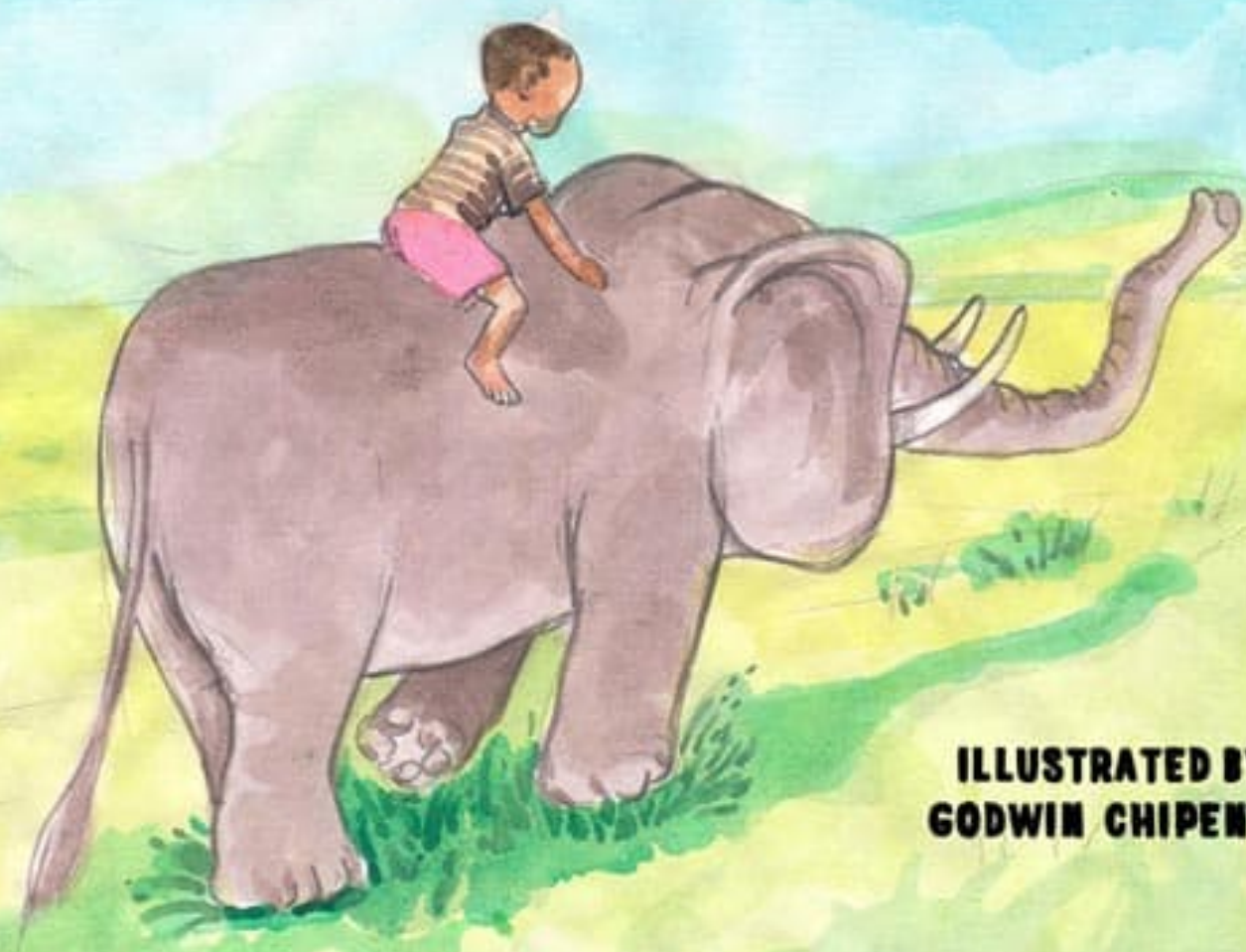


