thinks it is cute.



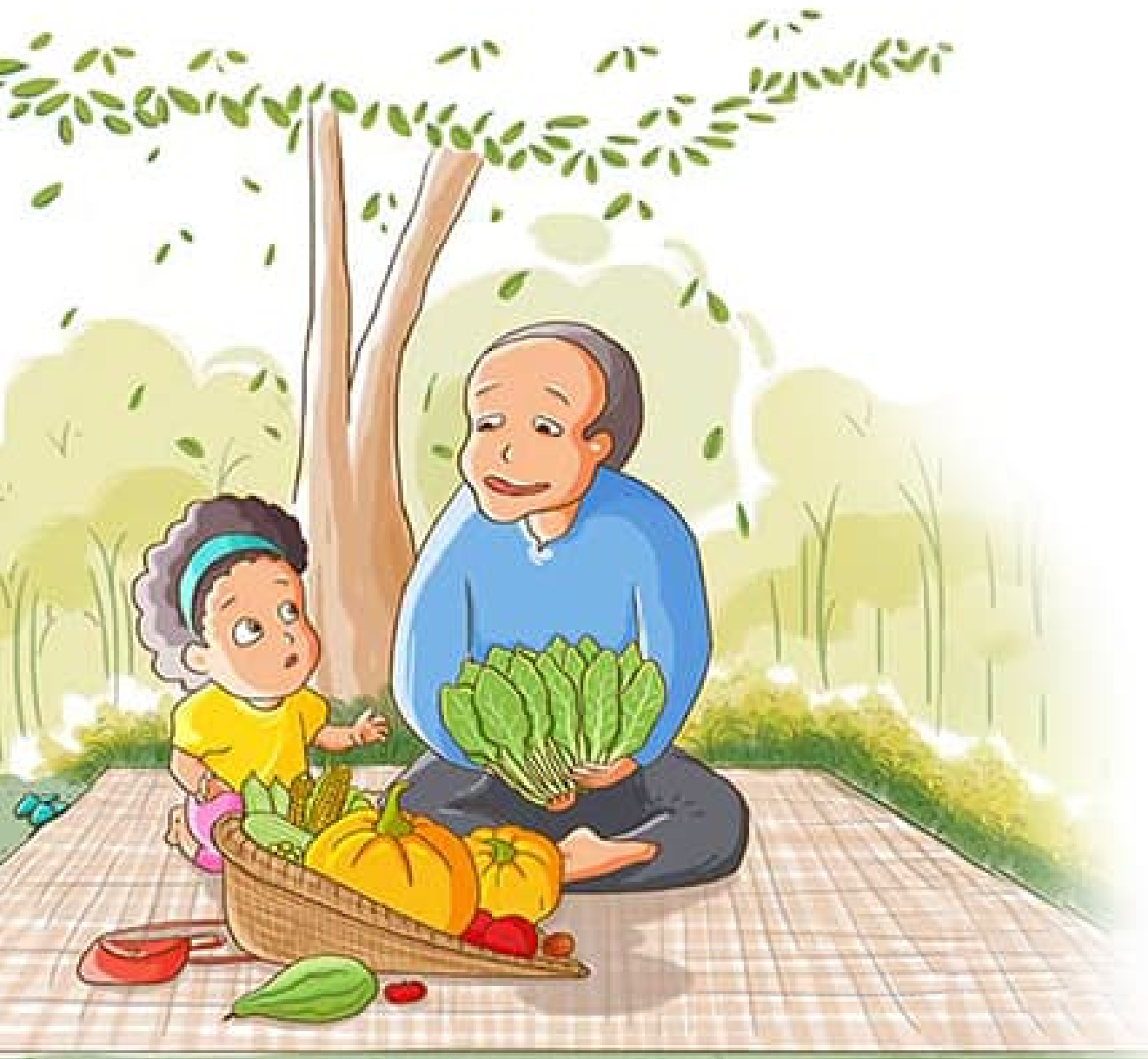
She says hi to
