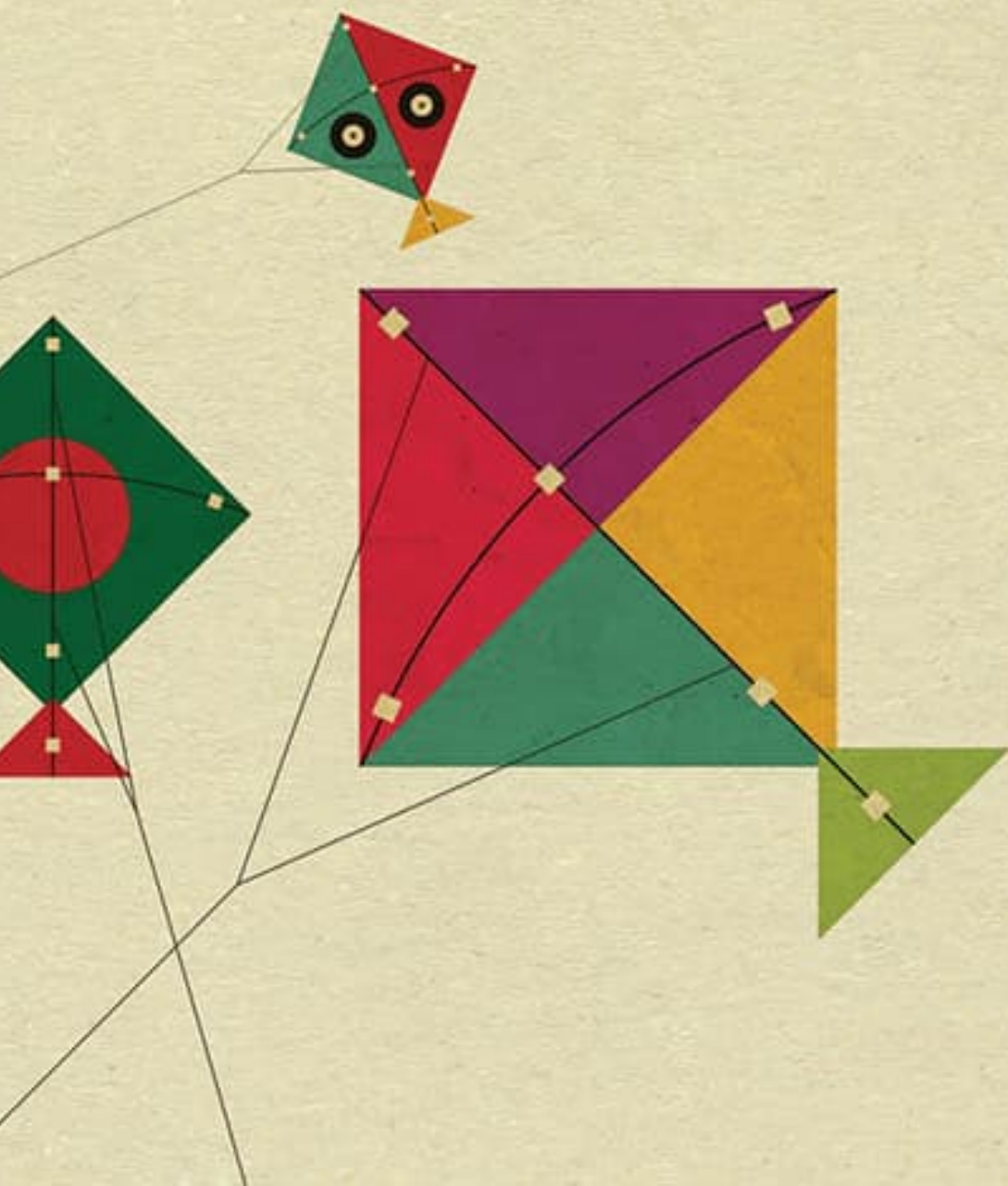

clouds.

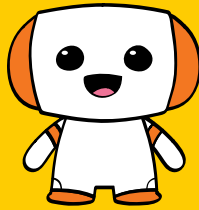