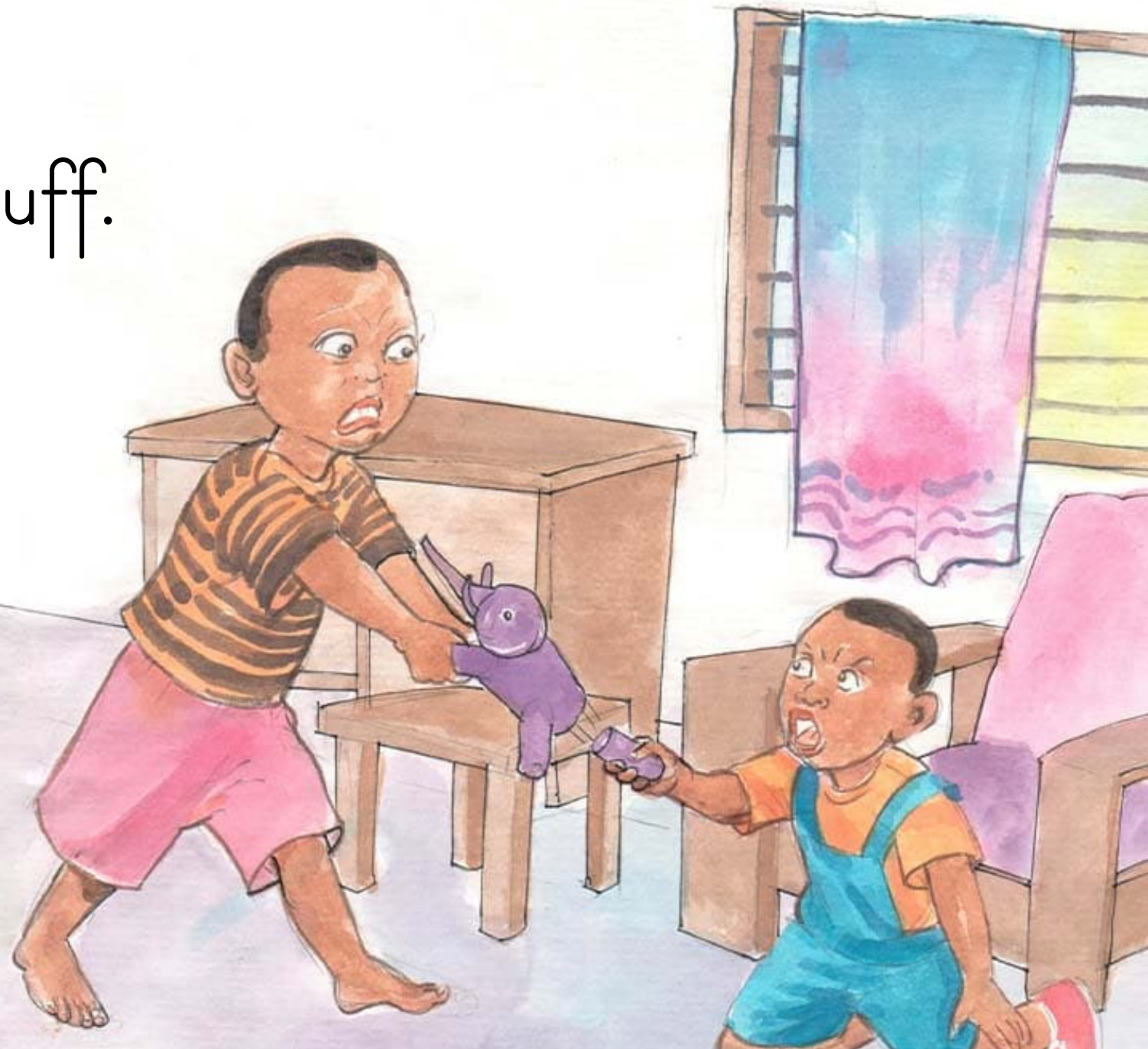

