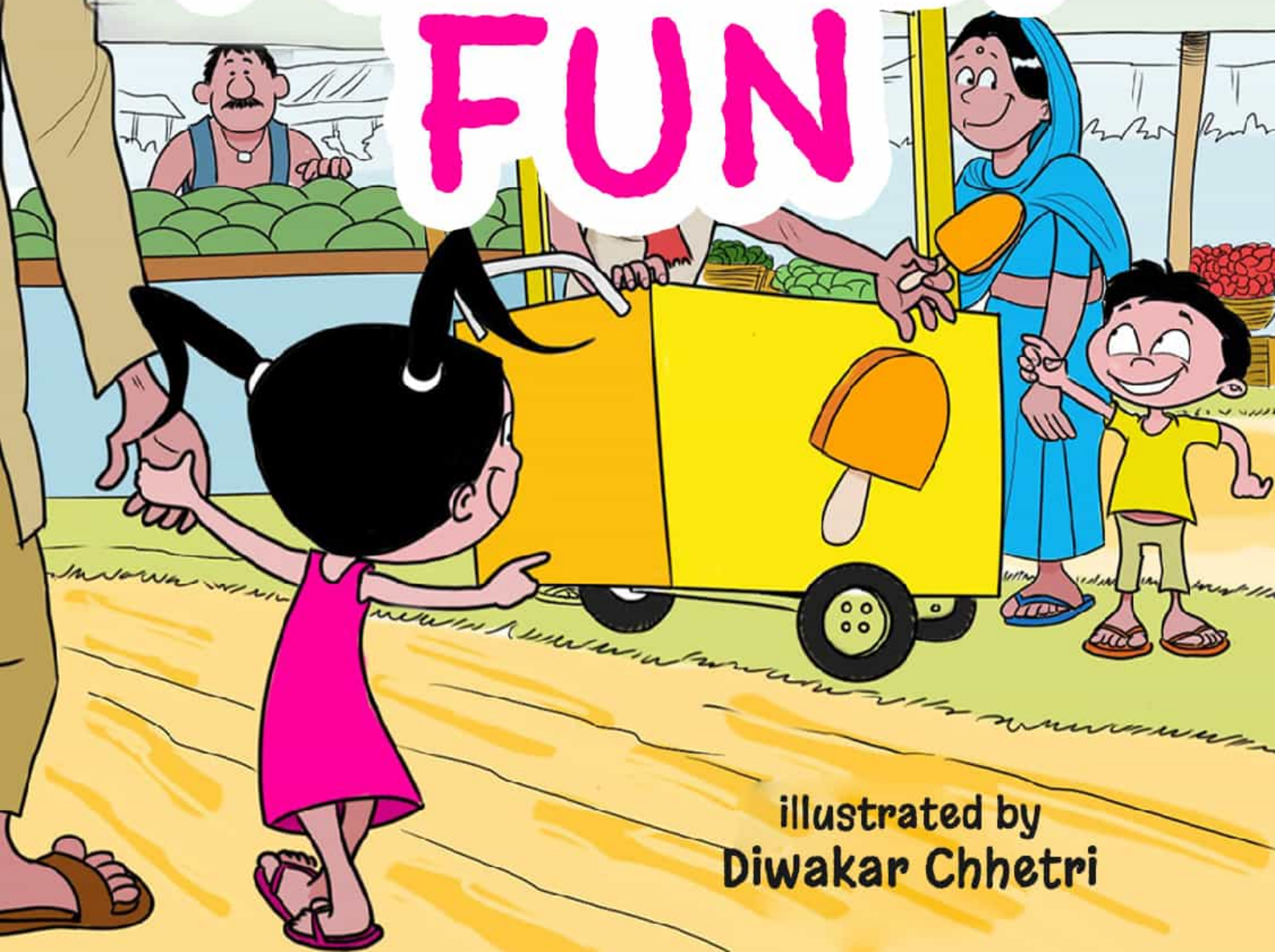
