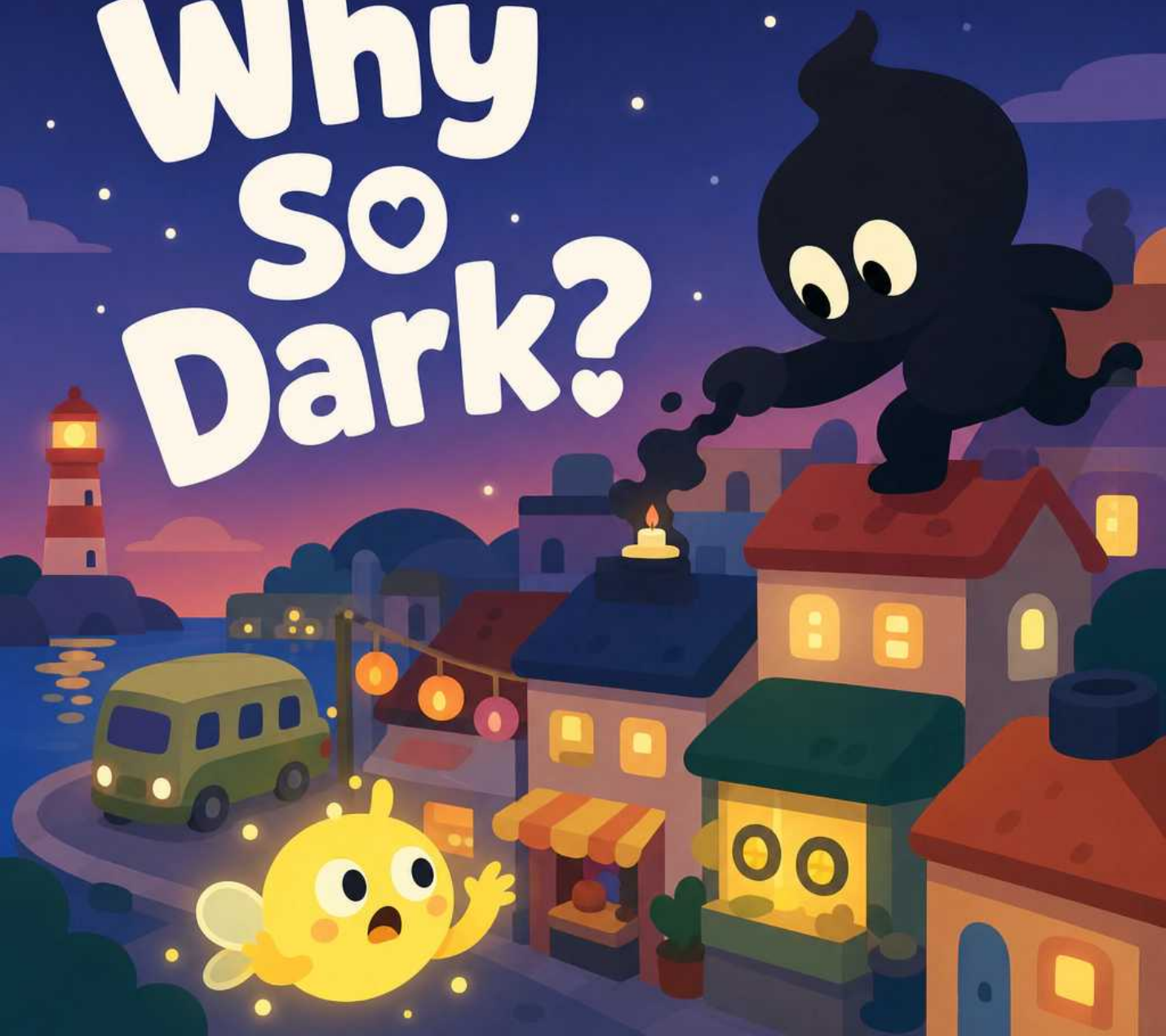


Why So Dark?
