They ate a lot.





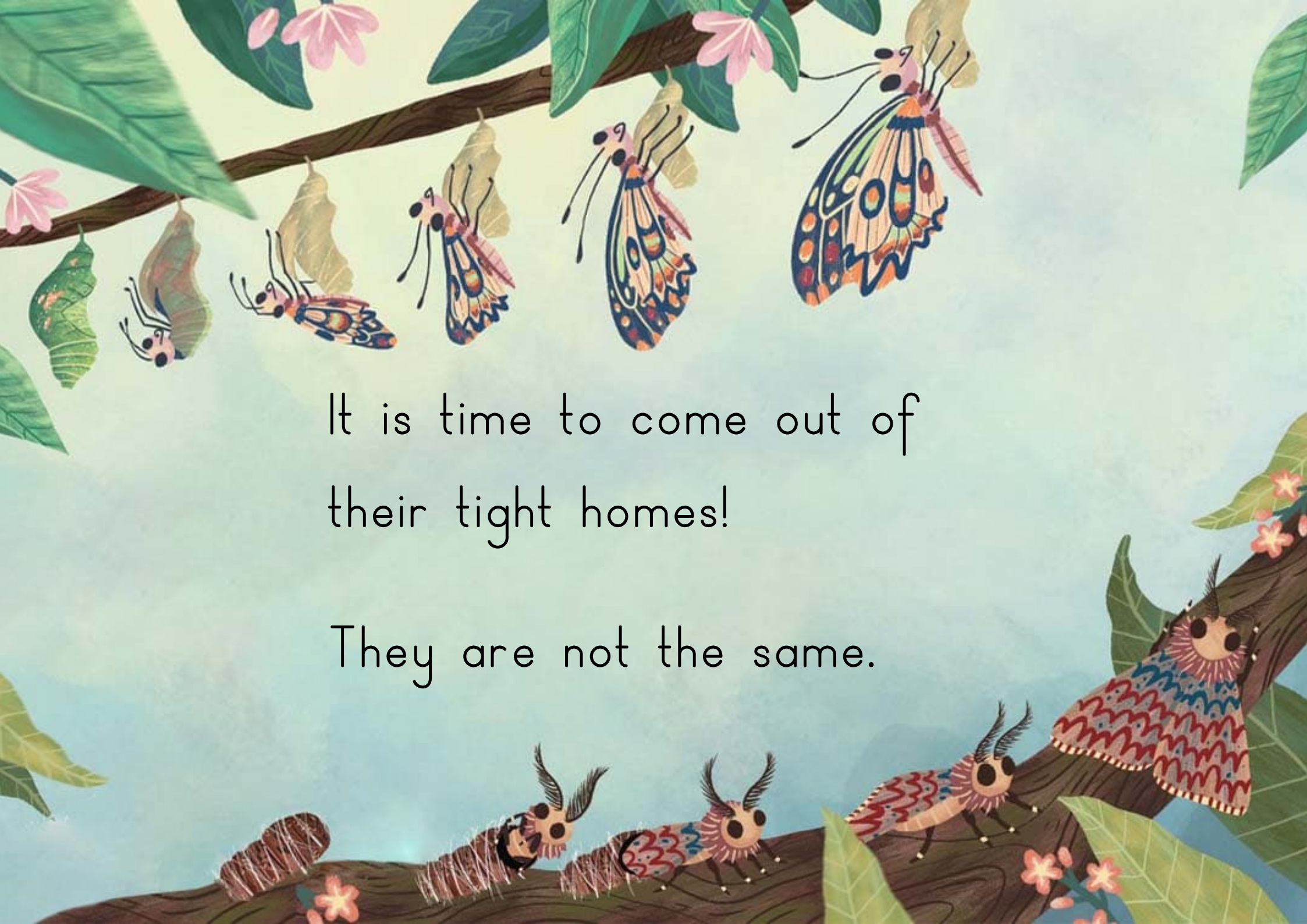
They make homes so

out?



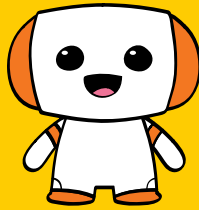




Some parts of their