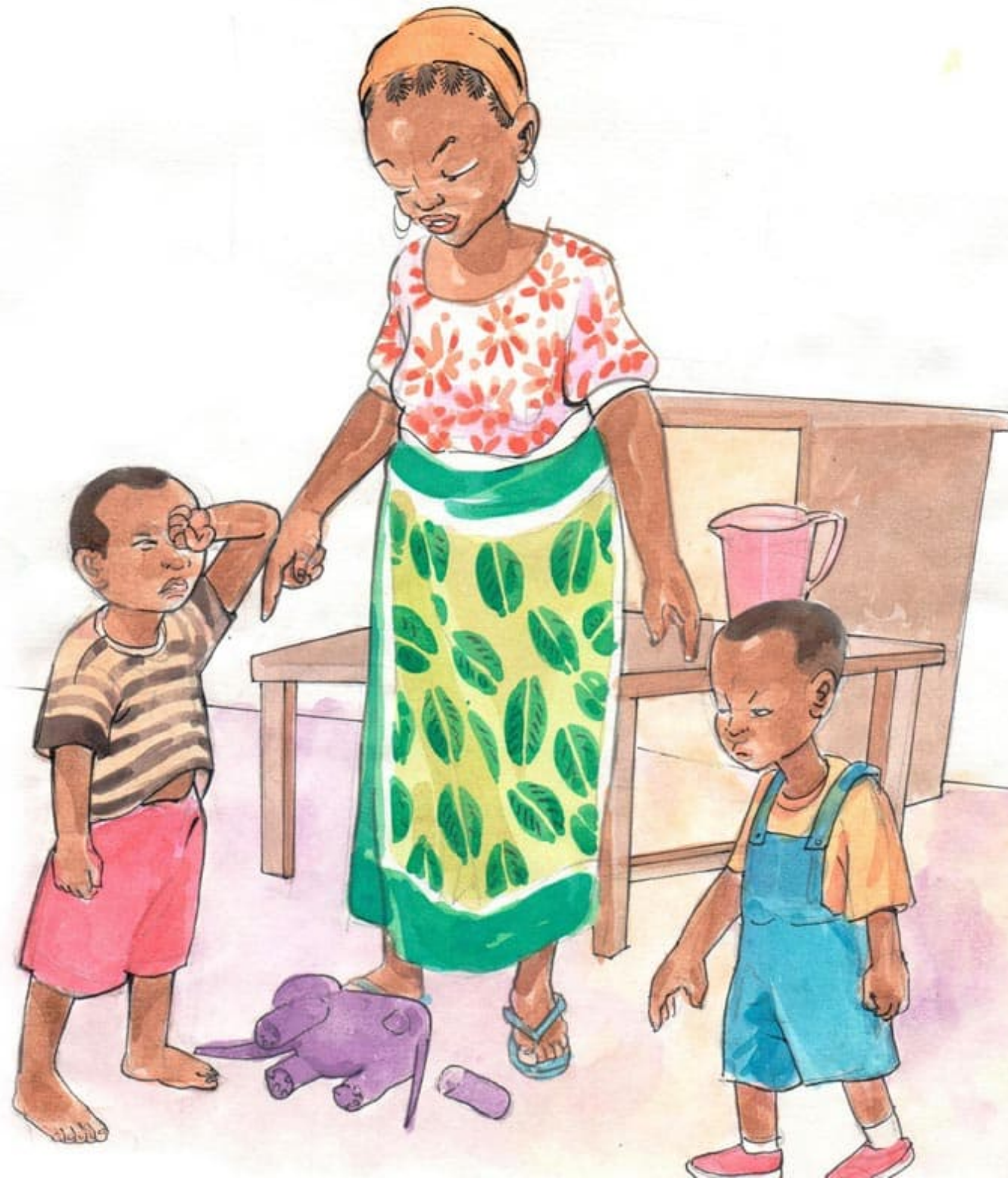

to bed.



