It might be here.

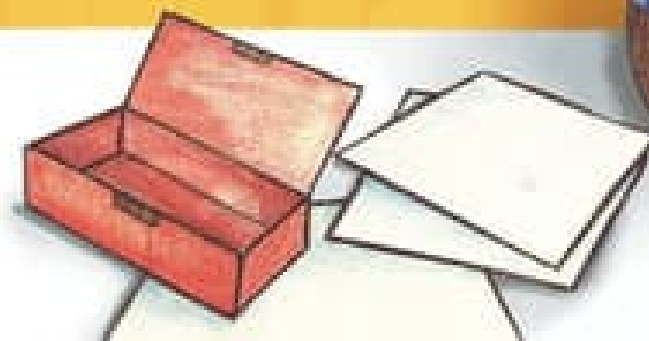
No!
