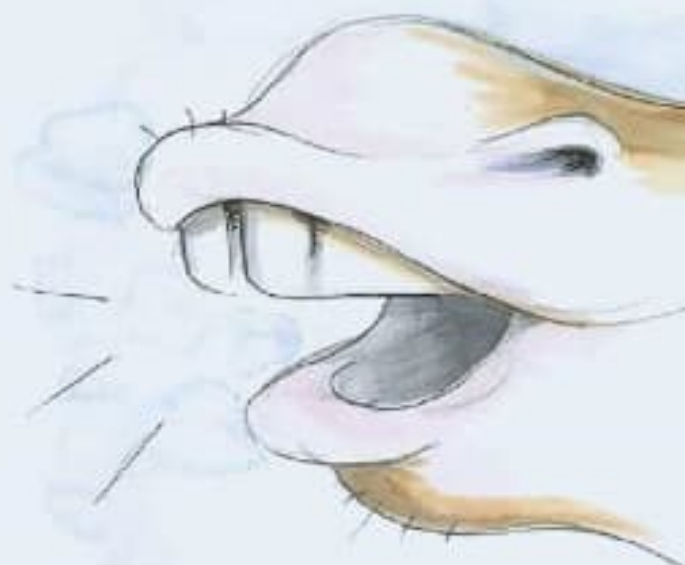


NO ONE LIKE ME

from anyone else.

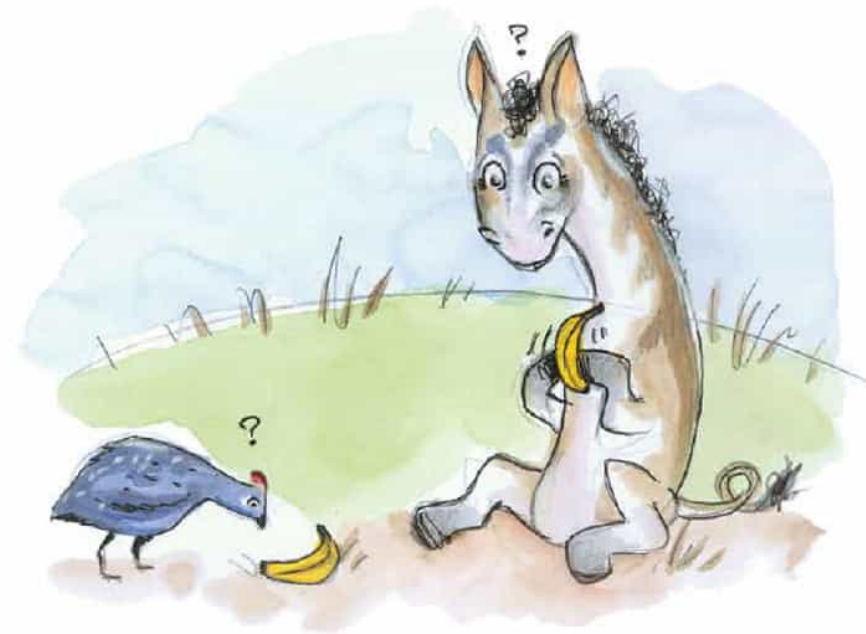


I run all around.

me?





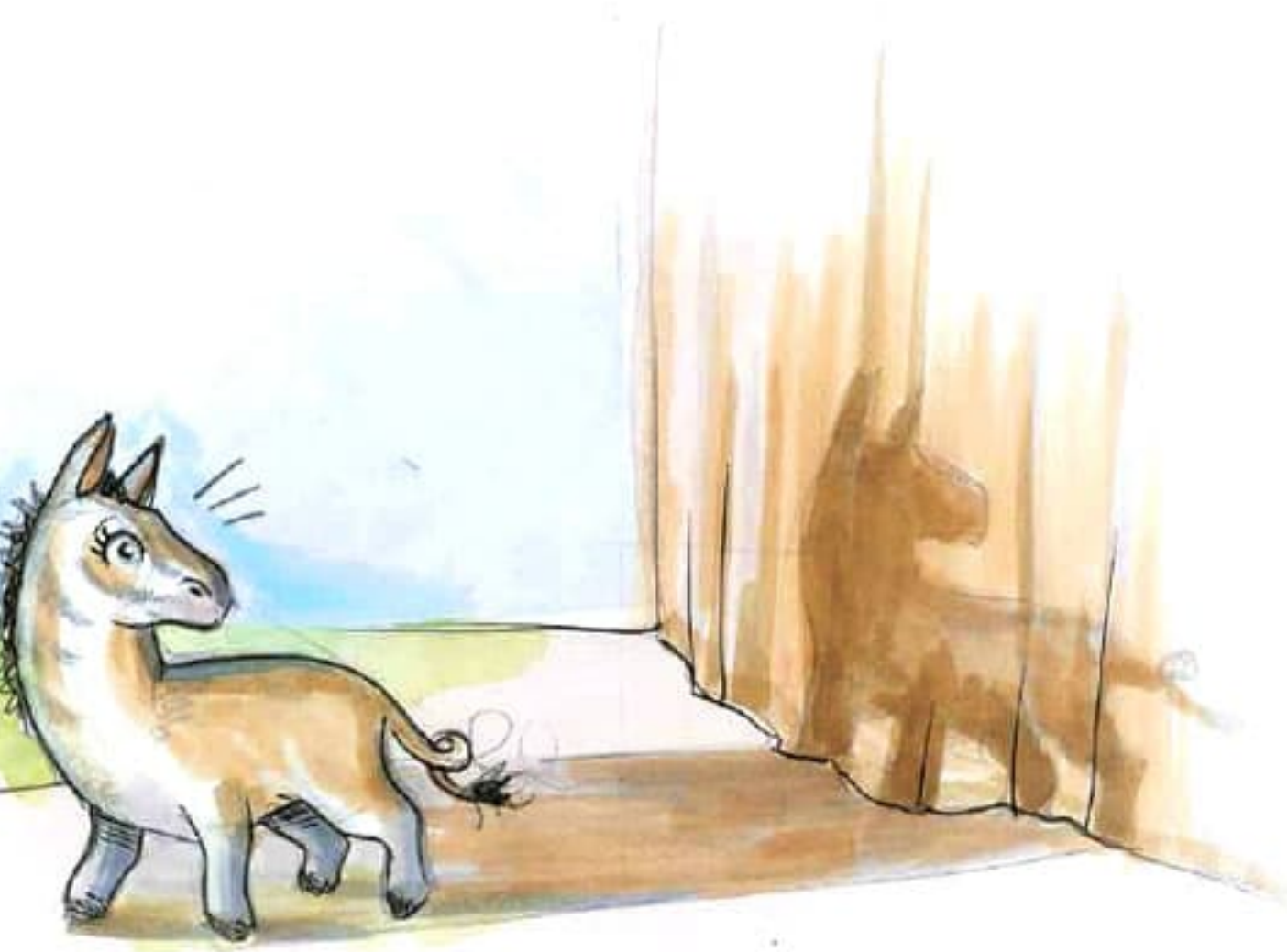
I do not burrow.
