

I Found It in the Cave!

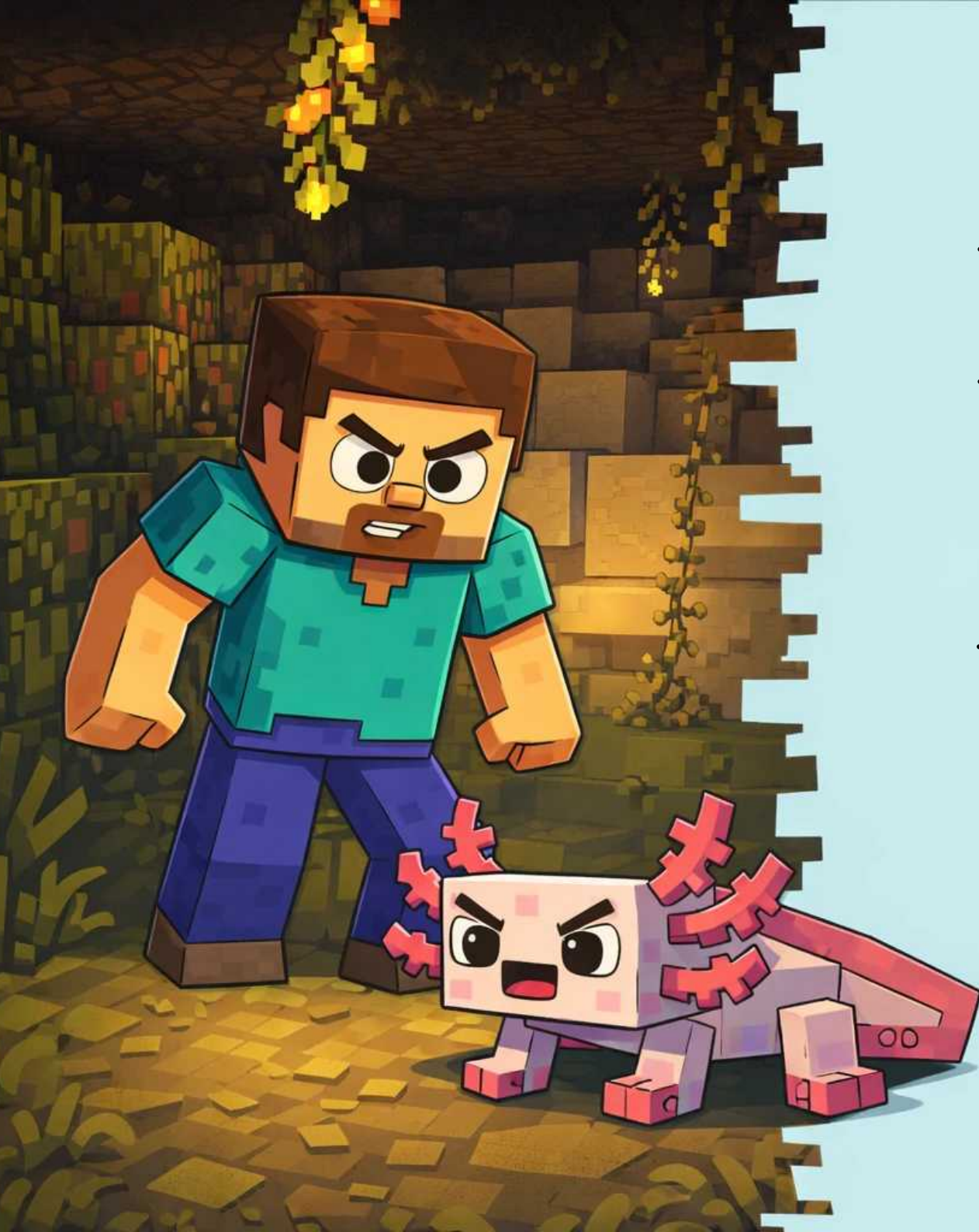


An Unofficial Minecraft Book

could have found!



