loud yip!



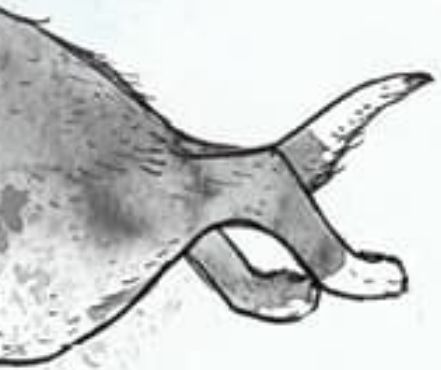
A big jump! He lands on

yard.



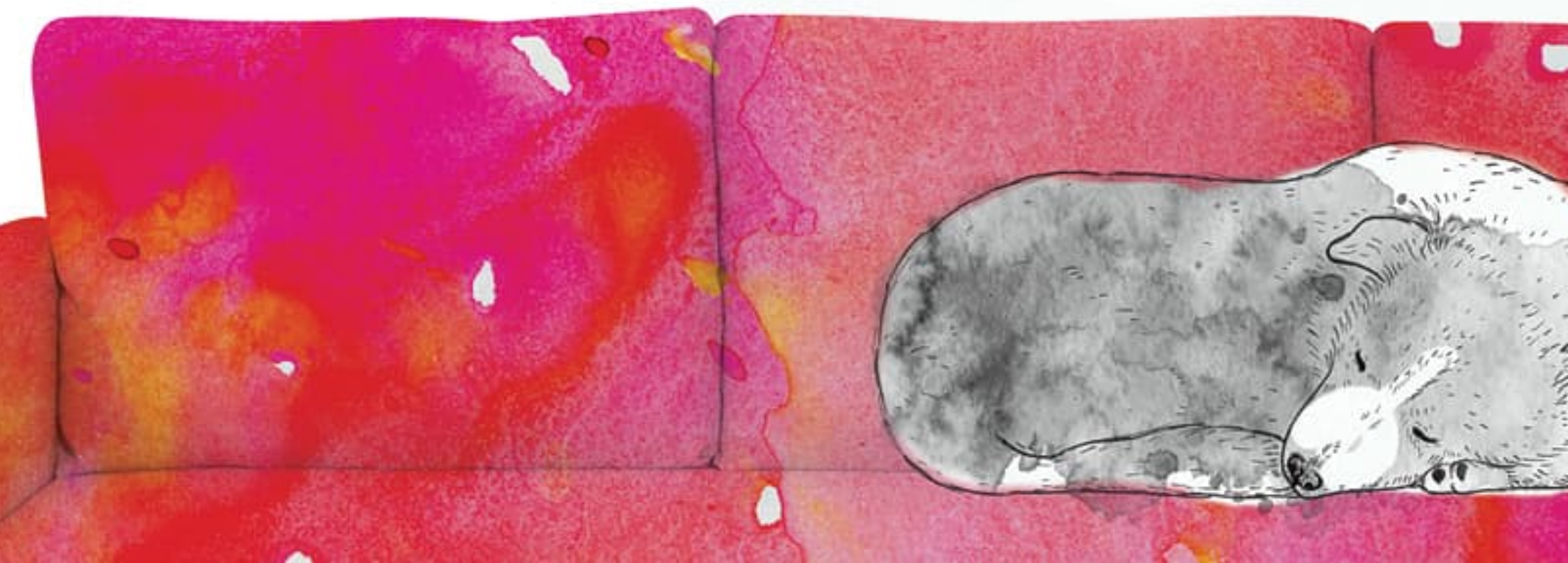
Mum is back from the shops. It makes him glad when Mum comes home.

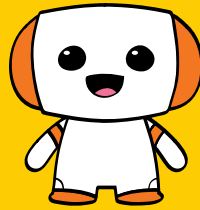




She pats him on the
