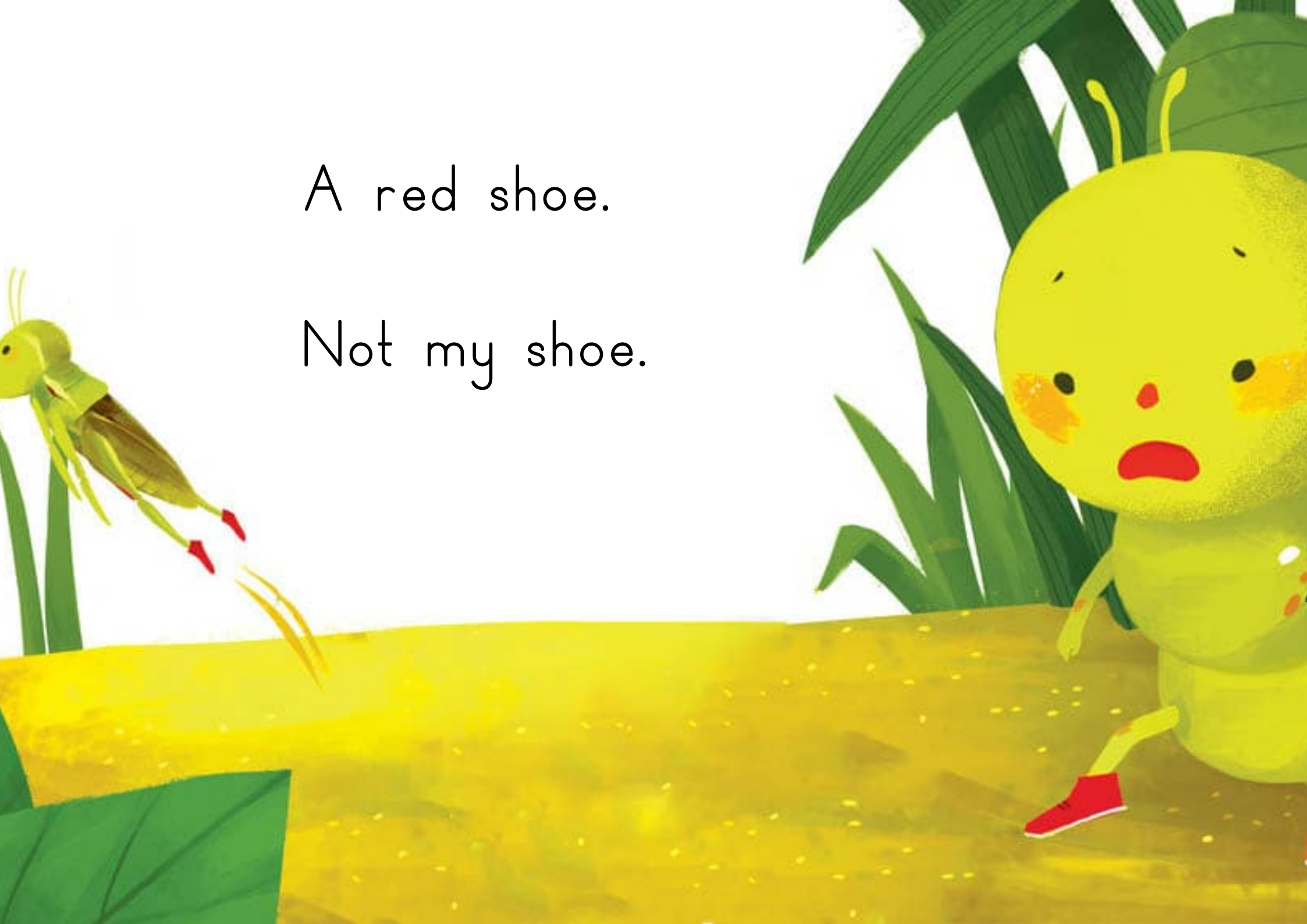

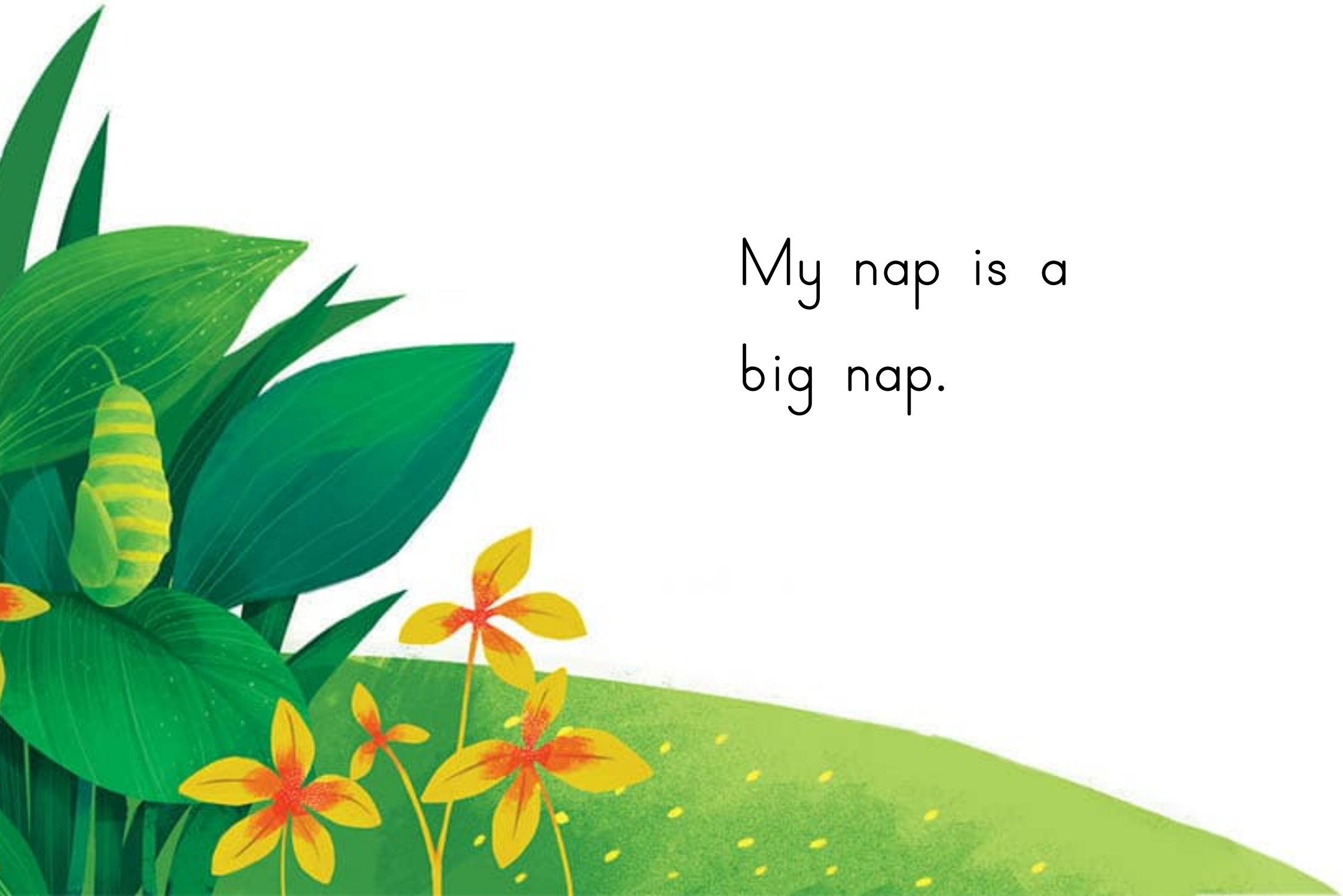

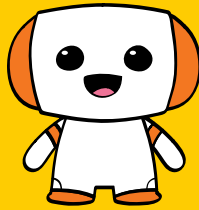
My nap is a
