me his comb.



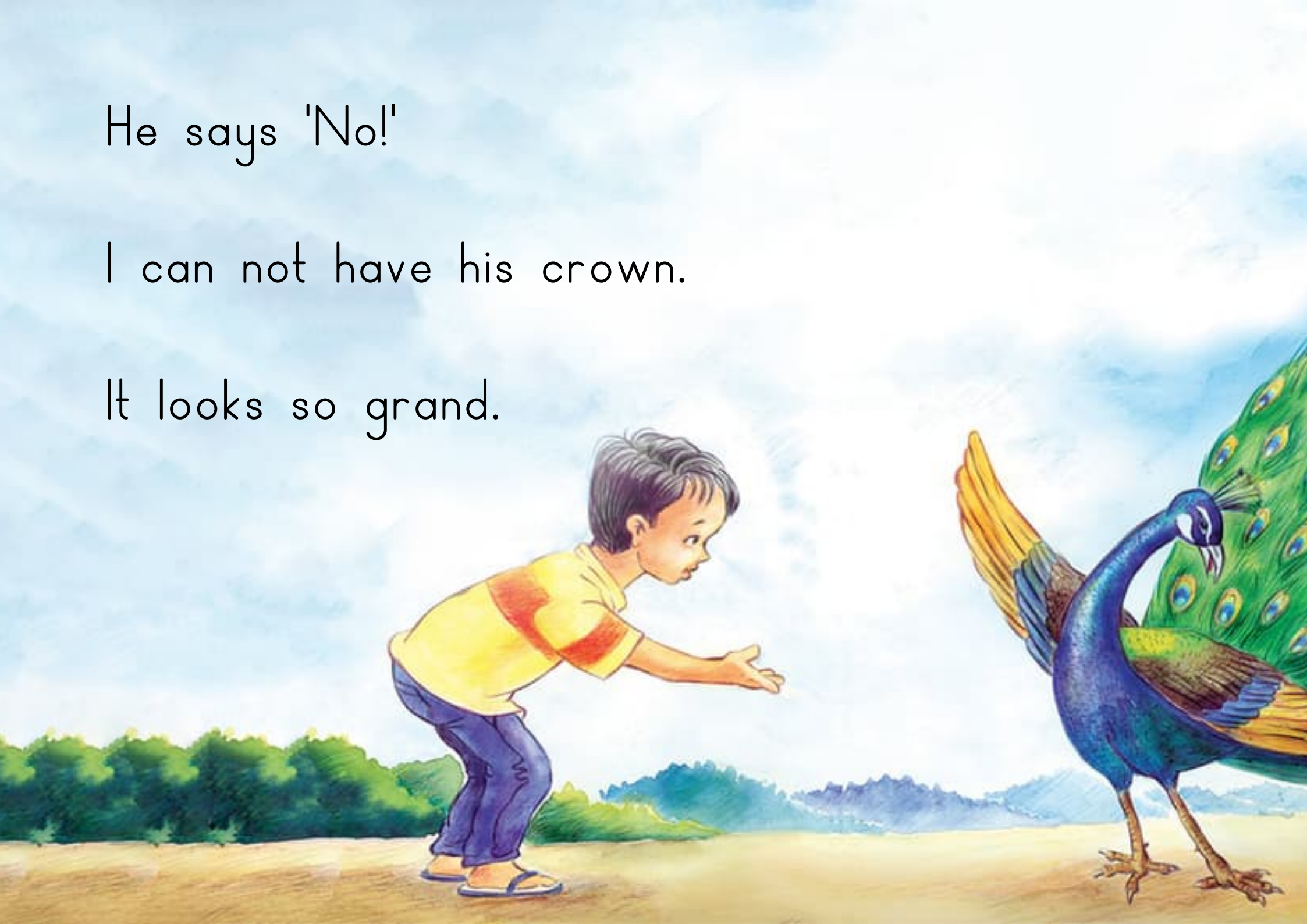
The green bird has a crown
too. Can I have a crown?