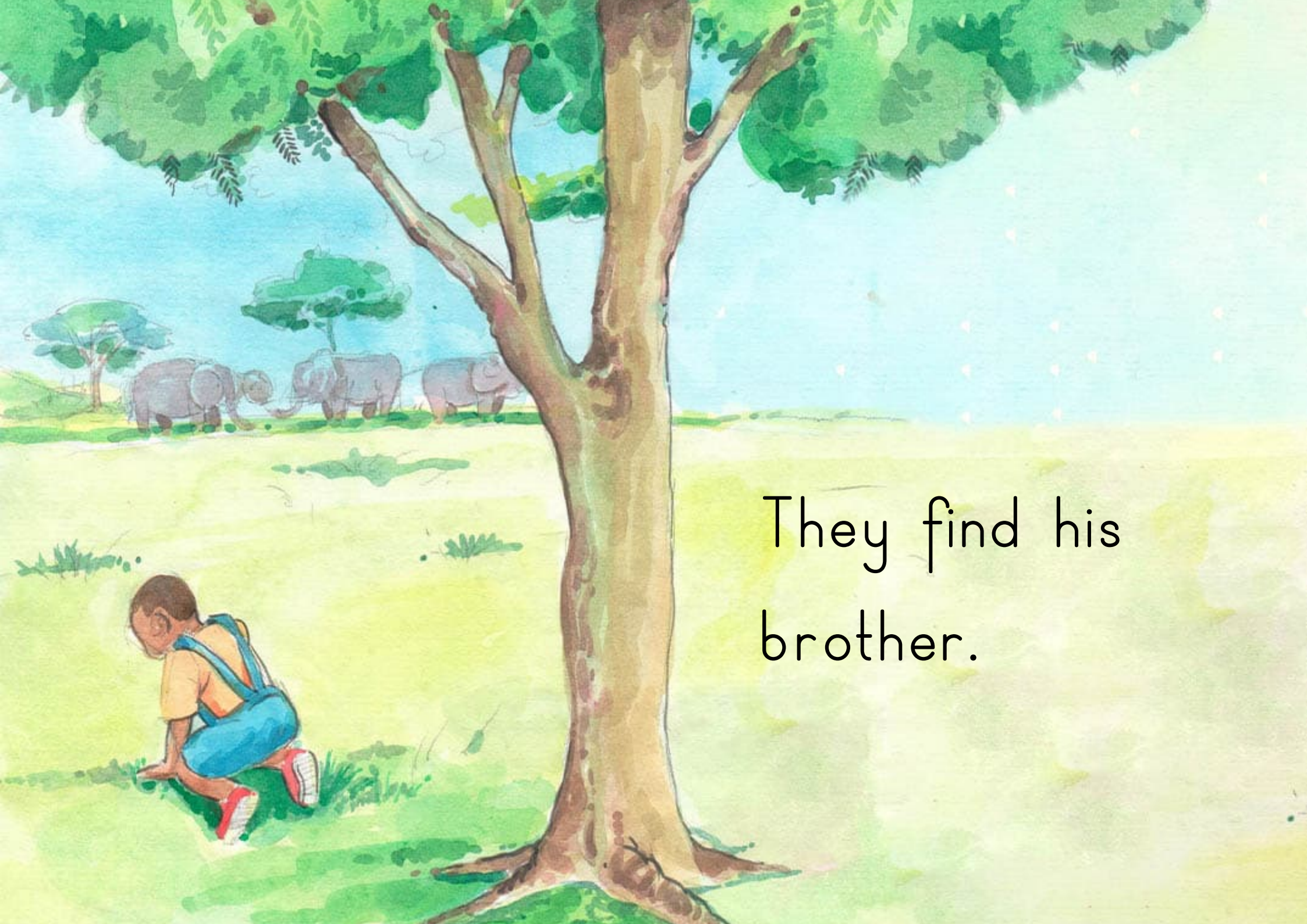
He gets up.

brother.



