Some people like to have a garage under their house. He is a big name in bike fandom, so he must keep his bike in great shape.





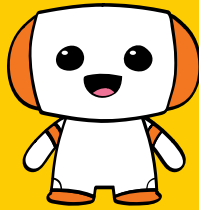
Some people live in houseboats. They seldom leave, but they can row a boat to shore if they need supplies. They can get most of what they need from the sea.
