

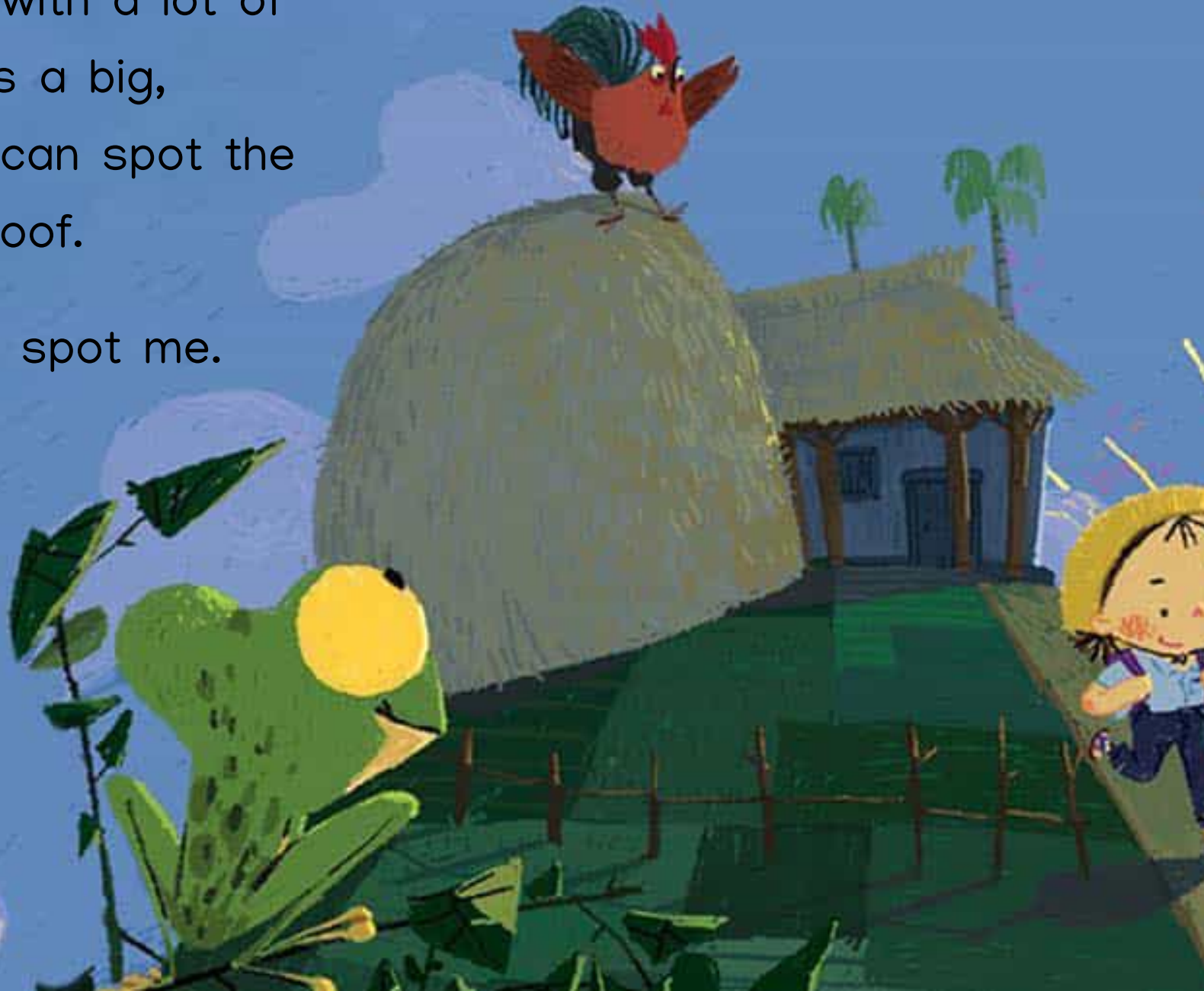
I Can Spot ...

