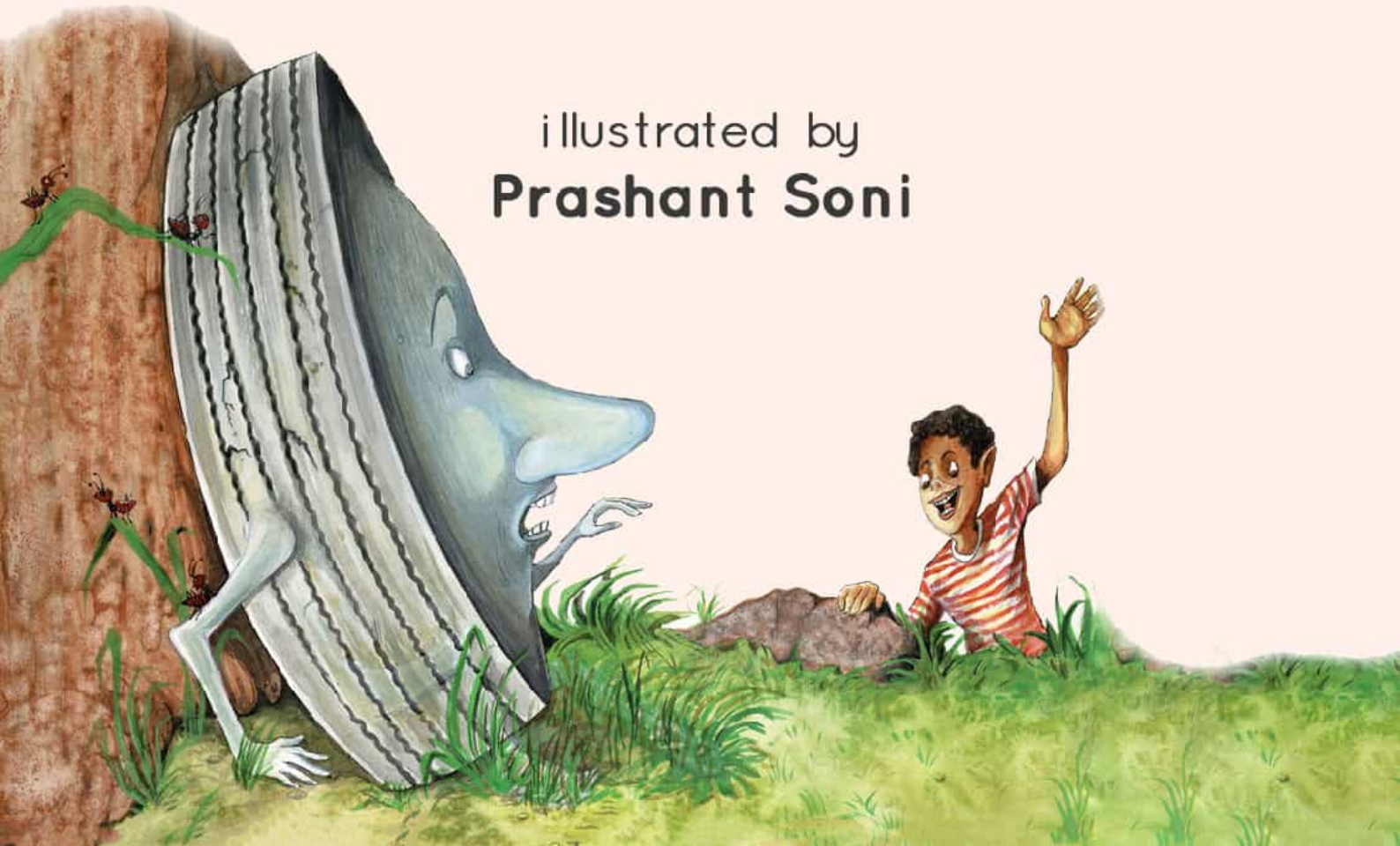


