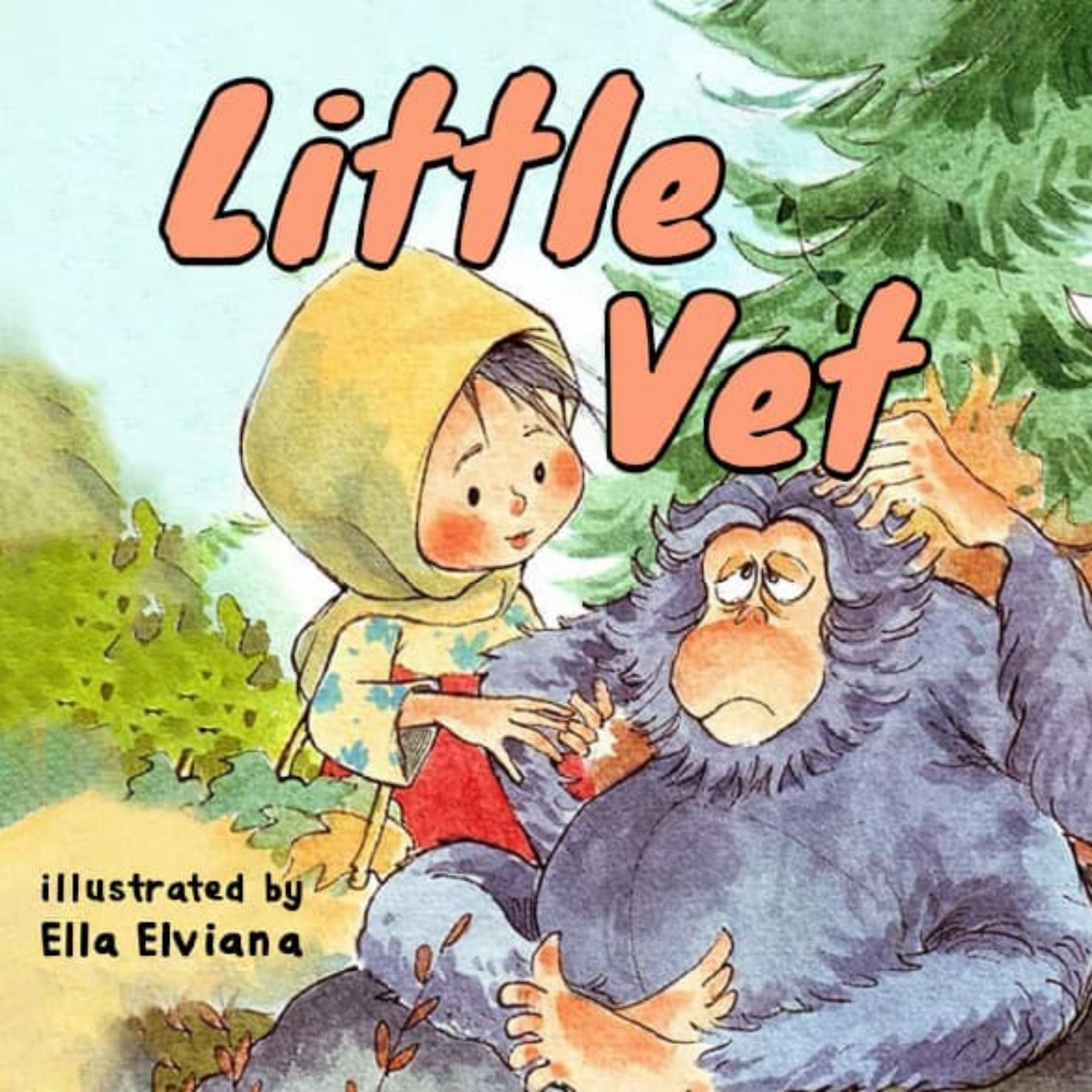

same trap.

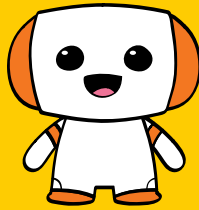
But while she