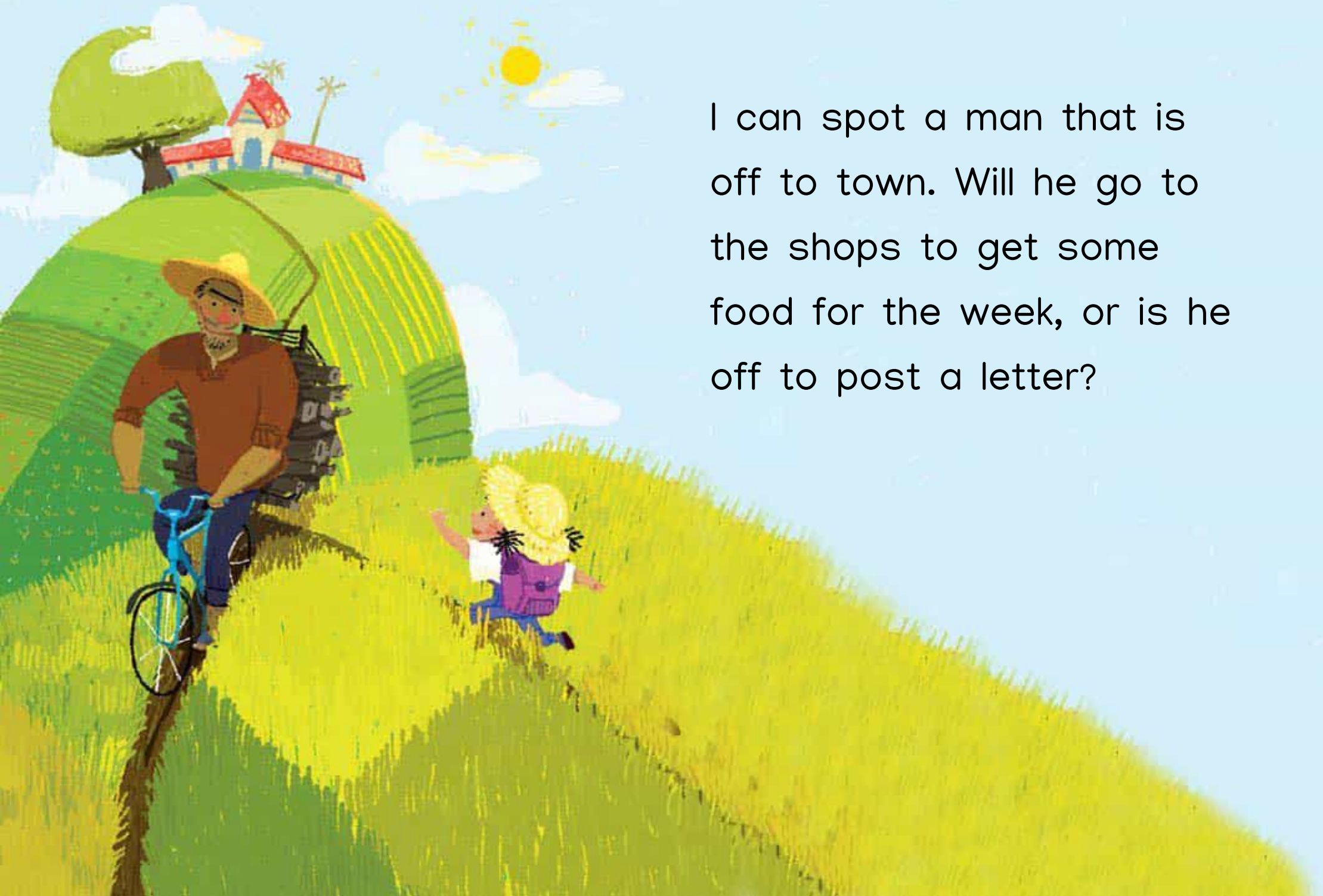

The rooster can spot me.