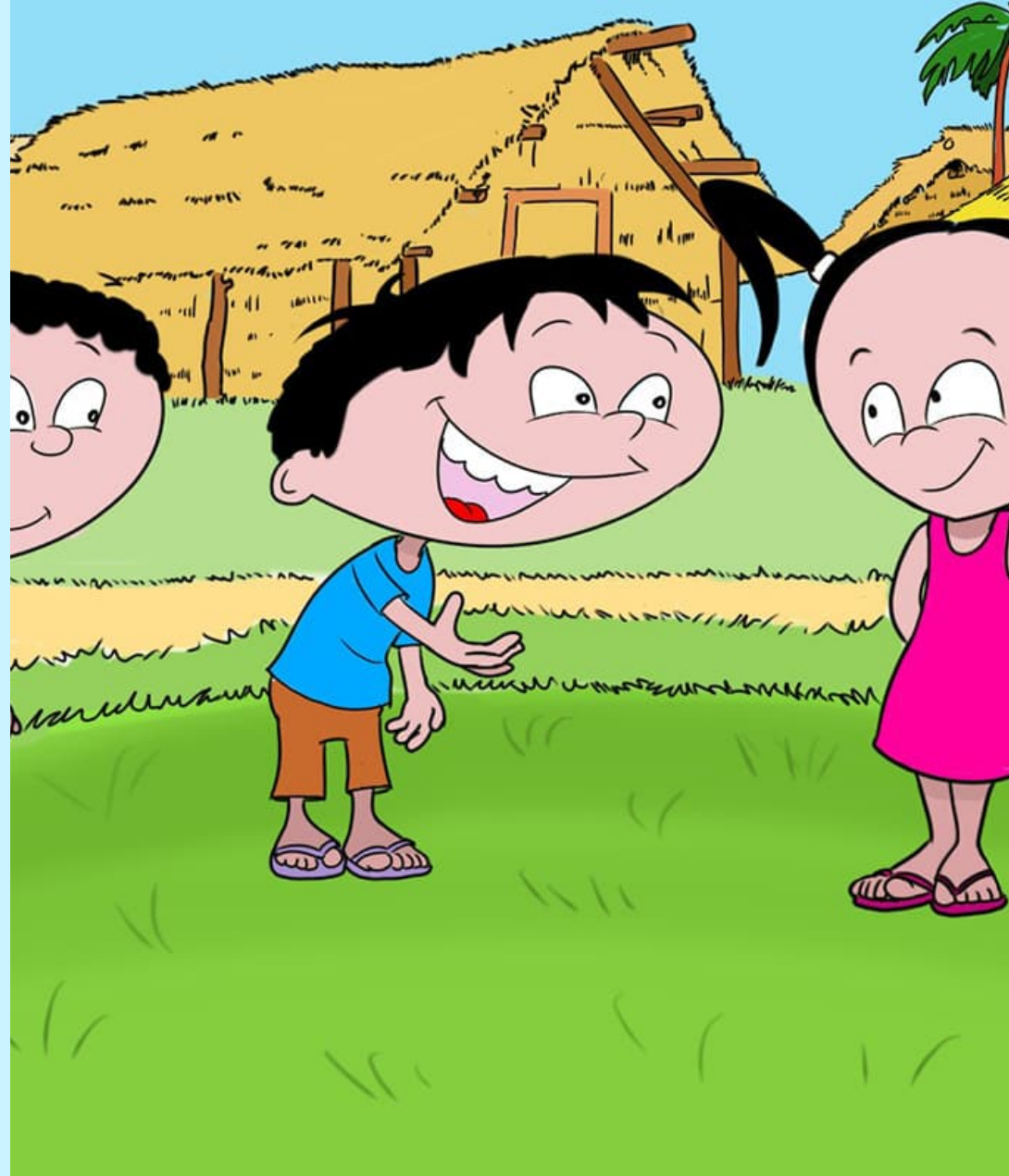


