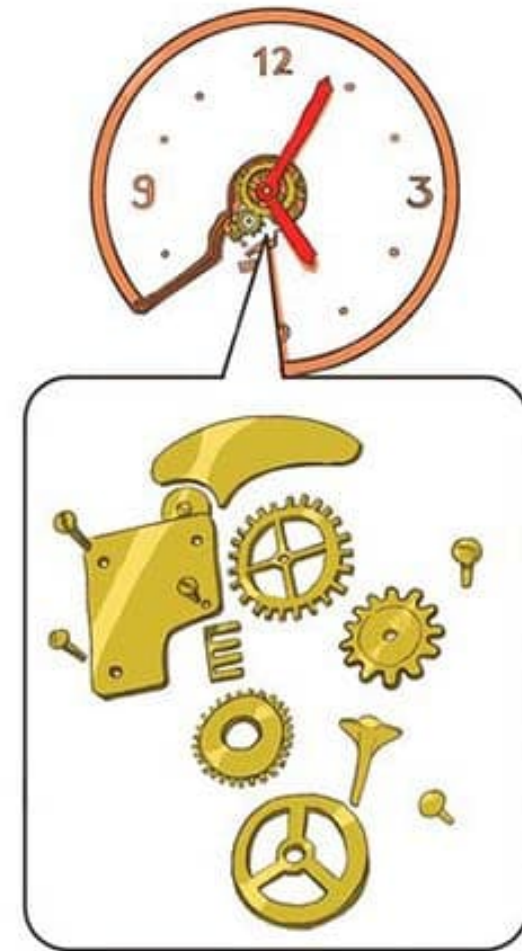
Wheels are on a lot of things. They make them tick.

big!

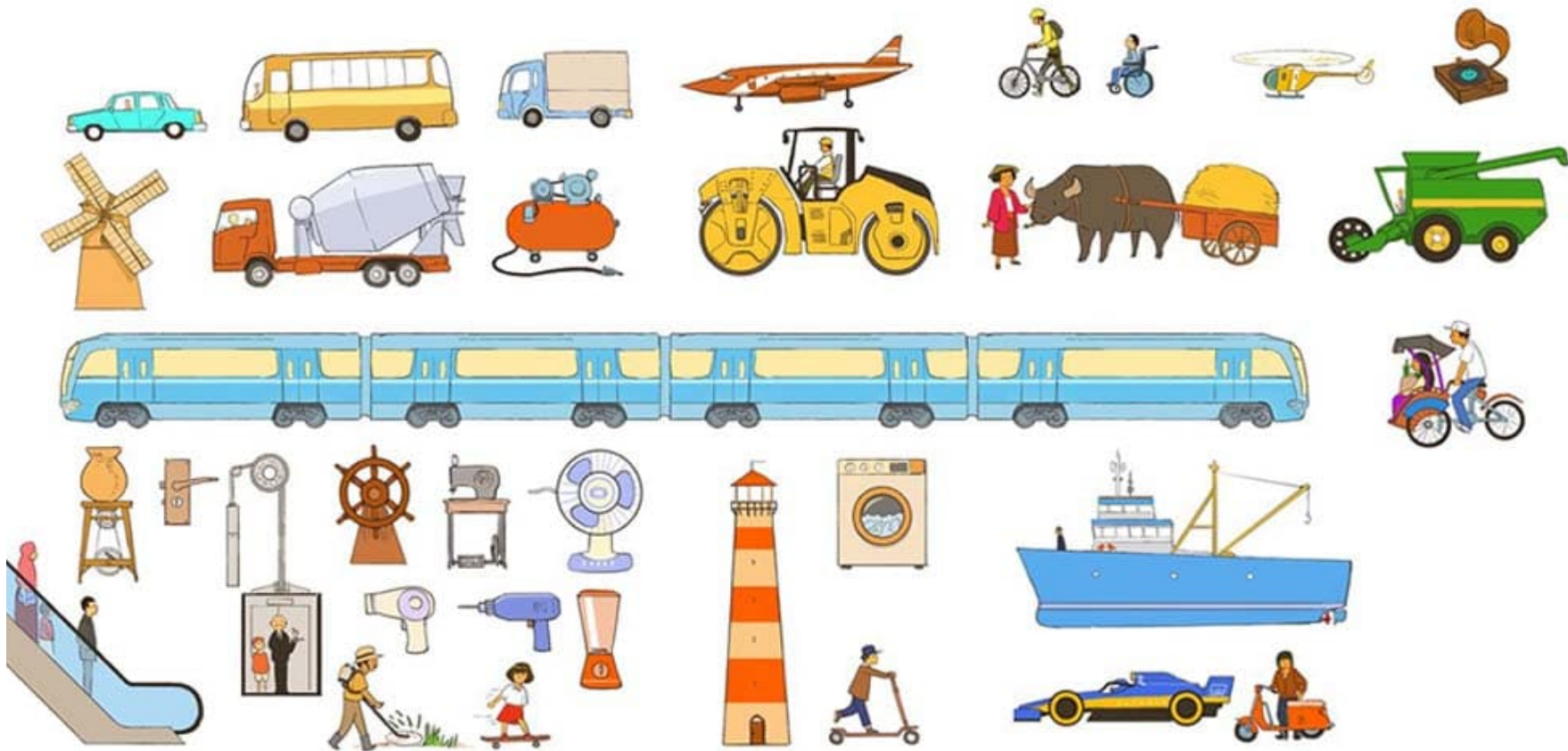
Clocks have wheels in them. They make them tick and tock.



