Not in a hole.

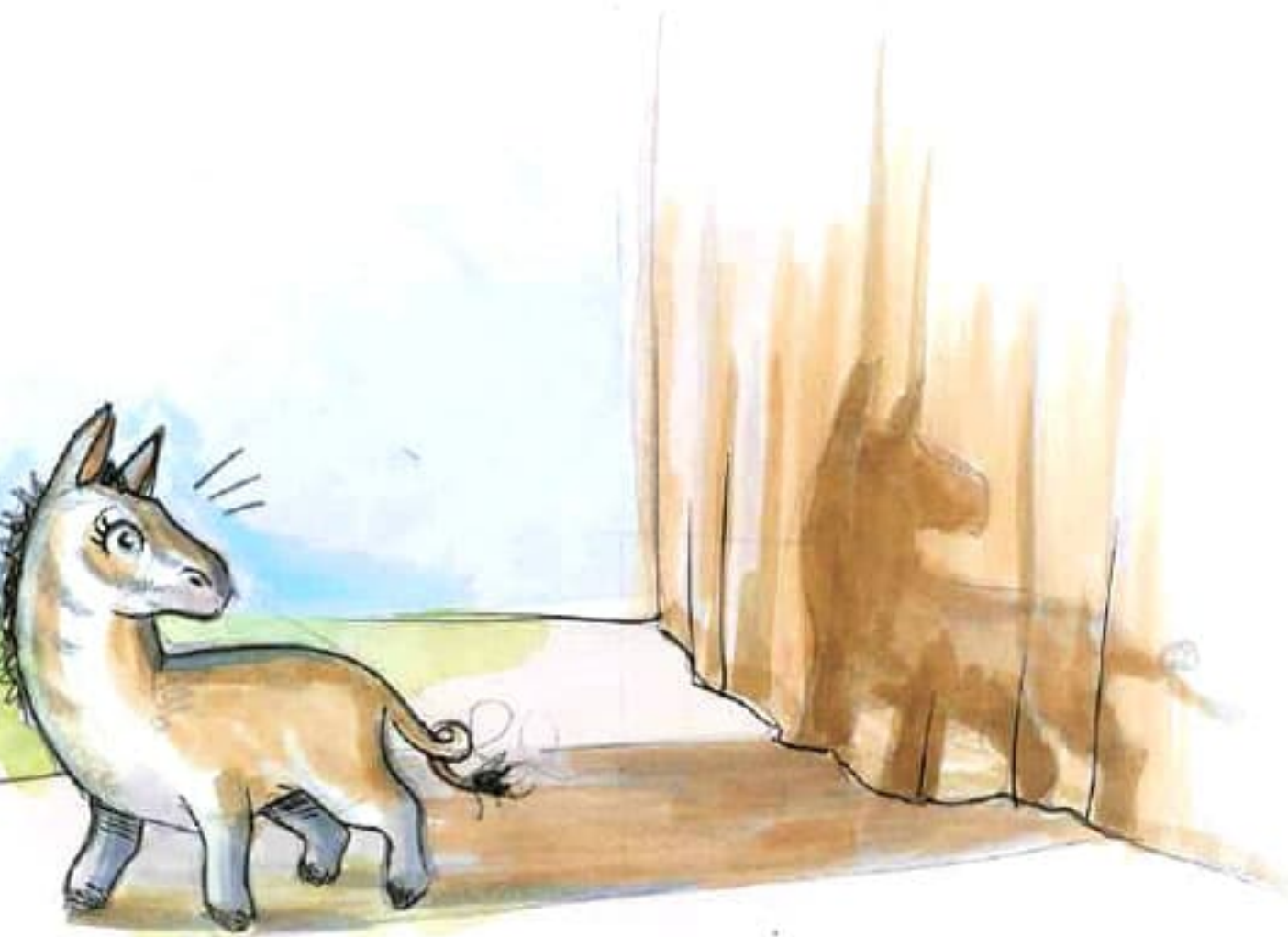
Not in a nest.

No, it is just me.

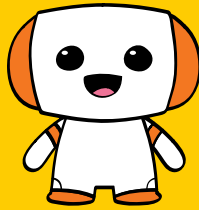
Yes.