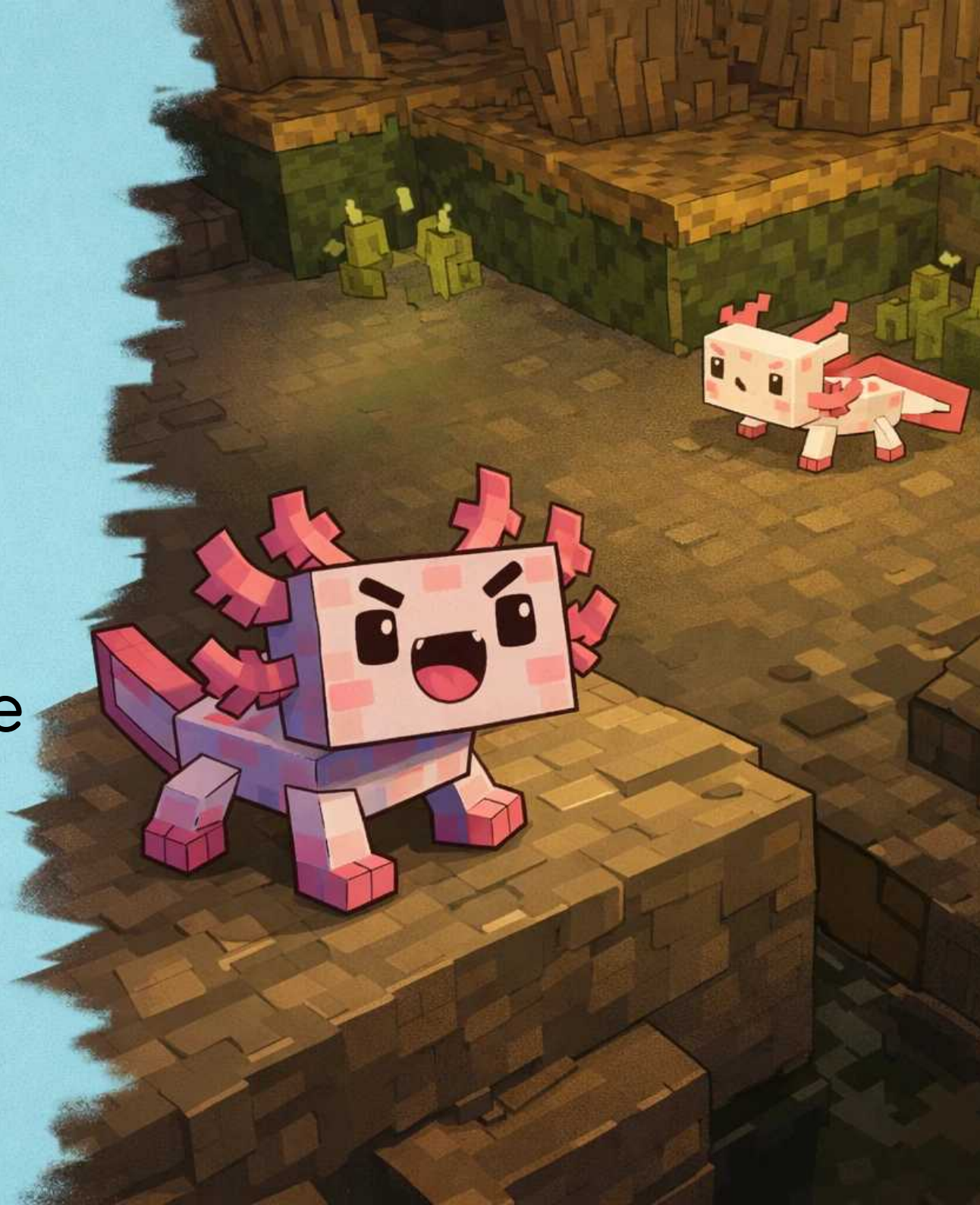


The pond looks dull, so I