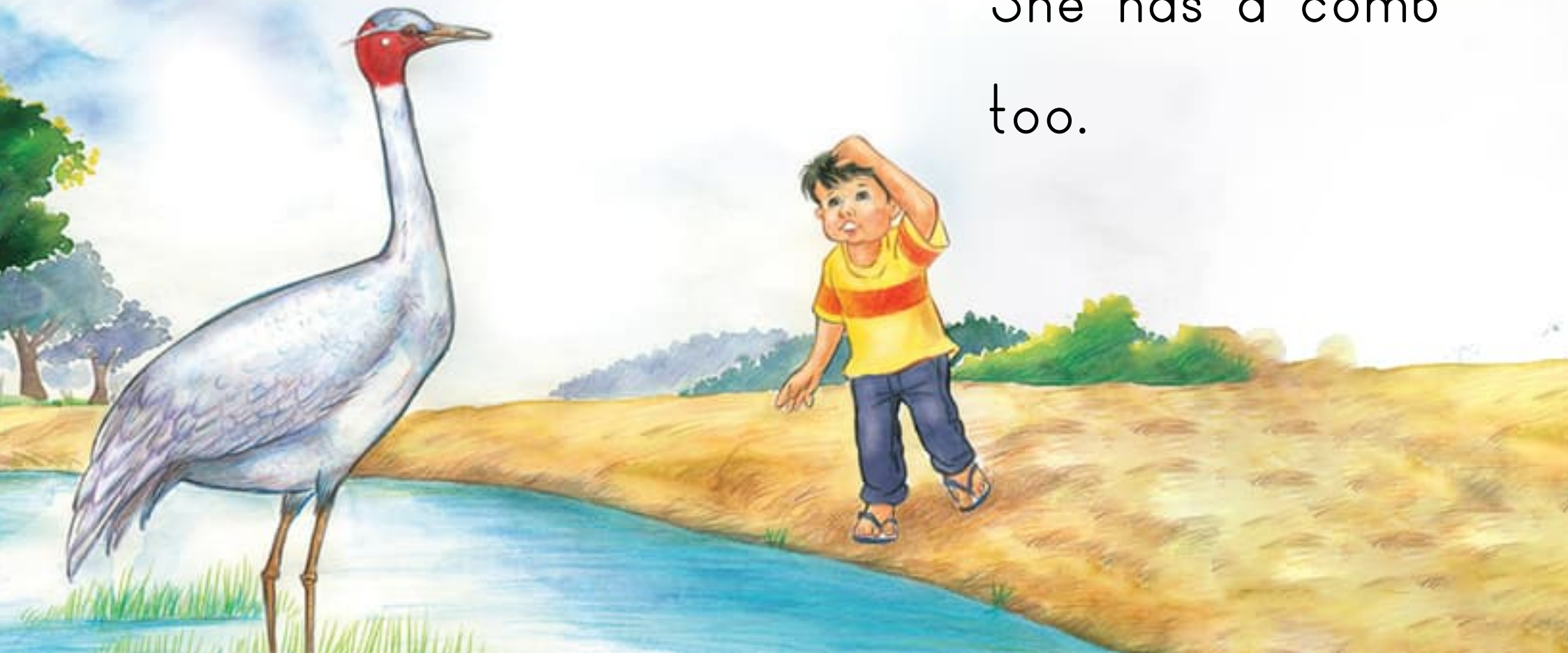
He says 'No!'

too.

