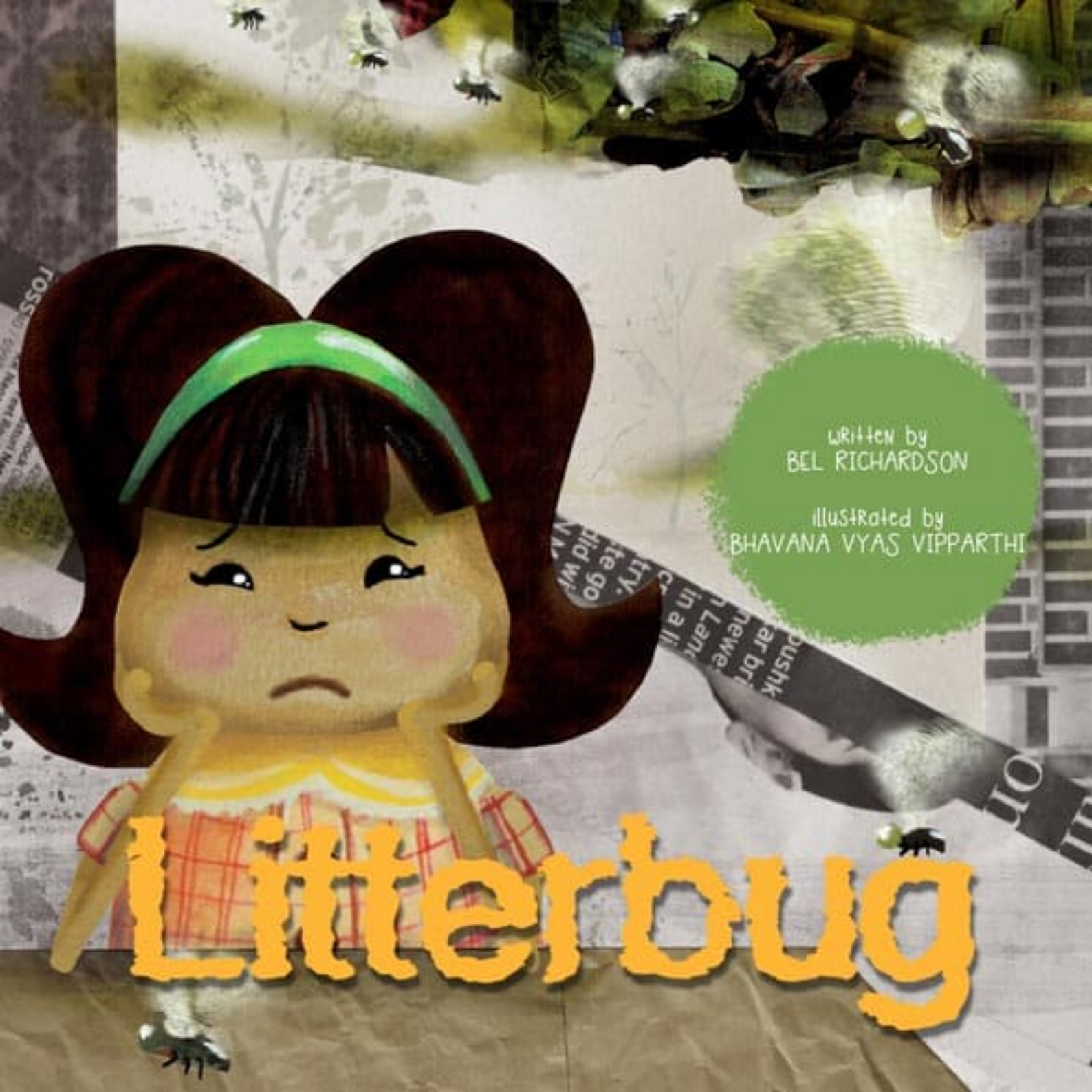

stop.

