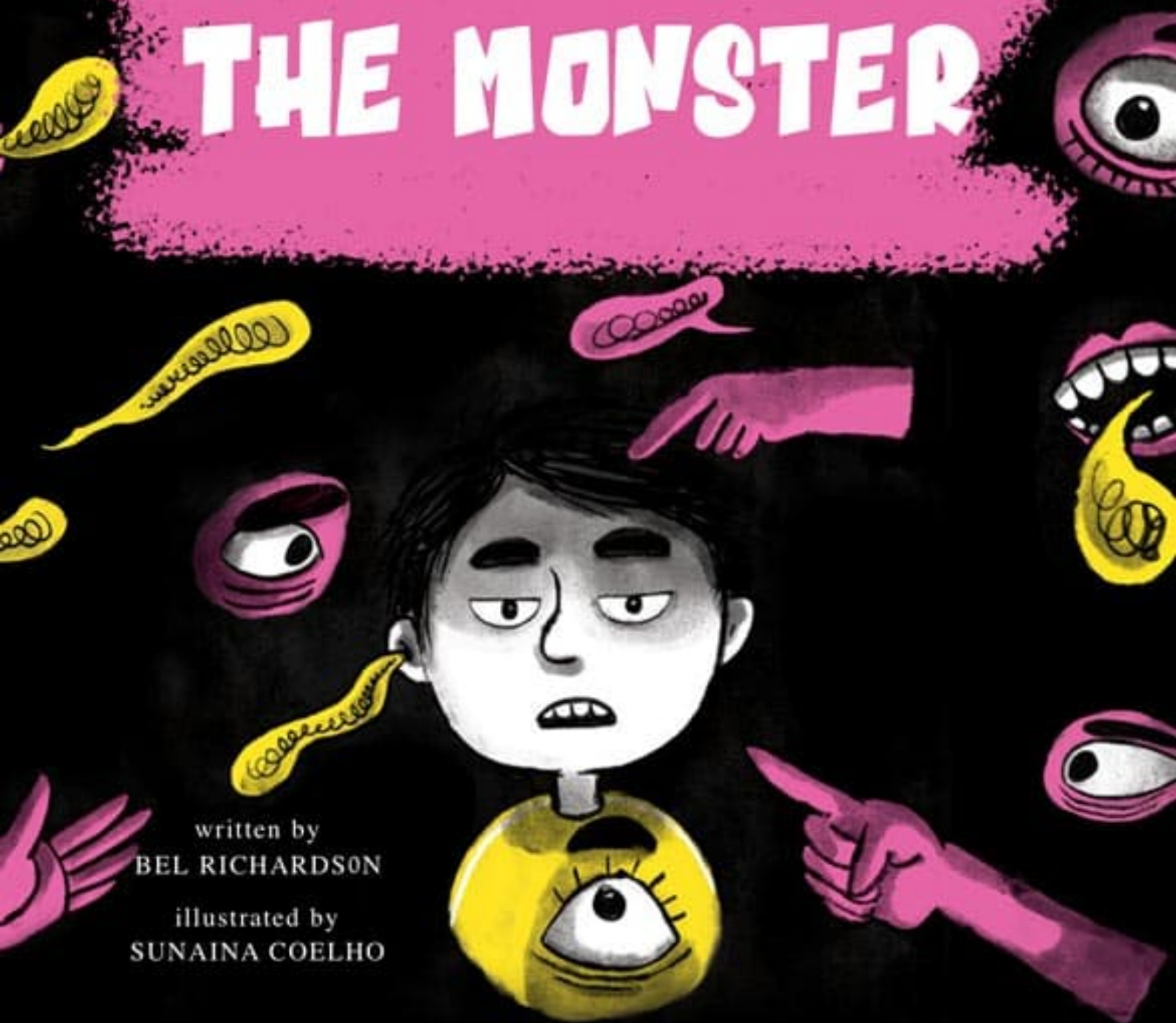


THE MONSTER
