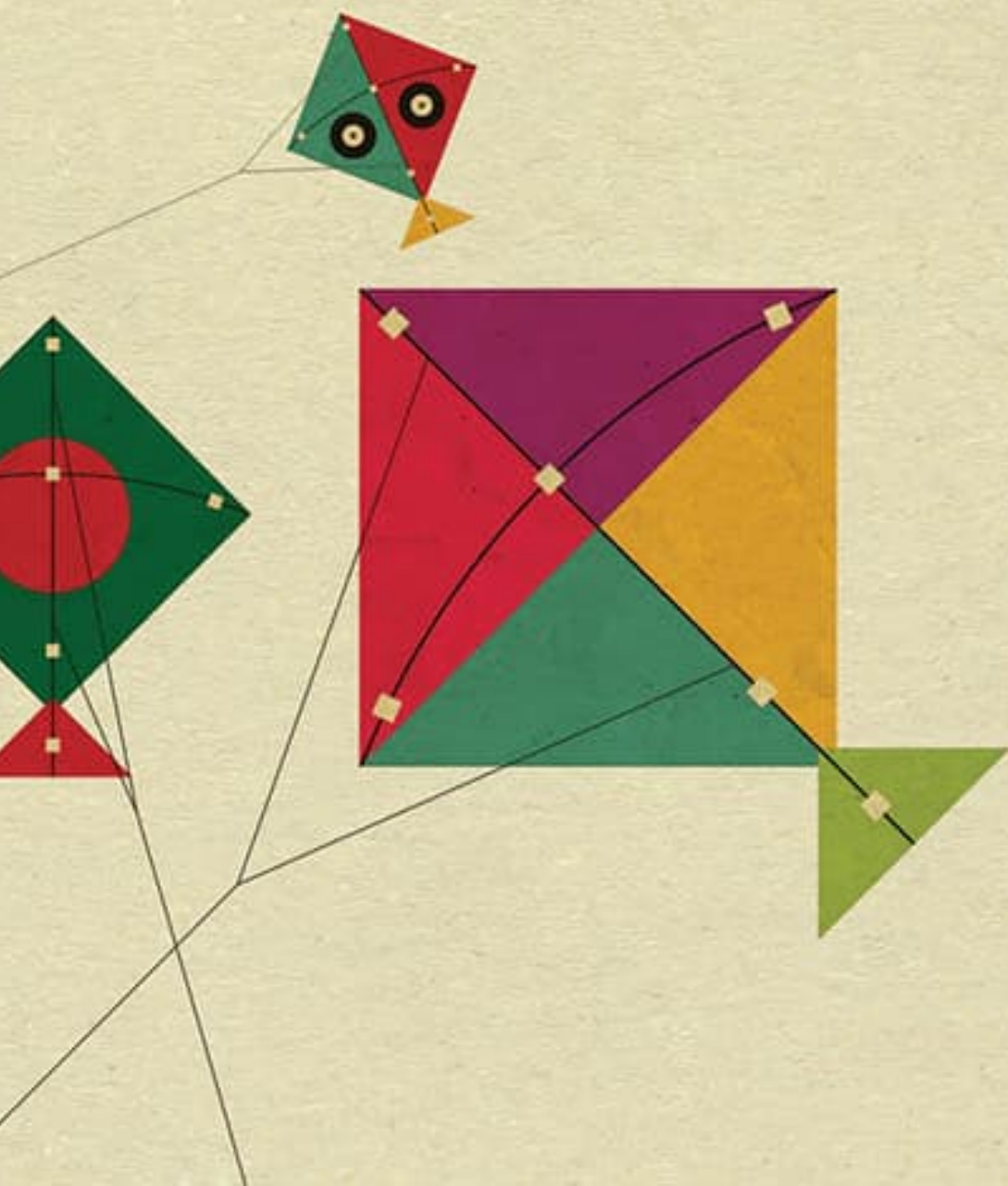
Are there things with no

sky.

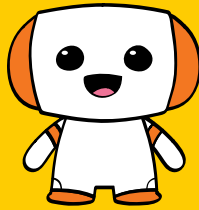
We are not kites.