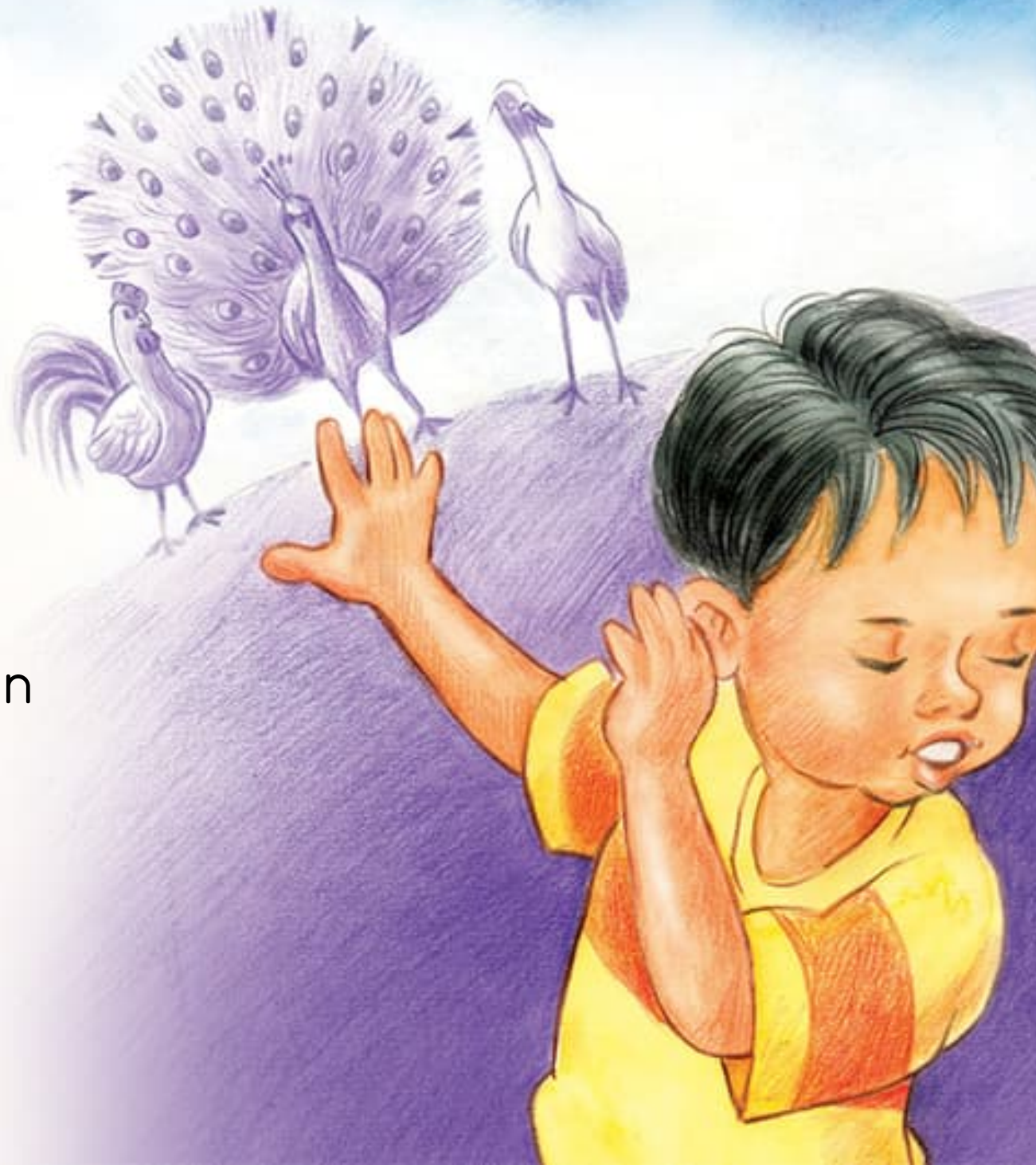


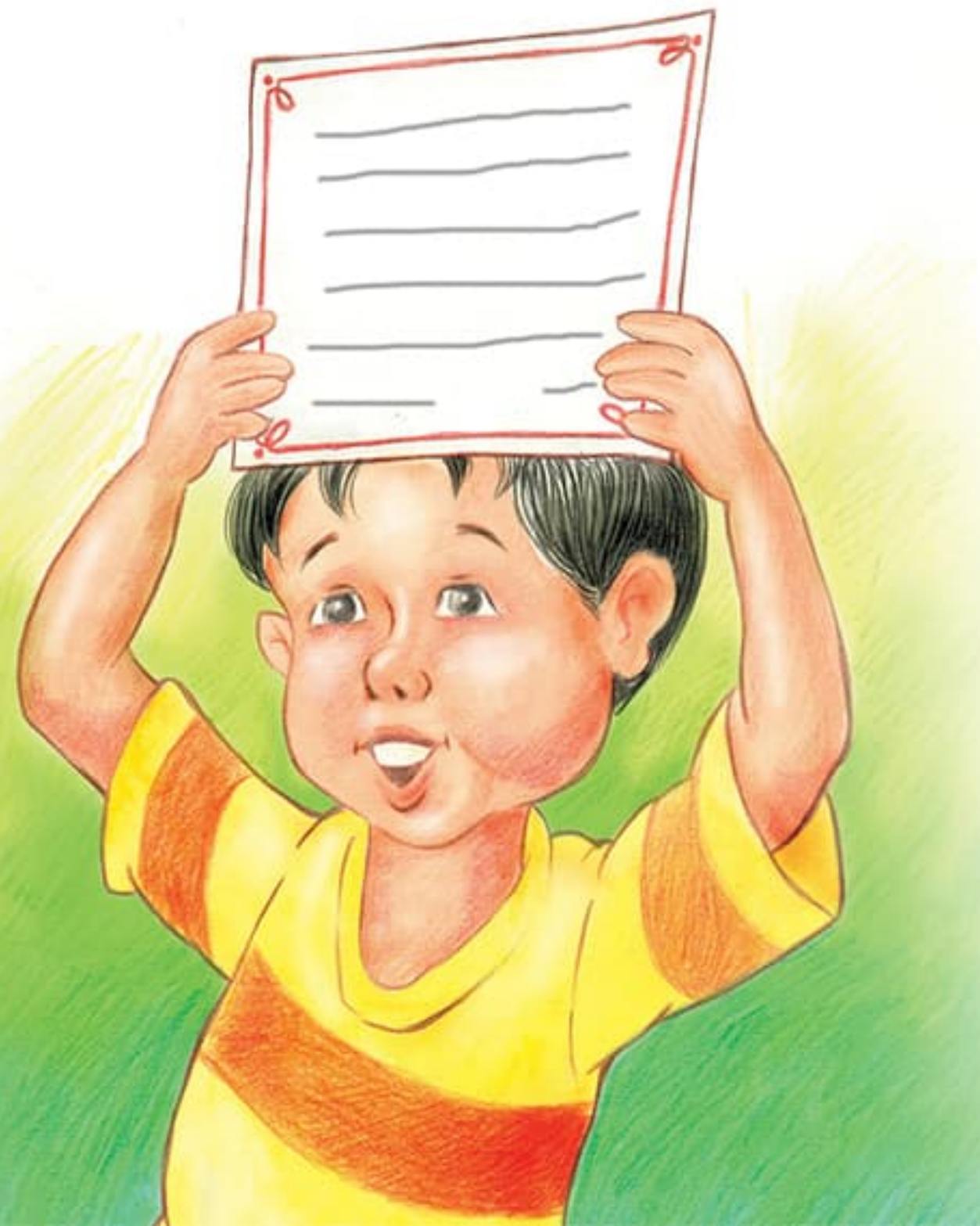
The comb crowns look
