those fish?

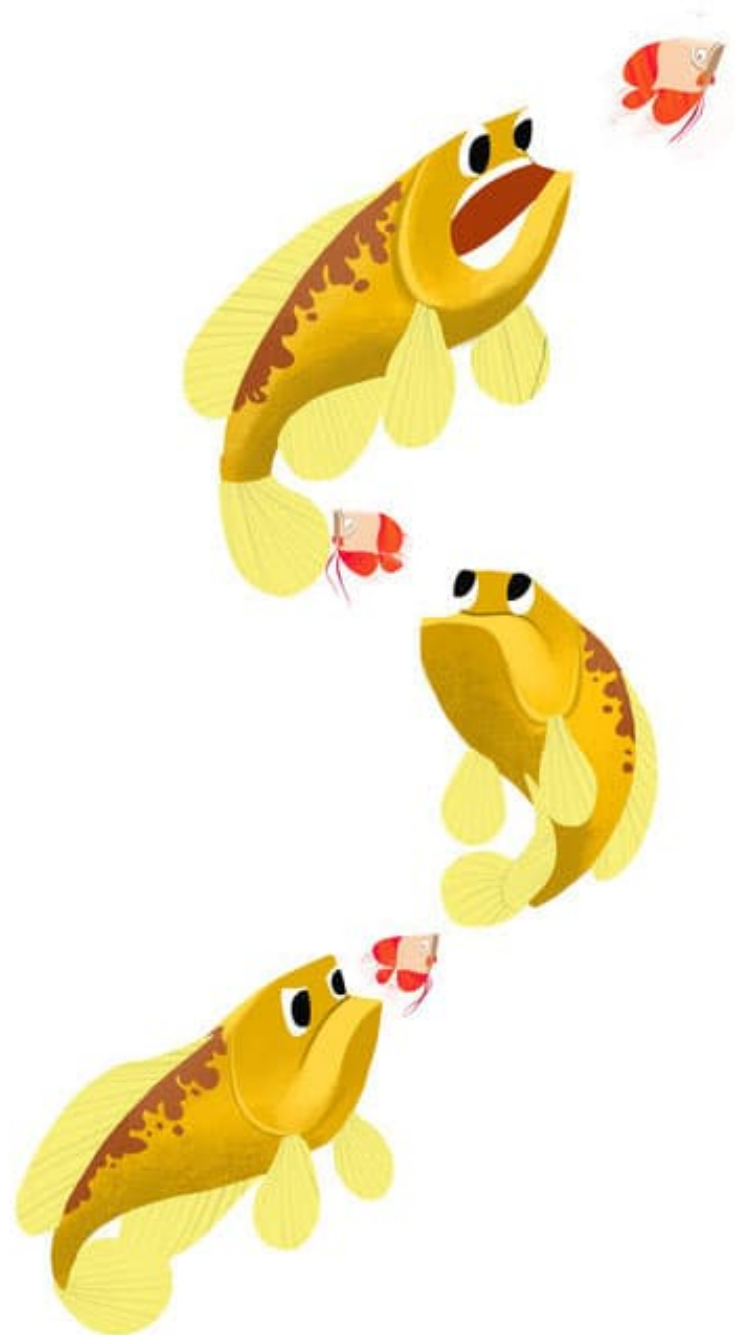




But the big rock

Little Fish.



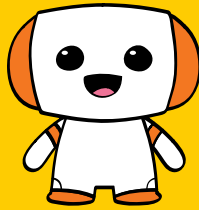
Kingfisher is up.
