stuff.



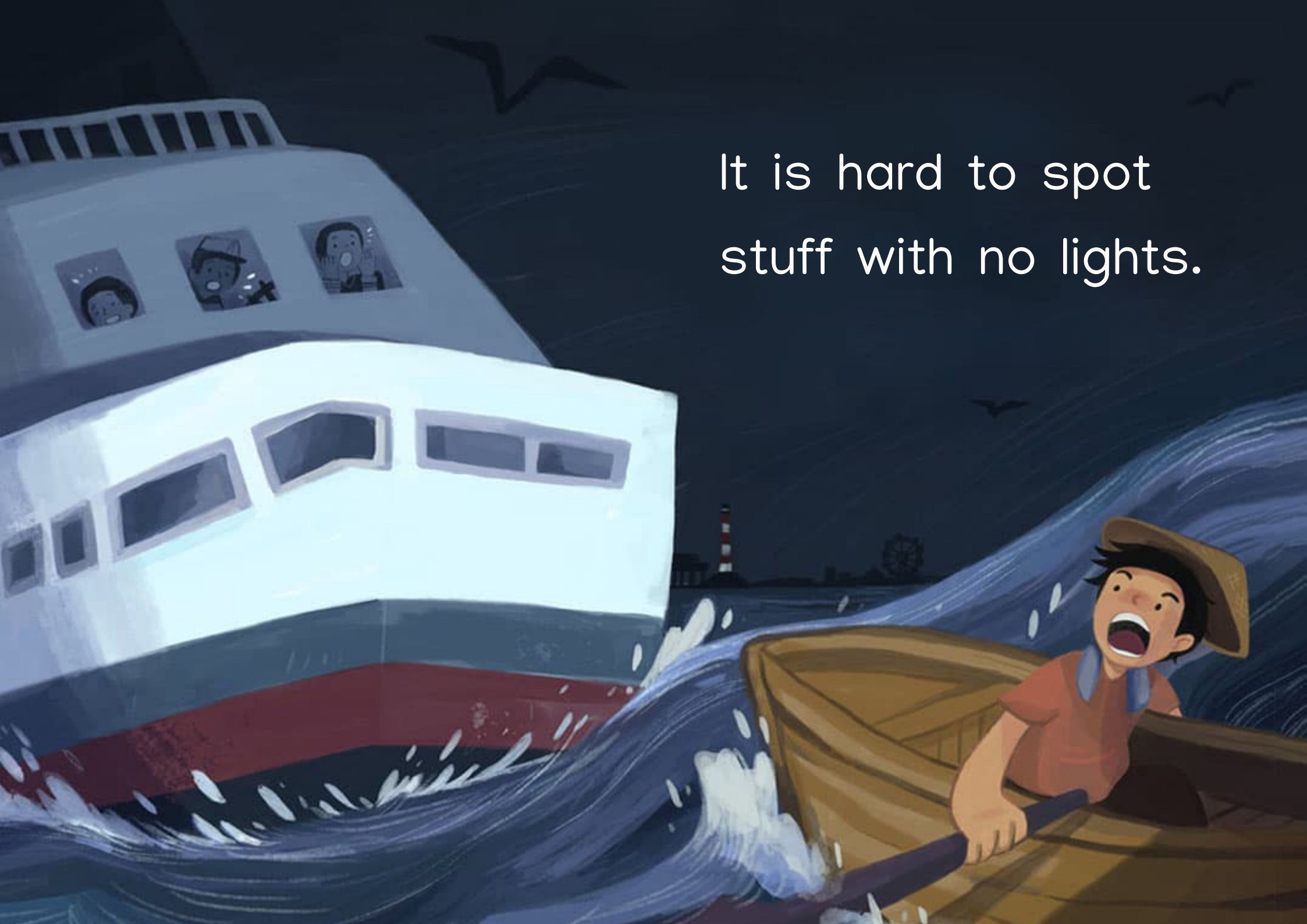


It is no fun if the sky
