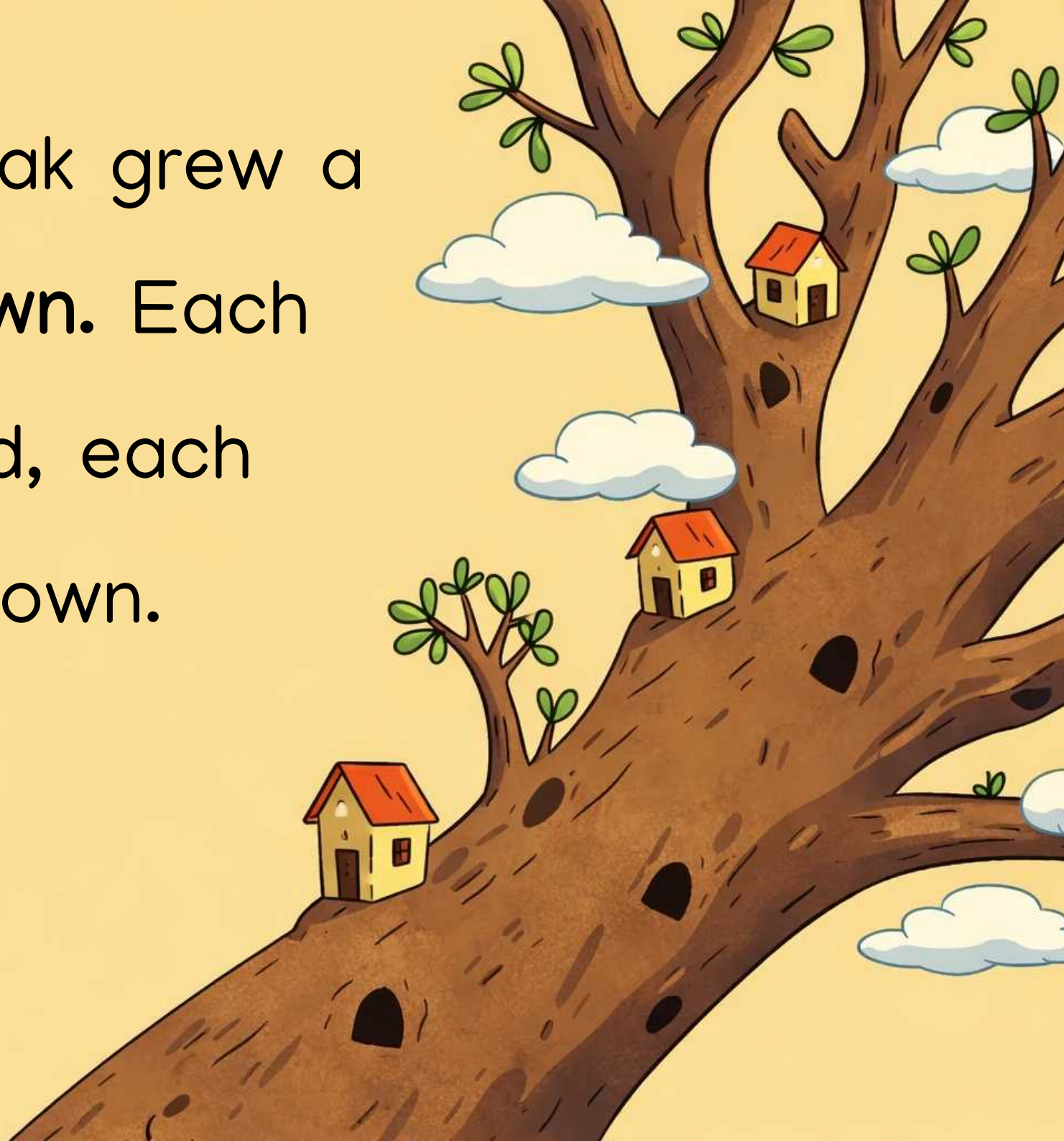


Who Took My Nuts?
