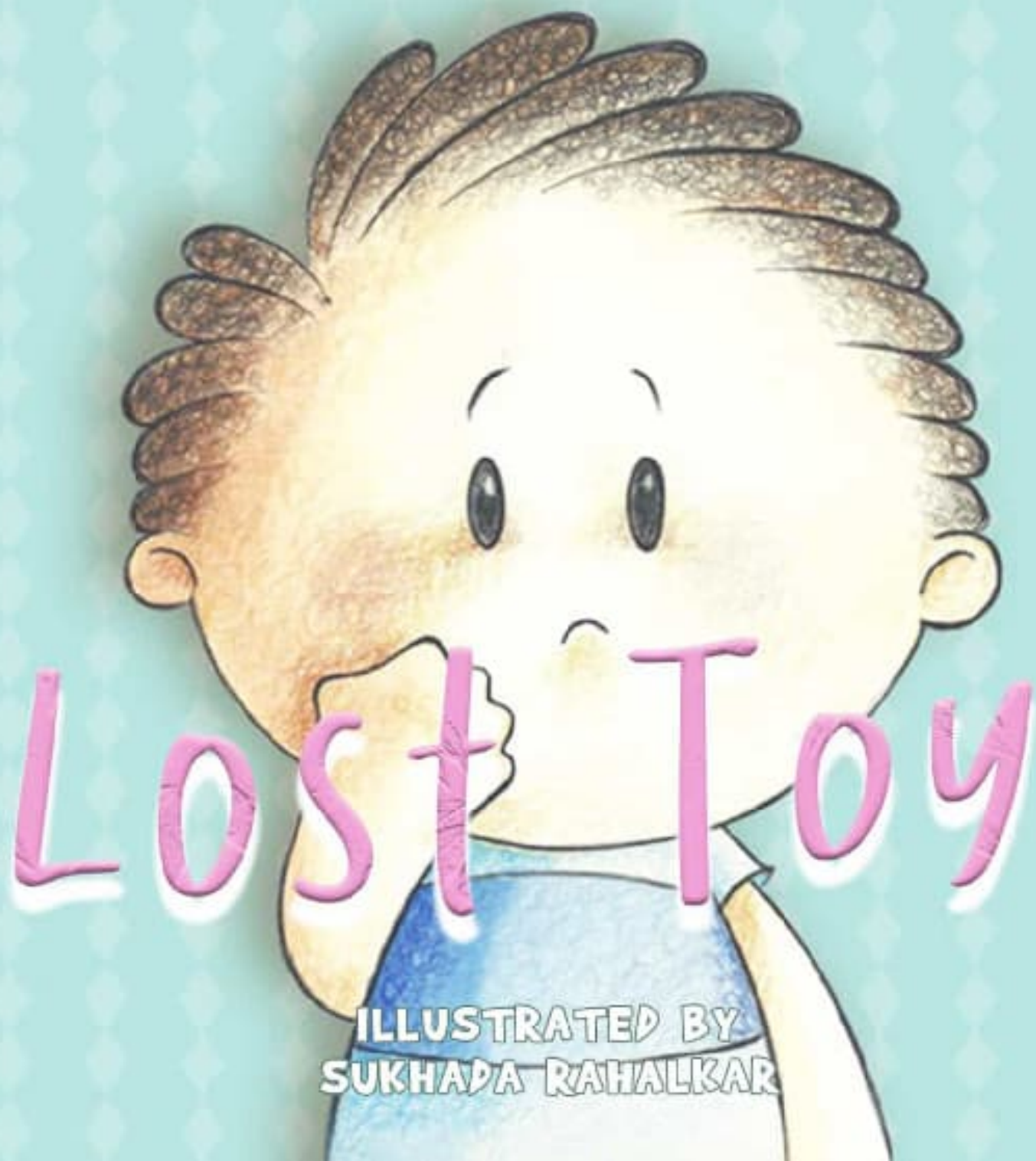

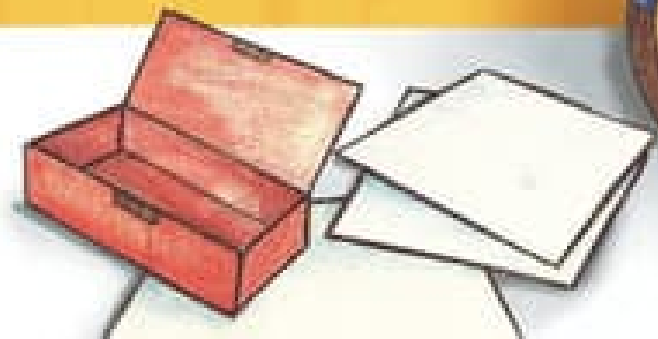

It is in her hand.



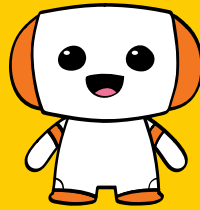


I am glad.