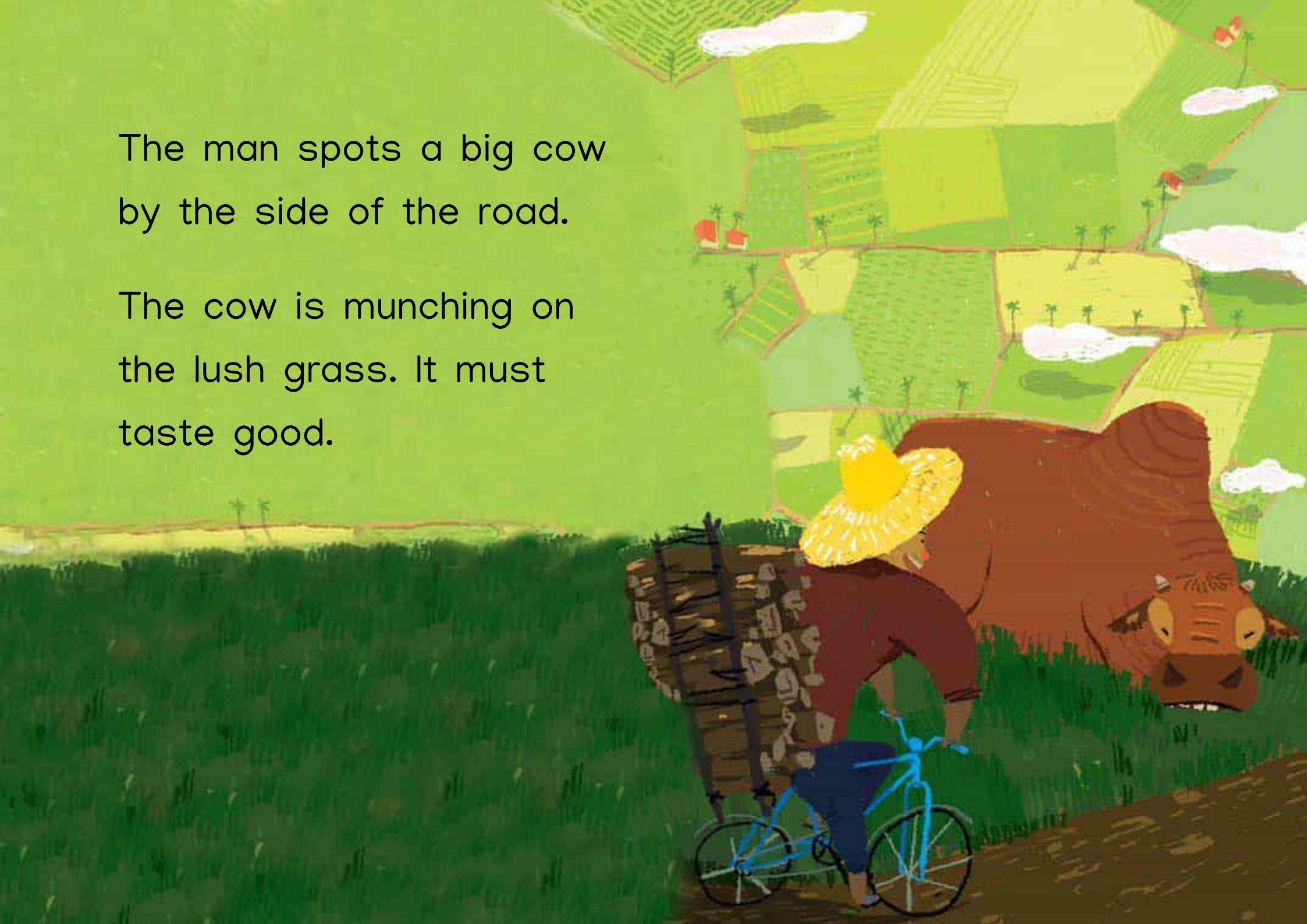


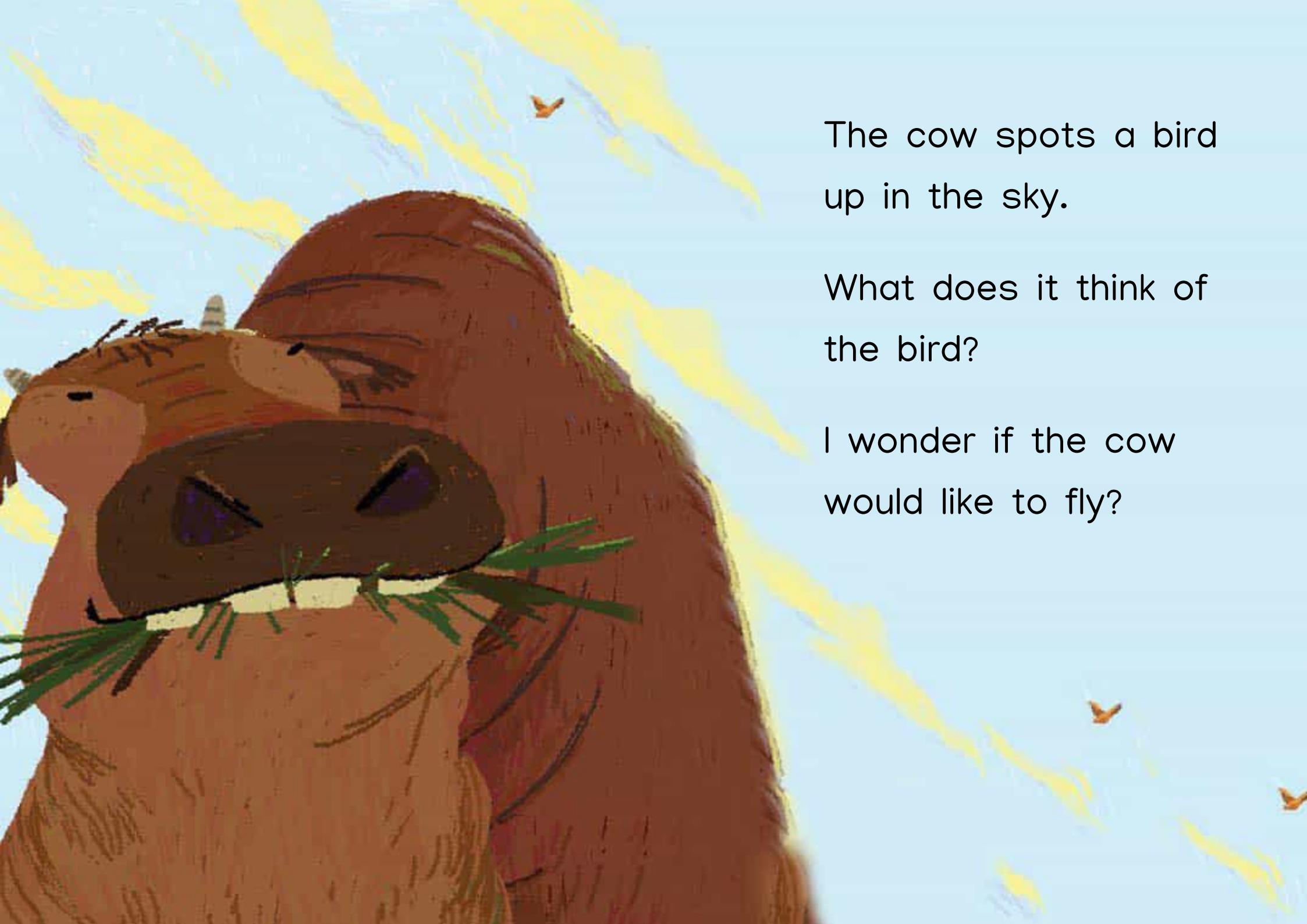


I can spot a man that is

taste good.