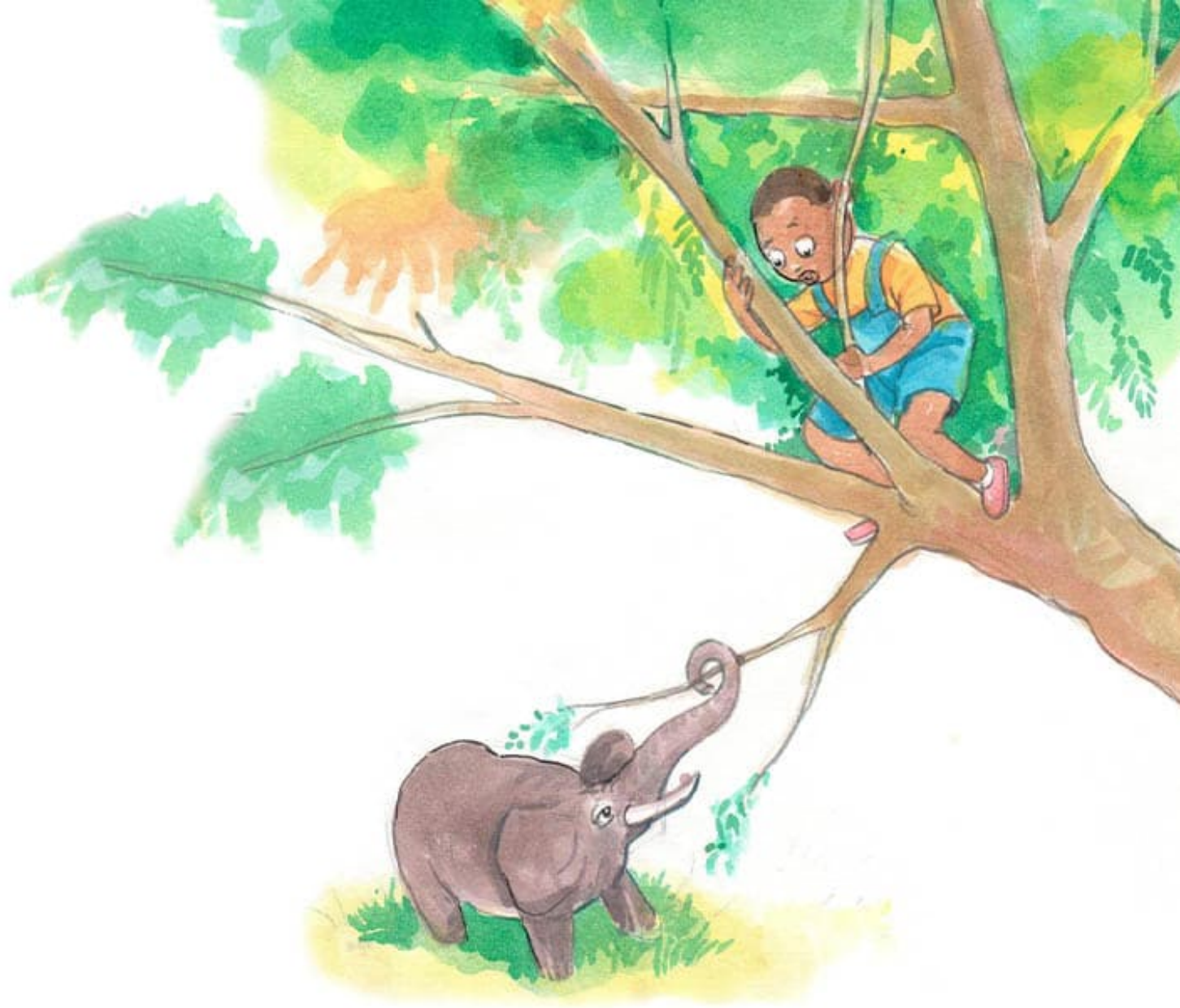


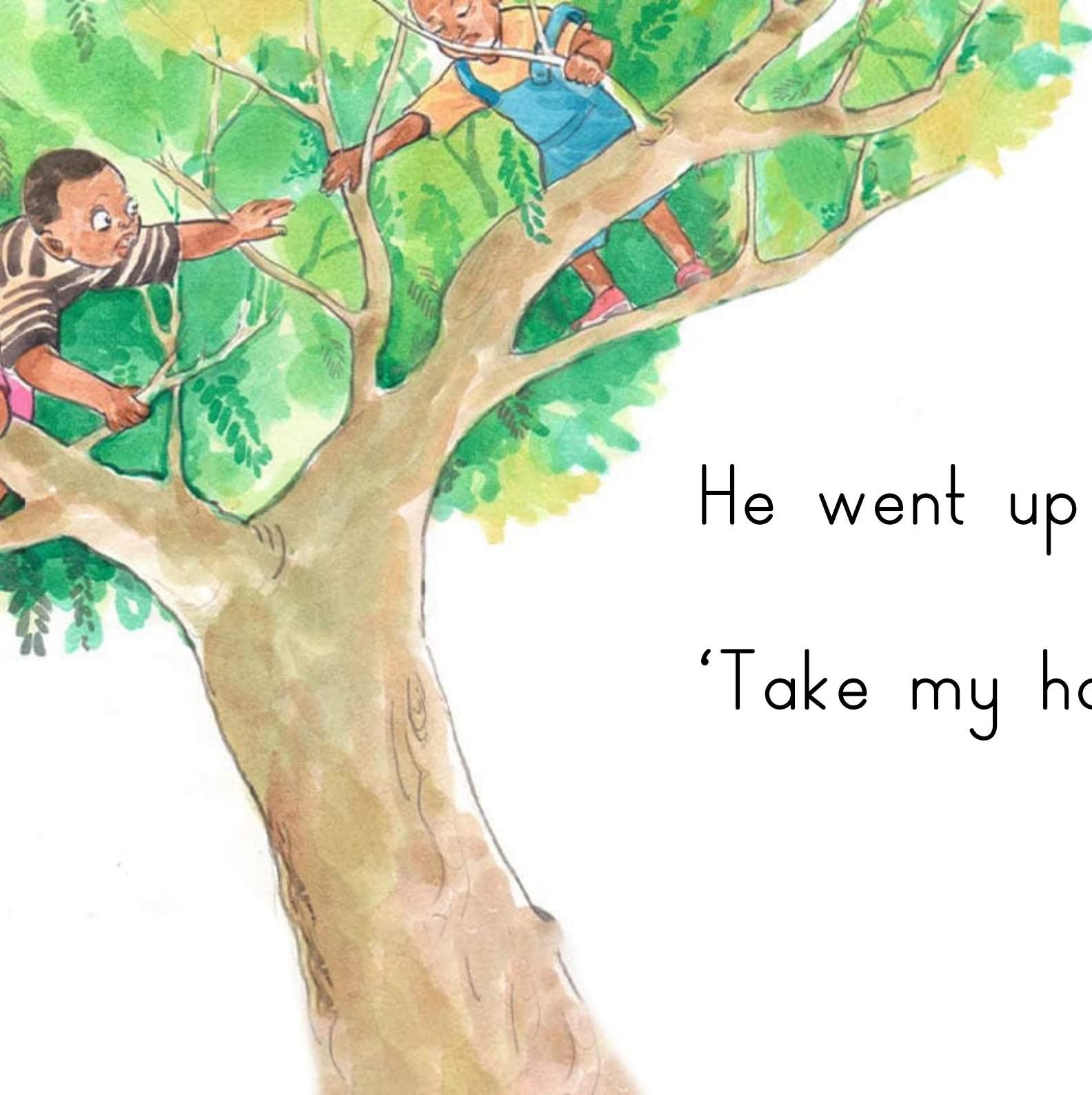
He gets up in

He is mine!’

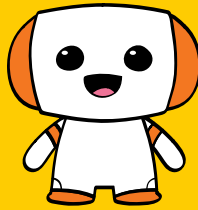


He wakes up.
