

UMBRELLA

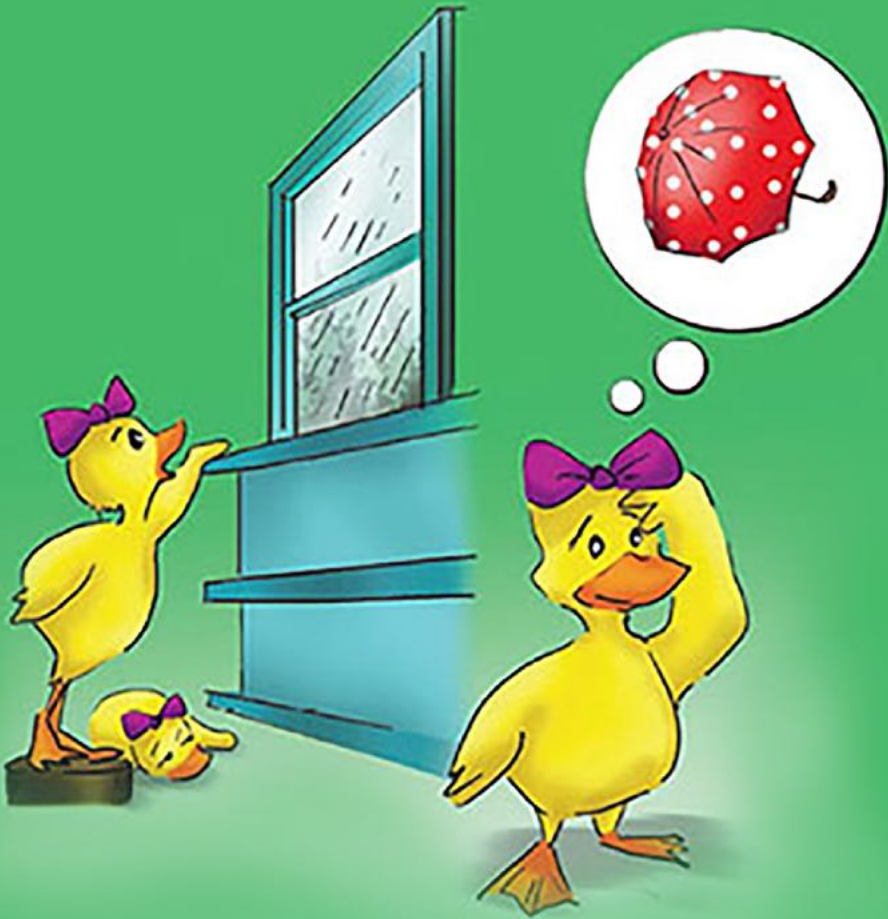

size for the duck.





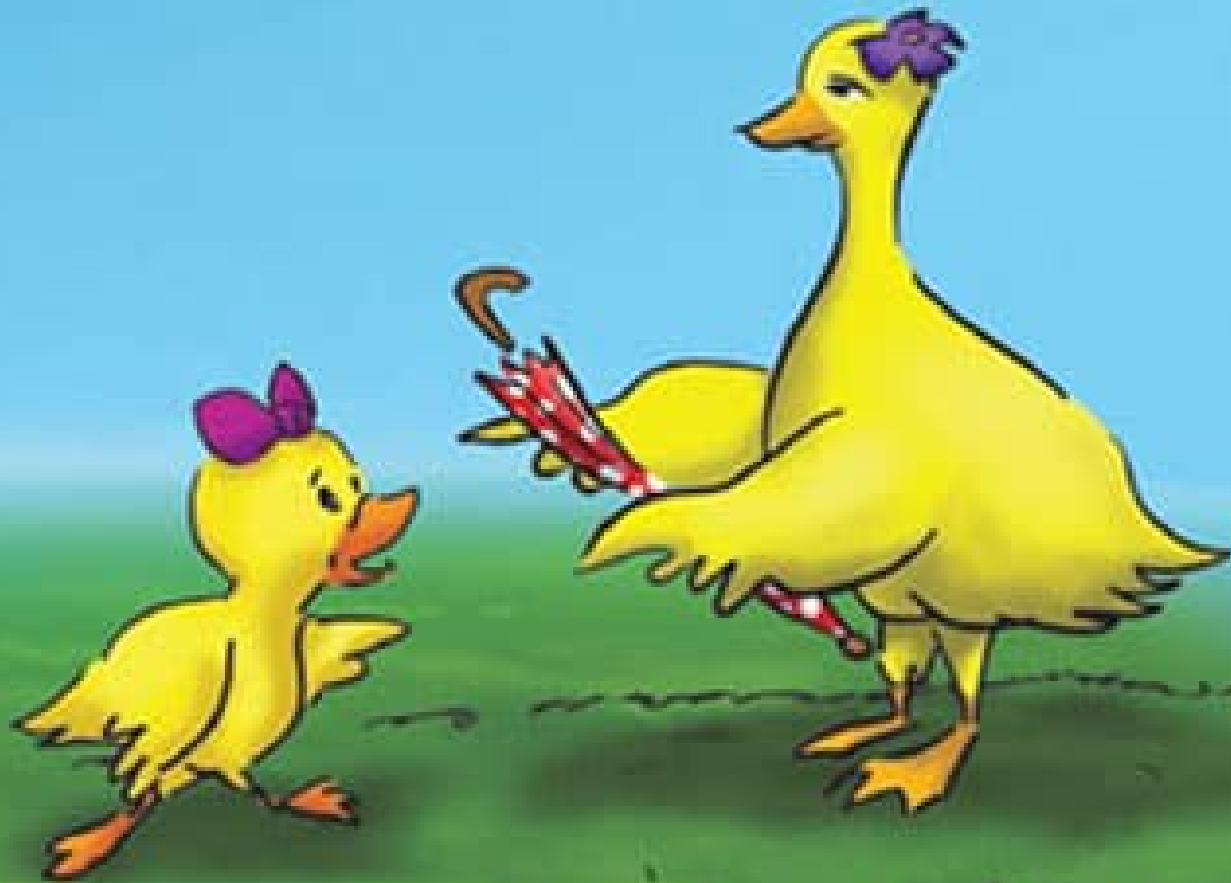
Next she sees a mouse.