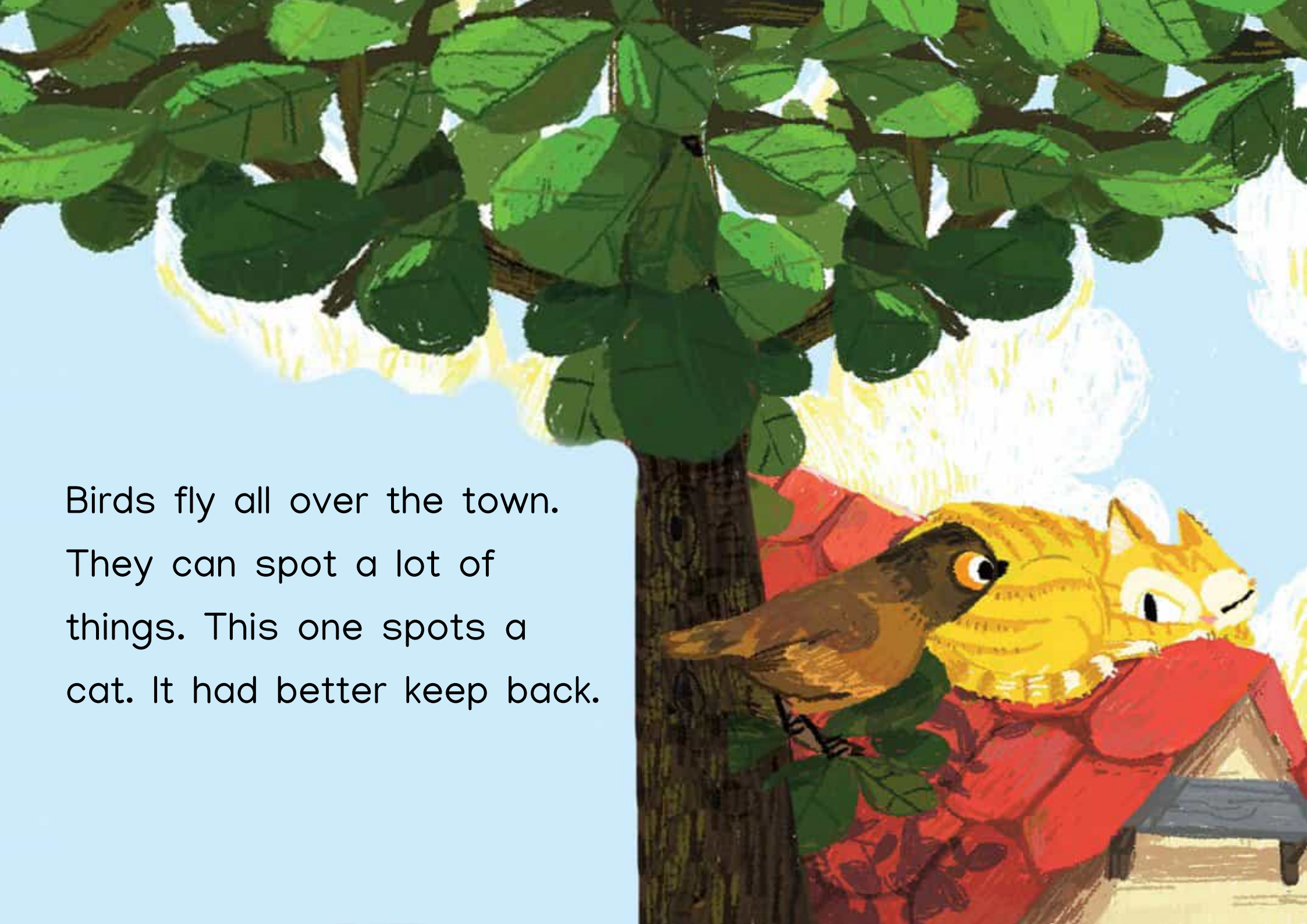


The cow spots a bird

Do they have their own animals and crops?

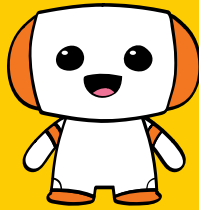