MARKET FUN

What were you doing?



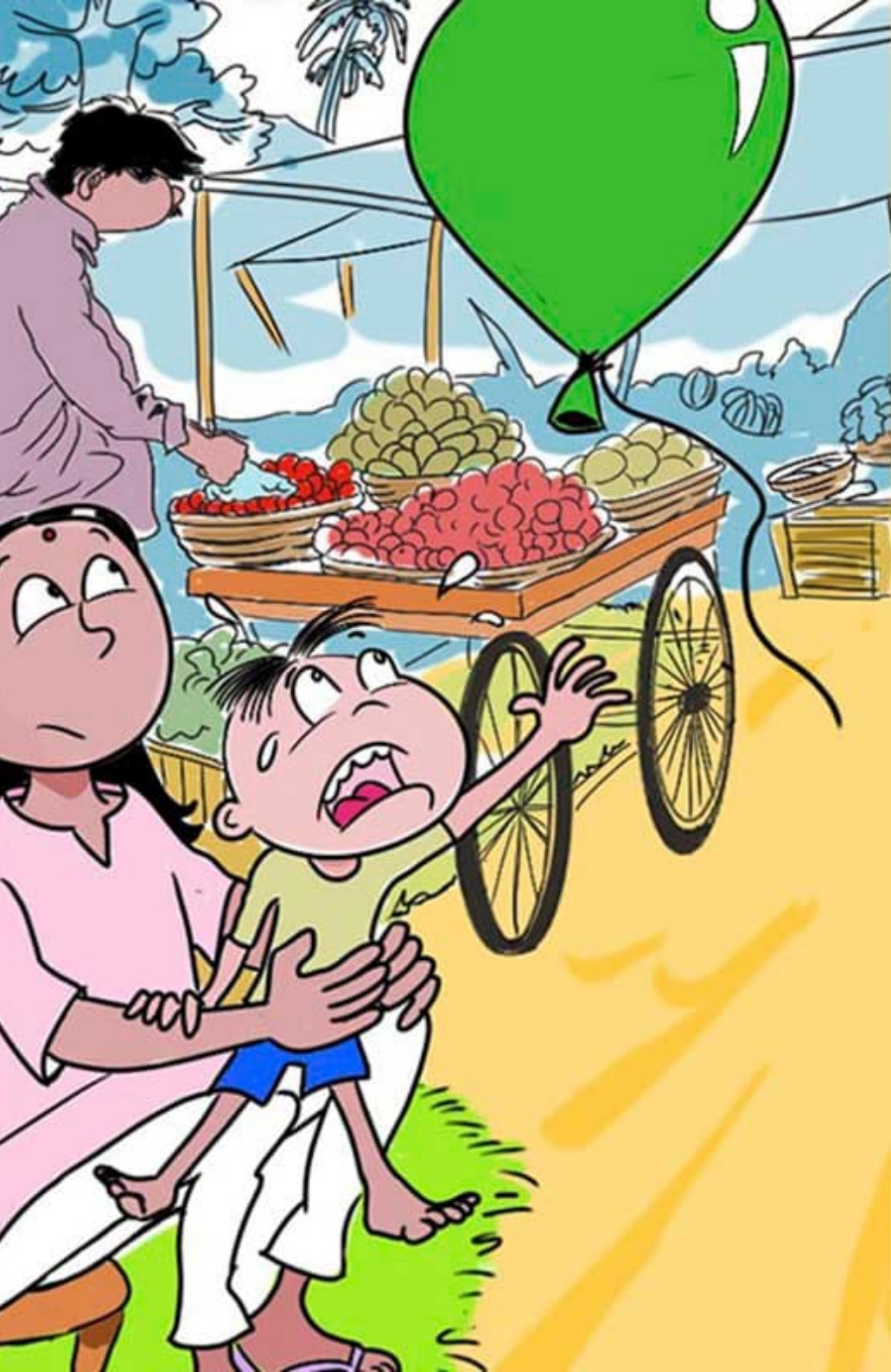
I went to the city with my dad, and he took me to a market.

And there were so many stalls selling all kinds of things like fancy fabric and a nice yellow skirt.



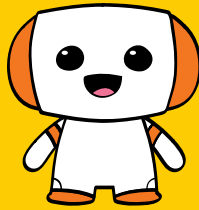
I wanted to try on the sun glasses, but dad said my fingers were sticky, and I shouldn't touch.