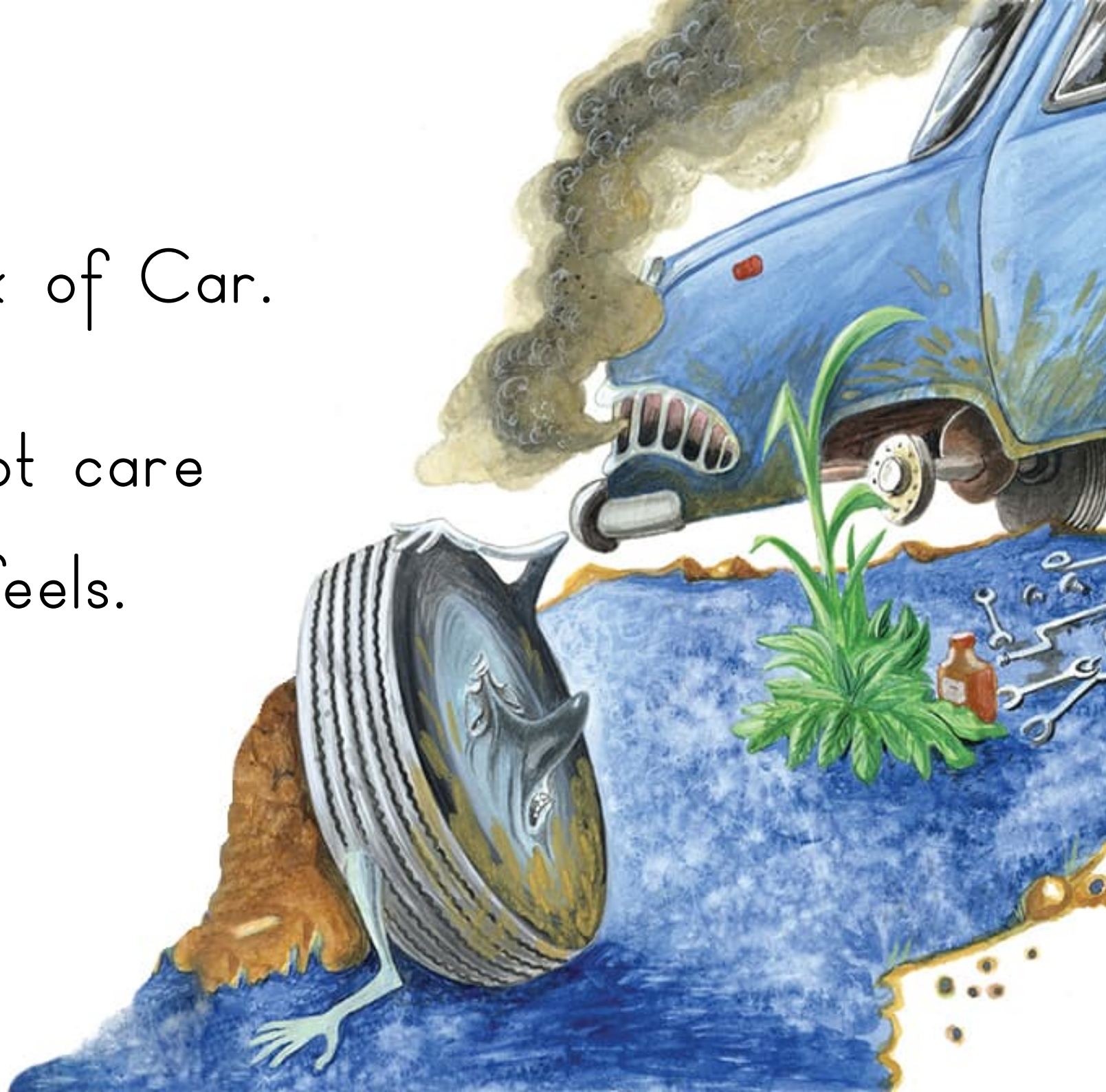

how Tire feels.

