dragonfly.



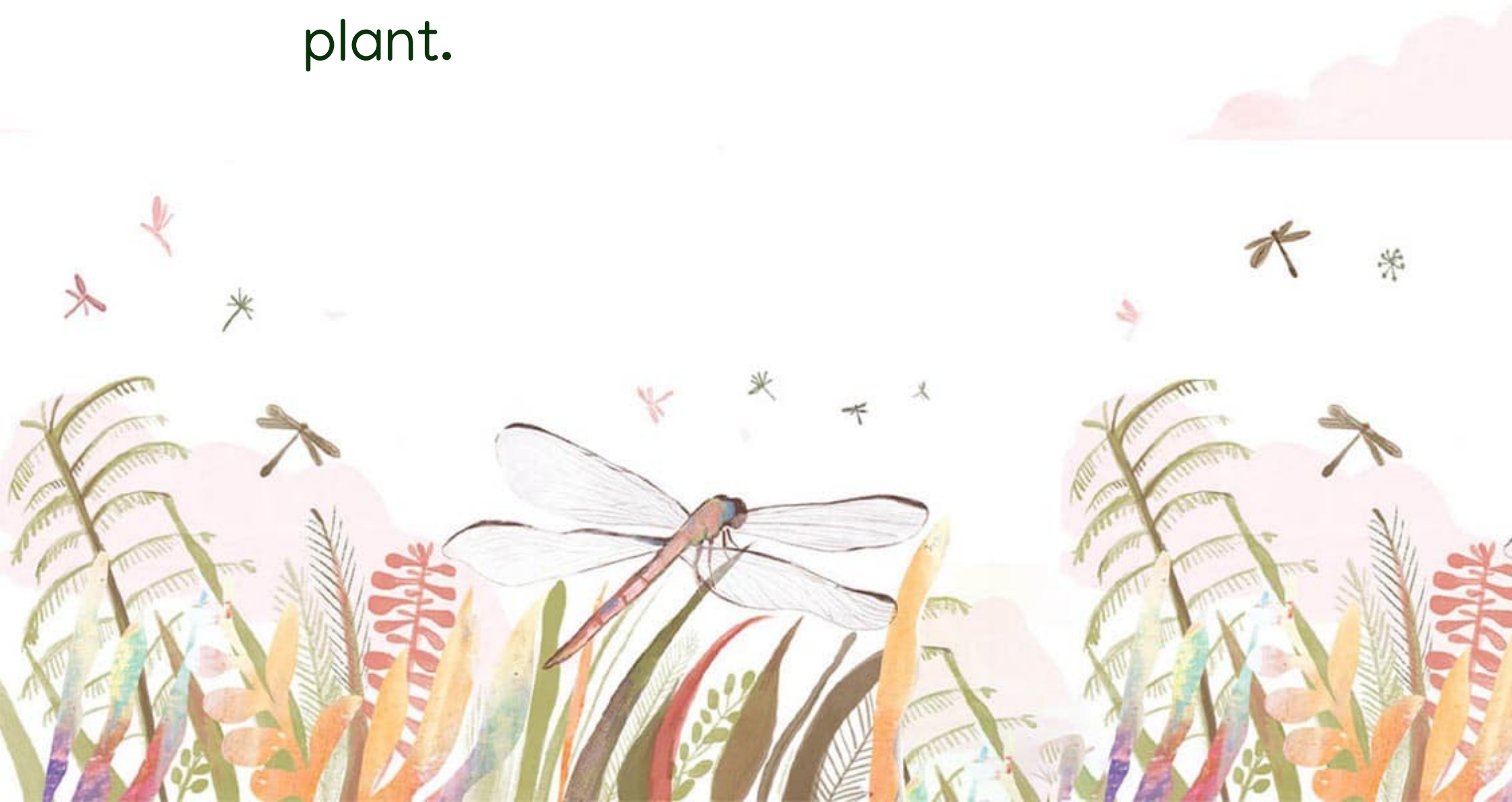
We have a brisk walk