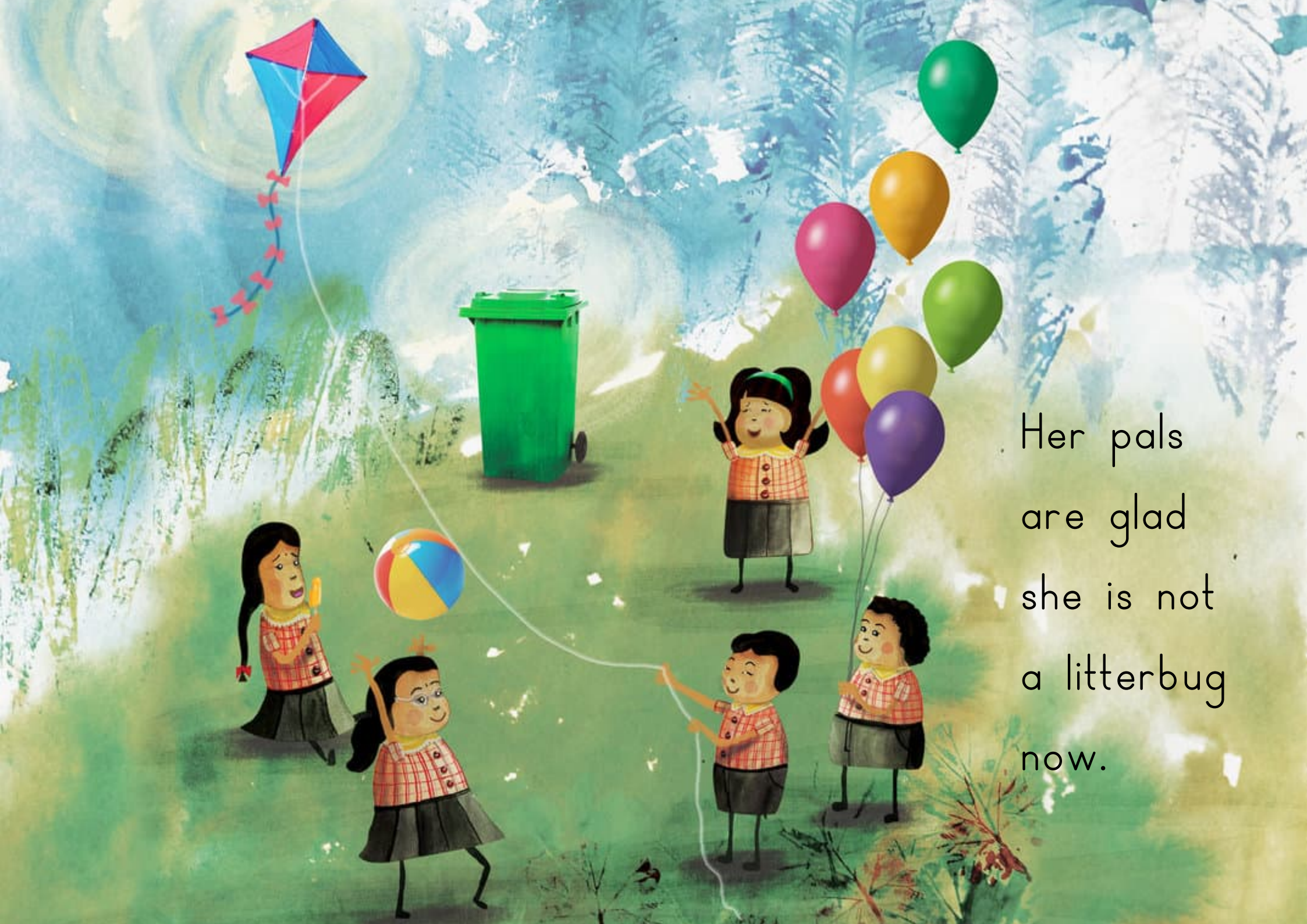


Di gets all of the
