tests.



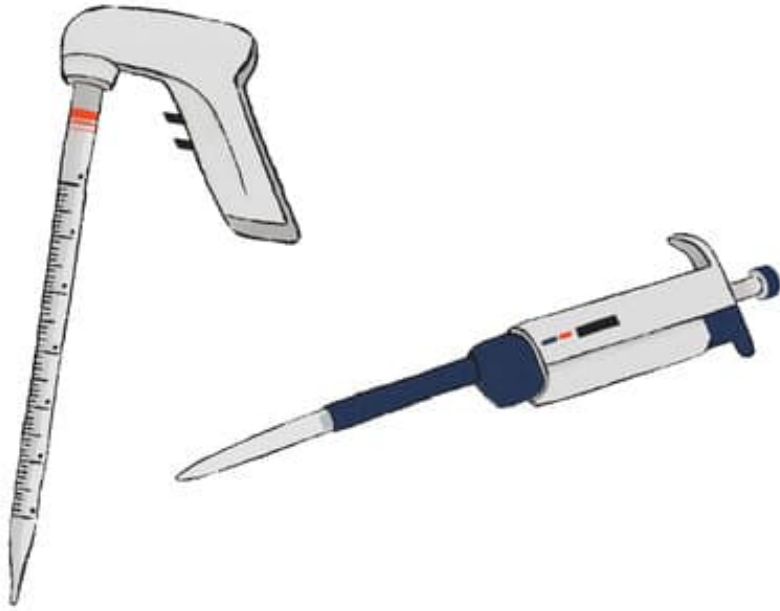
Zara takes notes on her tests. She starts to rule out some microbes.

her tests a few times.

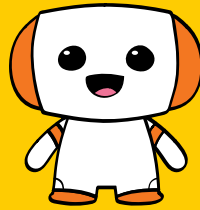


She talks to a work pal. He will do