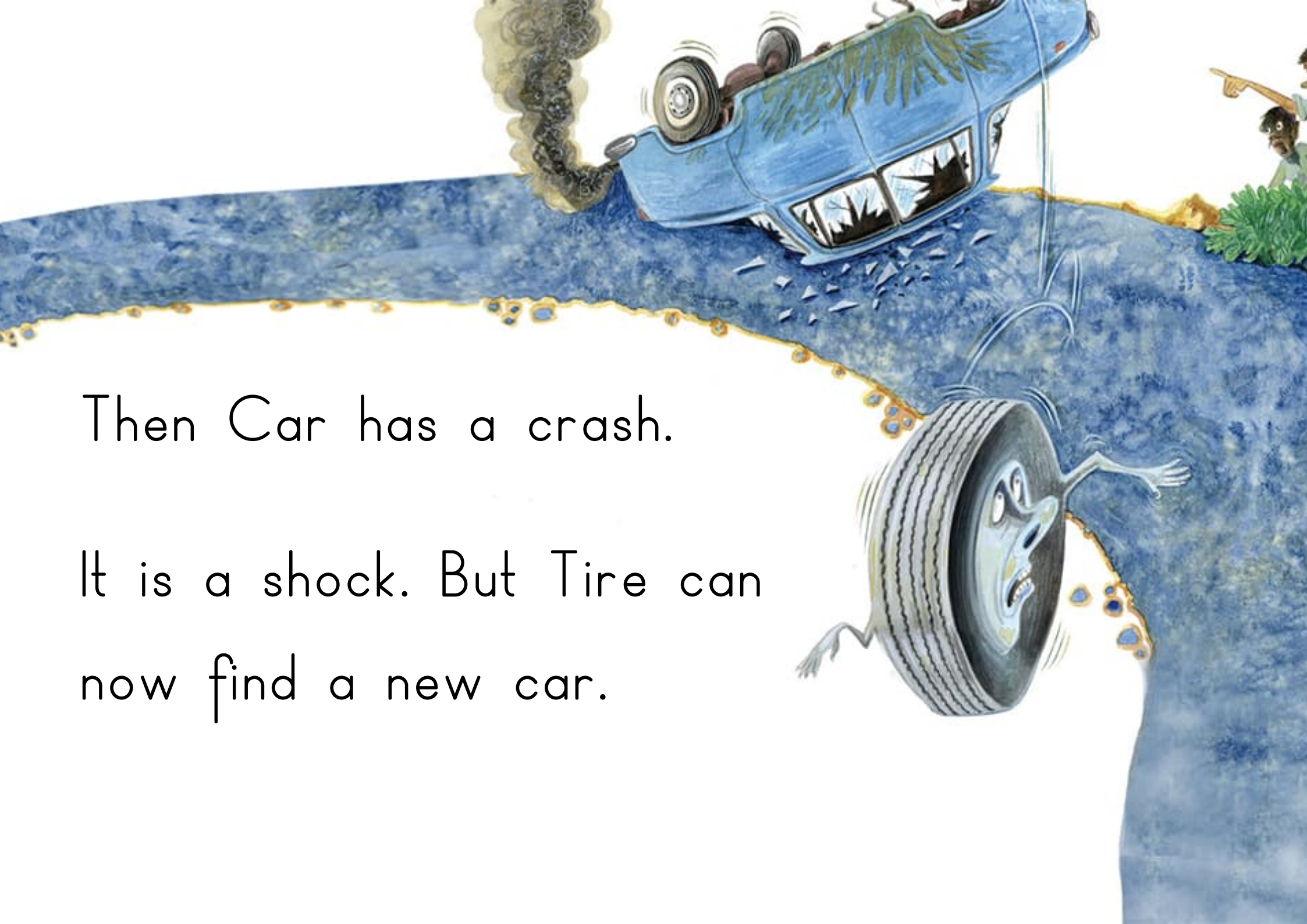


Car drives on

Tire.