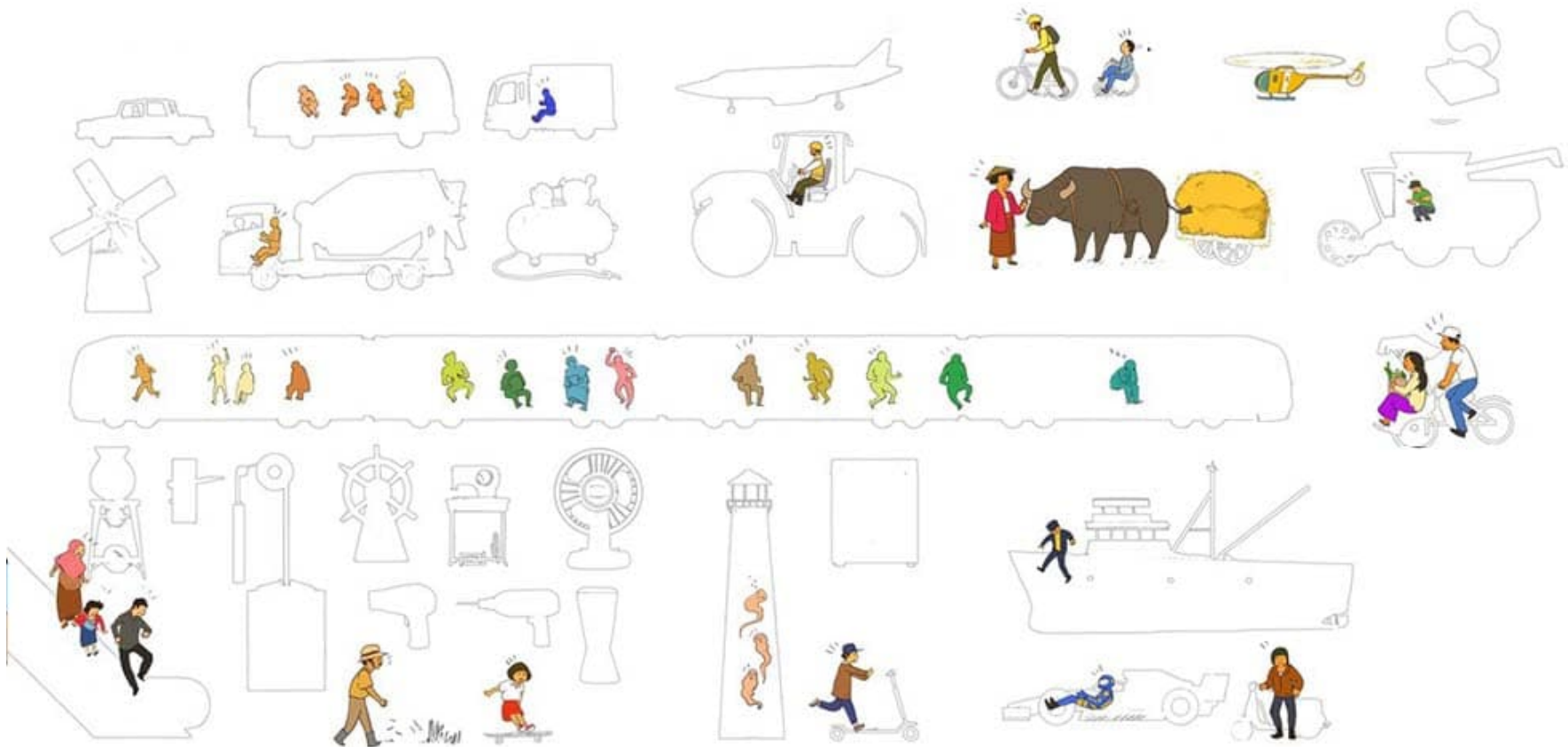
We see a lot of wheels when

not all.

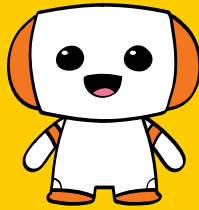


And with no wheels, we
