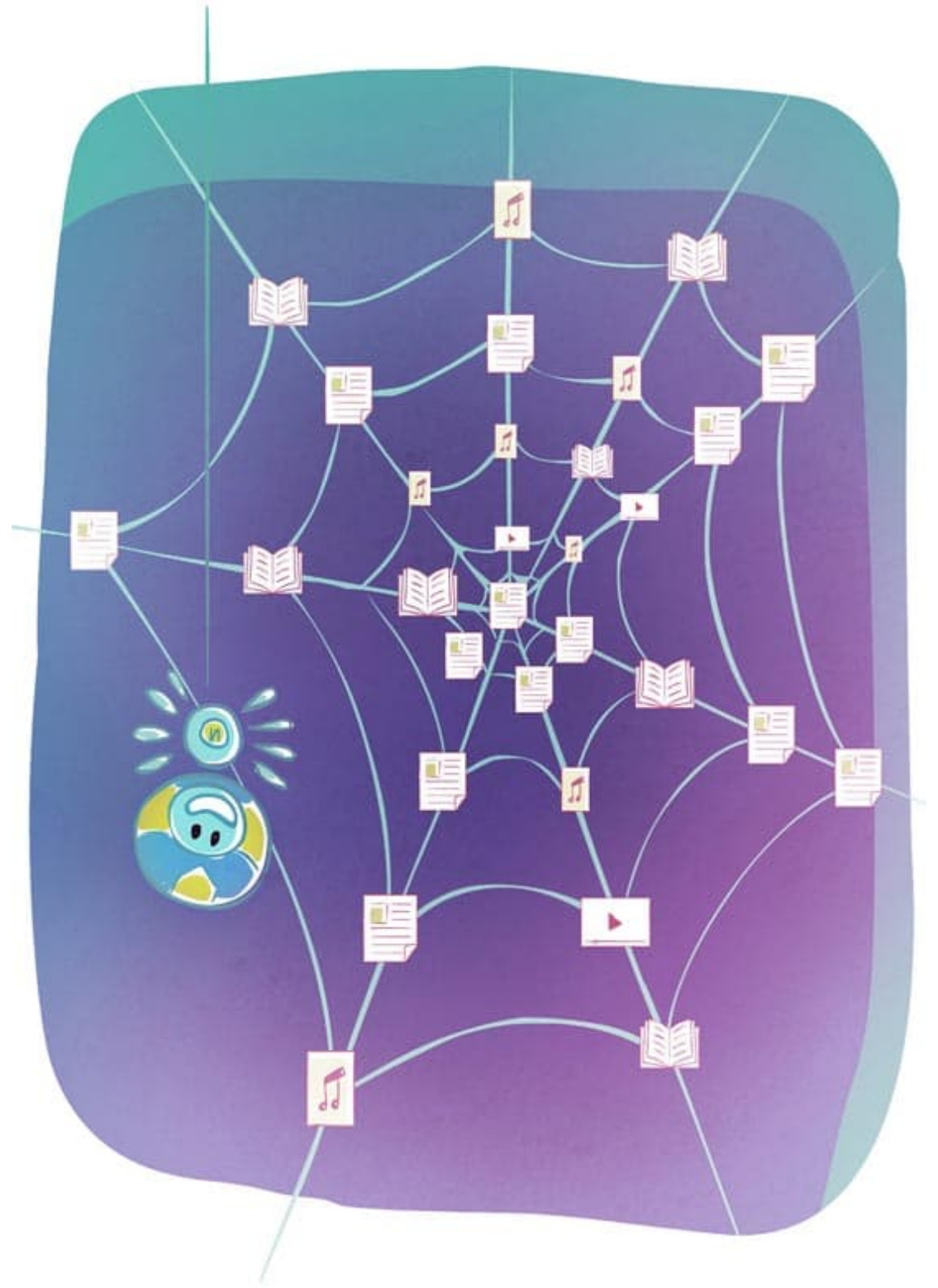

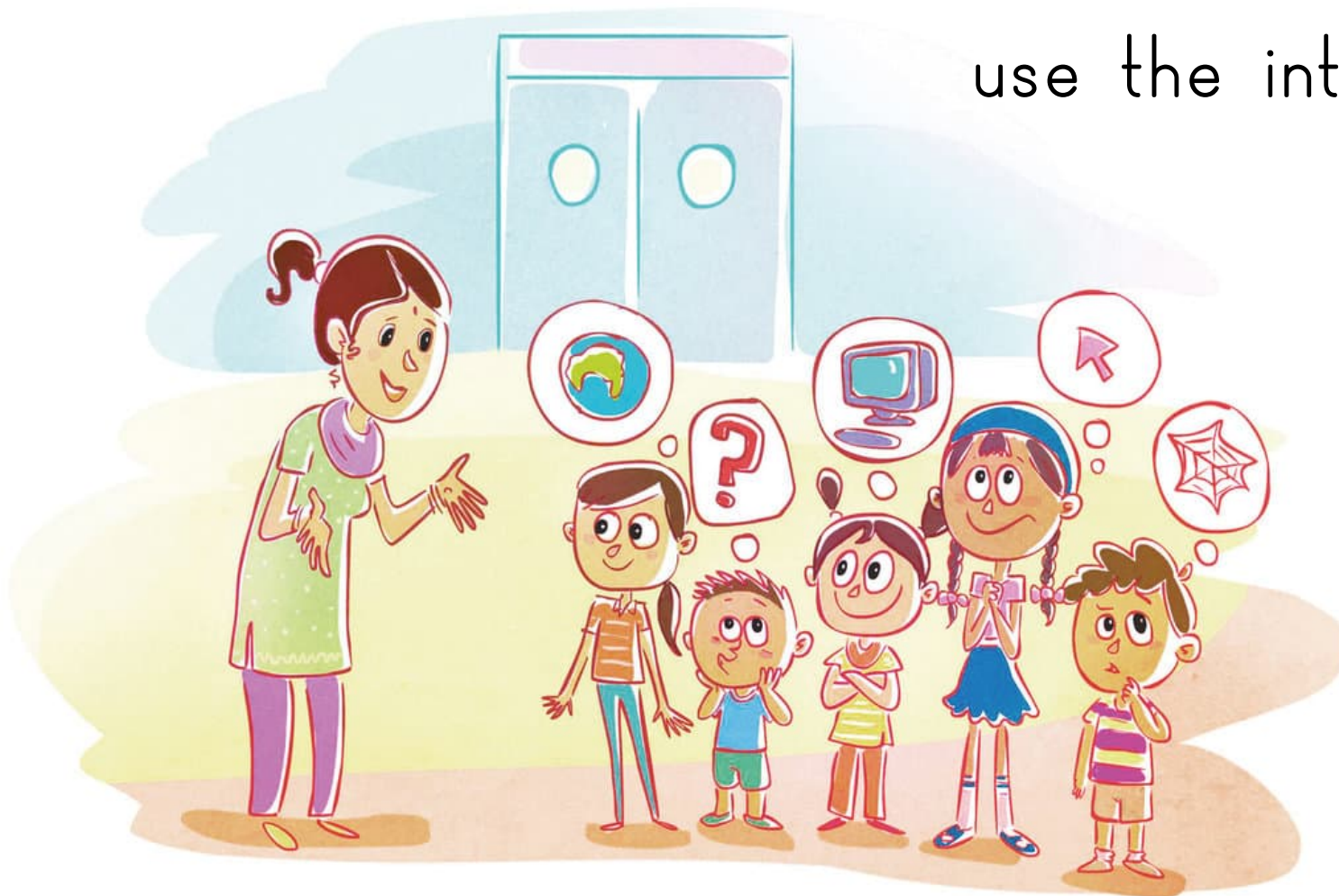
We use the web

there lets Miss use the internet.



