the sights.

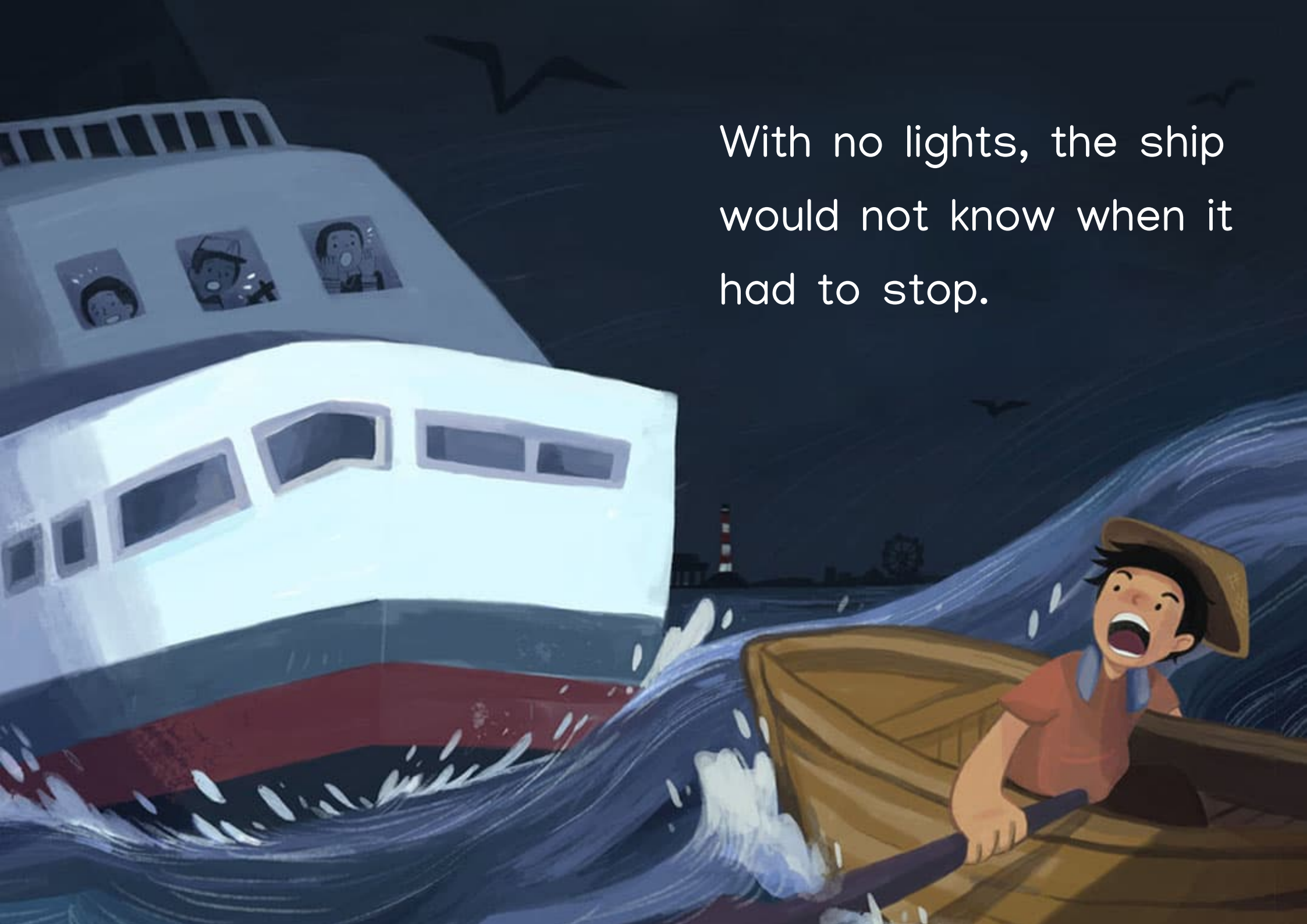


If the lights go out, there