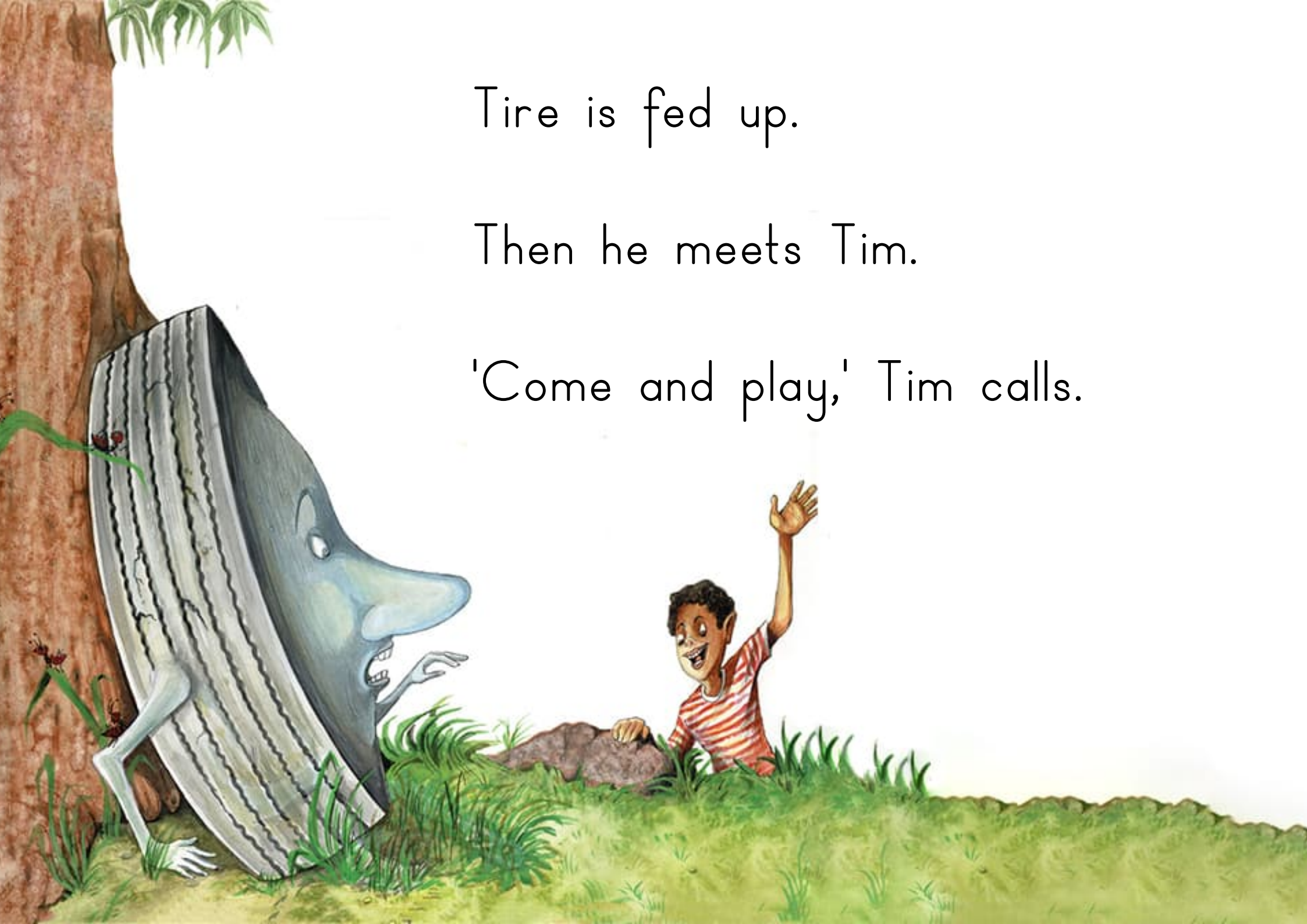
'Can I be a tire on

Then he meets Tim.

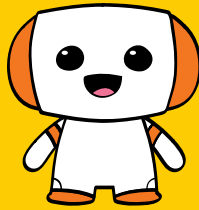
'Come and play,' Tim calls.