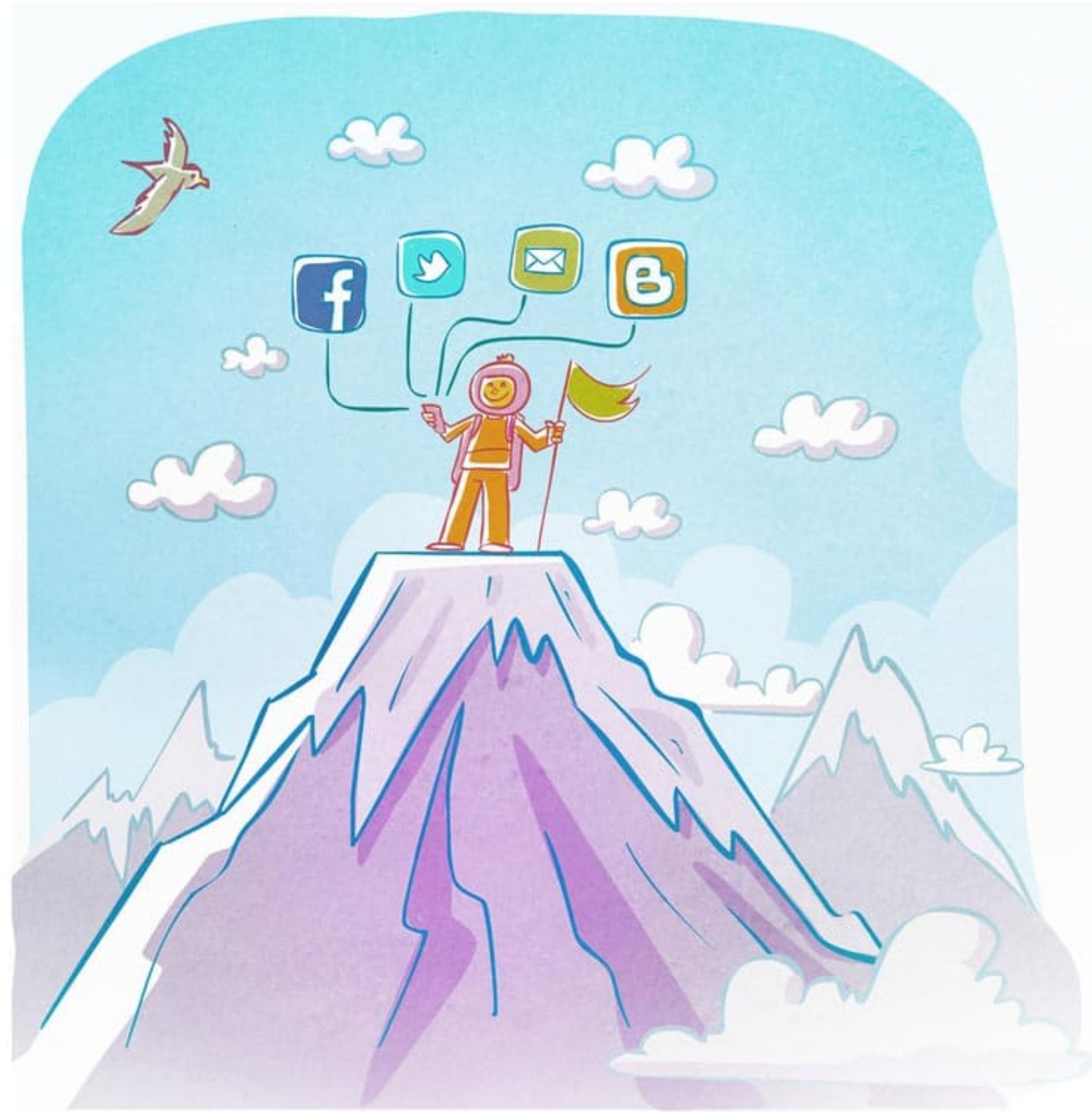

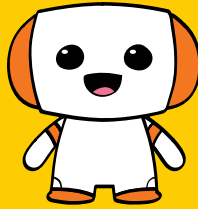
